Bay uses seized drugs

Three raids this week led to the confiscation of more than six pounds of marijuana and 13 ounces of cocaine, Upper Peninsula Drug Administration Turnover Extractors Director Clarence Bishop said.

He said UPDATE has also relayed an unknown amount of ecstasy to the NMU administraheadquarters, Cohmonus building.

SOUTHEASTERN AFGHANISTAN — Suspected terrorist ring leader Usama ben Laden, who has been in hiding somewhere in southeastern Afghanistan for the past six months and survived repeated U.N. attacks on his headquarters, was informed by the United States on Monday that he was now free to roam about the country. In making the announcement, U.S. President Georgie Bushes suggested ben Laden get some fresh air, preferably by himself, and within range of American sharp shooters. Inmates ingest vomit to get high

WAY UP THERE, Canada — The Canadian Beaver Basher cited several witnesses inside the Hollowed Tube Correctional Center saying that some heroin-addicted female inmates so desperately crave methadone that they routinely consume the fresh vomit of inmates currently on methadone treatment because enough is still present in the vomit. The newspaper uncovered the practice while investigating the death of an inmate. "The whole building knows (that the inmate choked on vomit)," said one of the inmates, "That's how she died. I should know, she kept bugging me to blow chunks so she could lick it up. It's really nasty." Guards said they knew some inmates were ingesting the vomit of others but thought it was "just a fetish." "I just thought they were into some sort of sick ritual," said John Gun, a guard at the correctional facility.

"We don't think that will be a problem though," Bay said, "Because everyone who ever comes to Marquette loves it here."




A new prototype NMU student, a look alike for Abercrombie ads (complete with frosted hair), runs into Lake Superior Wednesday.

The FDA is preparing to approve an over-the-counter sale of a new sexual assault protection drug, dubbed "the anti-drug." Lorena Bobbit originally developed the idea for the narcotic, but scientists were unable to perfect the side effects of the drug until recently.


"I could see up her skirt,"

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
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
