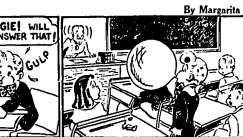

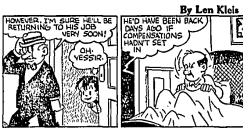

HOUSEHOLD TINTS

Patterns that are used frequently will last longer. It isn't necessary to hang them out of doors. Just use the iron on the line for 10 minutes so that the air can circulate around it. This will help to dry the fabric and prevent perspiration dampness.

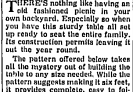
To make liquid fat from hot tallow, pour it through a coarse cotton cloth which has been wrung out in cold water.

Wallpaper cleaner can be used to clean paper or parchment lamp shades successfully.

Water stained bottles can be cleaned by partially filling them with hot water, adding some metal polish, fill shut or broken egg shells and then shake vigorously.

When pressing velvet or corduroy pieces of fabric, use the press for the part to be steamed. Dampen slightly and press on the wrong side with an iron. The nap will have a fresh, steam-cleaned look.

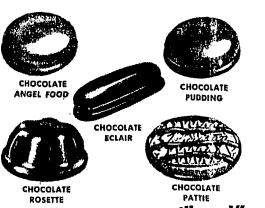

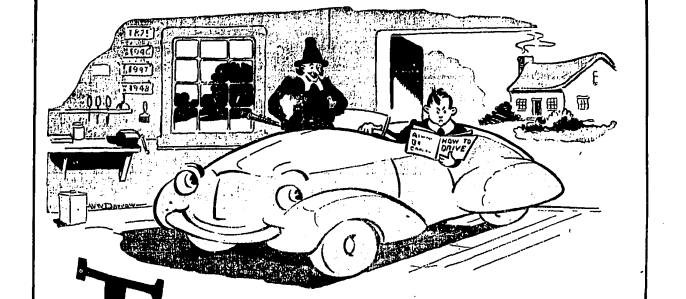

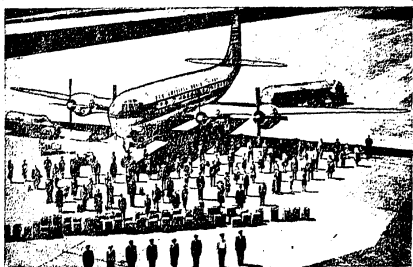
