In the bettle mixex before Plattsburg when the fort was blown up, he was dangerously was wounded and was thereafter confined in the hospital at St. David's Island until receiving his honorable discharge on account of physical disability in February 18 1865. Mr. Vasseur immediately came to Ontonagon to visit a brother and with the exception of the following year which he spent in Greenbay he has since resided in this place.

Mr. Vasseur was one of the very few veterans of the Civil War remaining in Ontonagon. He was known, loved and respected by all men, women and children of the village and his passing is regretted by all.
