

# Indians Cop Opener 3 - 1 Lose To Gile Here 5 - 4

Green Hurls 18 Innings In Series  
Split; Sarri Homers In  
2nd Clash

Thrills and spills, base hits and bobbles highlighted the 1st Interstate Championship doubleheader last Sunday as a grand total of over 2,000 paid and unpaid fans packed the Montreal and Ontonagon diamonds to watch the Wisconsin and Michigan representatives battle for the IBL trophy.

After camping in Ironwood Saturday night the Indians motored to the Montreal diamond Sunday morning and downed the Western Champs 3 to 1 on 3 hits while Green set the guests down with 7, 3 of which were bunts, good for their only run in the opening round. A morning crowd of 476 paid, watched the locals come from behind in the 6th with 3 runs on a pair of walks, Mikitenac's single and an error.

## Sarri Comes Through In Nighcap

The "man with the mask" came through in the home collision. Behind 2-0 in the 2nd frame and the sacks loaded with none out Hill popped into a double play. Sarri then ripped a single through the infield scoring Mikitenac and Fisher to tie the score. Sarri came up again in the fifth with none on and poled out his 2nd 4-bagger of the year over the left field fence.

The Indians blew a chance to end the series in the 7th. Zell made a shoestring catch of Ross' Texas Leaguer for the 1st out. Lackie singled and took 2nd when Thomas juggled the ball. Green beat out a bunt with Lackie scoring when the ball got by the catcher, Green taking second. The score Ontonagon 4, Gile 5. Curski and Mikitenac were hit by pitched balls loading the bases with 1 out. Fisher then hit to the mound with Green tagged out at the plate and the bases still loaded. Laurila also tapped to the box for the 3rd out and ending the inning. Gile pushed across 3 unearned markers in the 4th after 2 out when Thomas singled and Ferrari's pop-up dropped behind 1st base for a double. Thomas broke the 2-all tie making it 3-2 when a low throw got away from Sarri. Ferrari scored on an infield error with Aimone safe on 1st. Aimone made it 5 to 2 on Hornick's hit to left.
