We were saddened to receive the report of Tom's death while in Florida. Ken Hamar reported to me concerning the accident, and we had so hoped Tom would be able to recover.


It was my privilege to know Tom very well for about forty years. I rated him as one of the unusually fine men it has been my privilege to know, and his many friends will surely miss him.
