Postmaster' Urges Early Yule Mailing

Negaunee residents were urged yesterday by Mrs. Agnes Rgan, local postmaster, to mail Christmas greeting cards and packages early in order to insure delivery not later than Dec.

Volume of early Christmas shopping is holding up well on a nation-wide basis, and, had result, postal department officials are advocating use of air mail to speed up delivery of packages, letters and cords, as well as stressing placement of zone numbers on mall sent to metropolitan centers.

"Patrons should allow at least two weeks for a package to go across the United States during the holiday rush," Mrs. Regan said, "However, by using air parcel post this period can be reduced to four days," she point ed out

For rush purposes, Mrs. Regan advocated that persons use special delivery service. She emphasized that using special delivery does not guarantee in-demnity in case of loss or break age and that it is still necessary

to insure or register packages. There are other ways in which mailing can be facilitated, ac-cording to the postmaster, in-cluding sending parcels and cards in bundles of 10 or more, sorting cards so that those going to a common destination are grouped together and by checking width and girth of large parcels before presenting them for delivery.

Residents are urged to ask and use tags which are available this year which read "All Out of Town Delivery" or "All for Local Delivery", These tags

can be obtained at any window, Post office restrictions per-taining to size of parcels provide that domestic packages must not have a combined length and girth exceeding 100

Mrs. Regan stressed the necessity of patrons checking to be sure their mailings carry sufficient postage, "If people are in doubt regarding weight of par-cels, they should have them weighed at the window," she bigs

Attention of residents was call ed to the regulation, which provides packages scaled with tape should contain a fourth class sticker, or that they must be sent first class. These stickers permit opening of the parcel for postal inspection, if necessary. Postal regulations also prohibit placing of seals or of Christmas seals on the addressed side of ckages and letters.

Regarding mailing of greeting cards, Mrs. Regan advocated that at least those being sent out of the city go first class, which requires a three cent stamp.


