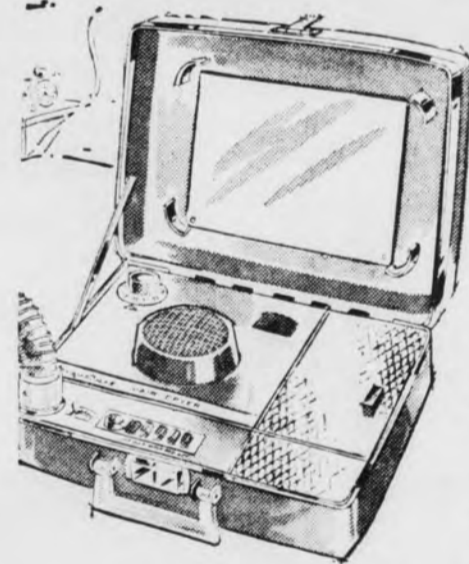

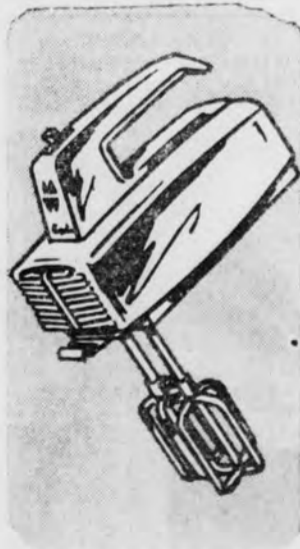

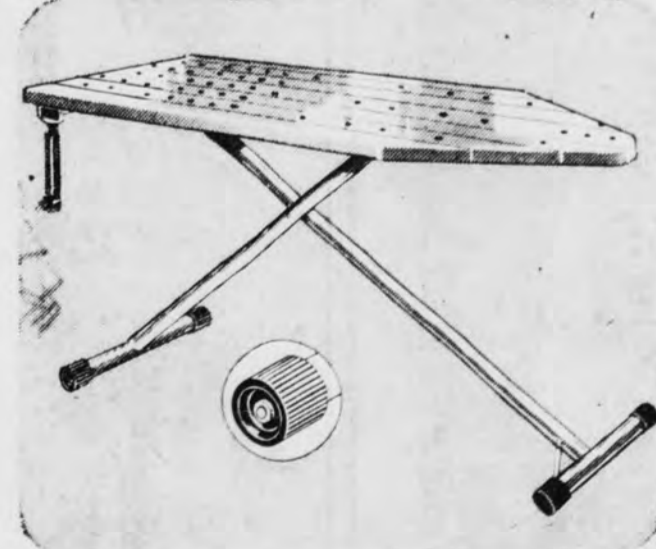

Soil Conservation District Plans To Award Scholarship

Marquette County's Soil Conservation District will again sponsor a scholarship for the Teachers' Conservation Scholarship School. District directors decided at their meeting this week.

The school, a field seminar in resource use, will be held at Camp Shaw, Chatham, Aug. 4-10. Sponsors of the school are the Upper Peninsula Education Planning Council and the Michigan Department of Conservation, in cooperation with the Michigan Department of Public Instruction.

The county soil district's scholarship is available to any teacher except those in the Marquette, Negaunee and Ishpeming school systems. The scholarship covers meals and lodging for the one week seminar.

The Teachers' Conservation Scholarship School is the outgrowth of a need for increased understanding in natural resource conservation.

Can Get College Credit

Teachers attending the school can receive college credit from either Northern Michigan University, Marquette, or Eastern Michigan University, Ypsilanti.

Also at this week's meeting, directors set July 31 as the date for the annual soil conservation district dinner meeting.

The dinner meeting will be held at the Gwin school. An election of district directors will be held at that meeting.

Tree Planter Available

It was announced that the soil conservation district's tree planter will be available to district cooperators and other land owners in the district.

The planter was donated to the district by the Union National Bank in Marquette.

Charge for use of the planter will be \$2.50 per 1,000 trees planted, plus a minimum charge of \$3 per day. Use of the planter can be secured by contacting district directors or Melvin Nyquist, Marquette, county extension director, whose office is in the county building.

Romney Has Deaf Ear For Demos

LANSING (AP) — Gov. George Romney has turned a deaf ear to Democratic demands that he veto the Ford-Canton strike benefits bill or disqualify himself from considering it at all.

Refuting arguments that the bill has a "conflict of interest" due to Romney's position as an American Motors stockholder, the Governor indicated Tuesday he will sign the bill when it comes to his desk.

Charges by Democratic State Chairman Zolton Ferency that the bill—by wiping out some \$280 million in so-called "negative balances" of certain corporations—would furnish them with a "multi-million-dollar gift certificate" were echoed by other Democrats.

'Public Disclosure'
Rep. Joseph Kowalski, D-Detroit, House minority leader, said Romney should make a "full and open public disclosure" of the negative balances and should disqualify himself from consideration of the bill, turning it over to Lt. Gov. T. John Lesinski.

Lesinski said he believed it "incumbent upon Romney, as the principal stockholder of American Motors, to disclose how much he would benefit personally from this bill."

He added that in the unlikely event Romney disqualified himself from consideration of the Ford-Canton bill, he probably would veto it "although I would listen to arguments the other way."

Incentive
The dispute centers around a provision of the bill which, in boosting the rates at which employers pay taxes to the State Unemployment Compensation Fund, allows those companies in arrears to the fund to have their debts wiped out, as an incentive for business improvement.

NMU Ends Spring Grid Drills With Game Saturday; 7 Seek Wildcat Quarterback Post

The Northern Michigan University football team will have a new look this fall, but the extent of the restyling will depend on two linked factors: quarterbacking and passing.

Coach F. L. (Frost) Ferrazza has seven quarterback candidates, and he'll be looking for one who can put new life into Northern's passing attack when the Wildcats hold their spring intrasquad game Saturday at 3 p.m. at Memorial Field.

Seeking to regain some of the passing poise they possessed with Frank Novak two years ago, while

maintaining the speed and power produced in the past by such hard running backs as Gene Valesano, Paul D'Arras and Tom Neumann, the seven QB candidates are expected to fill the air with passes. Last season, the NMU club attempted only 67 passes, and a better passing attack this year would obviously give the Wildcats a more versatile offense.

Among the signal-callers seeking a starting berth, Ferrazza indicates that punter Terry Nyquist, Marquette sophomore, has the inside track on the basis of spring training, but Stan Ferris of St.

Ignace and Jerry McCulloch of Berkley are right behind the former Marquette Graver ace.

Other quarterback candidates are Dick Rymer, Milwaukee, Joe Hase, Munising, Bernard Schmidt, Milwaukee, and Sam Hall, Lansing. Ferris and McCulloch shared front-line duties last fall.

For the past three weeks Ferrazza and line coach Pat Naughton have been evaluating candidates competing for positions on a team which was rated among the top twenty small-college squads in the nation last year.

Heading the returning line-men will be All NIAA and Little All-American tackle Jack Mauro, along with seasoned veterans Len St. Jean, Bob Kahlisch, John LaPointe, Bill Hamor, Joe LePorte and Bill Rademacher.

Coaches are counting heavily on veteran backs Don Bangert, Green Bay, Wis., sophomore and Tim Tranetcki, Wausau, Wis., junior in the backfield. Halfbacks Dennis Gorsline and Bob Erickson along with Jim Fox and Dale Hartz, newcomers, are expected to provide stiff competition for starting berths. Fox, one of the bright lights of last year's spring tilt, was ineligible last fall — by a tenth of a point.

The Wildcats, who will face the University of Detroit and the State College of Iowa among other newcomers on the schedule next fall, are expected to depend on the same defensive patterns employed in the past.

As in the past two years, sports-writers and sportscasters will select an outstanding back and an outstanding lineman for special recognition.

The annual intrasquad game climaxes 16 days of spring drills. In this brief period, only part of the offense can be installed, but progress has been made in most phases of the game.

The Wildcat coaches scouted the U-D alumni game last weekend, in which senior Jerry Gross bid adieu to the Titans' stadium with a passing display. Needless to say, Ferrazza and Naughton saw little of the rushing defense they can expect next fall, as one of the nation's greatest aerial specialists aimed at veteran receivers.
