A. I Started to work at the Athens mine it, From there I went to the Bunker Hill mine until they closed it down then I went to the mather B mine, and I worked there 1968. 9 was the mine underground? A. Va, It was all underground work, Q. what were the wages? A. The wages when I started there underground with \$ 6.40-an bounday. A. the benefits came in when the union came into the mines. And there was no benefits before that time that was in 1941. Q. were there any lacations? A. There was no vacations till that time either. a. what days did you work? A. I worked from monday to Saturday. Q, what hours did you work? A. I worked three shifts 7 to 3, 3 to 11 and 11 to 7.

a. Did anybody get laid off? Athere were times when some of the men got laid off, But I was lucky enough, because I had menority. Q. were there any Strikes? A. Three big strikes, 2 of them were over 110 days. a. Were there any unions? A. The union came in, in 1941. Q. was there any welfare? A. NO Welfare. Q. How did the miners get along? A. They got along pretty well. Q. Did anyone get hurt? A. There was alot oftnemen got hurt in the mines. q. How did you get to work? A. I walked to work I wild not have a What did you pat? Bandwich, an orange and two cookies. a. Did you carry your Junch in a Junch pail? Indente two tookies up in news paper so I eauld fit them in my jacket pocket. Because there wasn't room to carry a lunch pail in alot of places that I worked.
