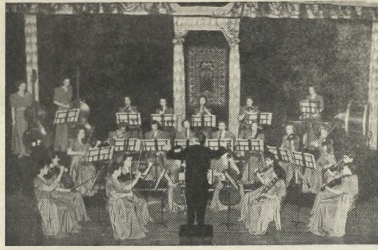

Among the books that have recently become part of the school's lending library, there are two that should have a great appeal to all of you who are interested in world affairs. One, THE MEETING OF EAST AND WEST, is written by F. S. C. Northrop, Professor of Philosophy and Master of Silliman College in Yale University.

The second book, entitled, THE UNITED STATES AND THE CARIBBEAN, by Dexter Perkins deals with the national problems, the political life, the manner of being, the culture, and the economy of Cuba, the Dominican Republic, Haiti, Costa Rica, Guatemala, Nicaragua, Honduras, El Salvador, and Panama.

THE PAINTER'S POCKET BOOK by Hilaire Hiler is a concise, practical handbook for the artist and student. Contents include a comparative survey of all the best processes of water color and oil painting and the selection and care of tools and materials.
