### Mecca statement

(Minnesota Environmental Citizens Conservation Union)  
Made before F to PCA Conference on Lake Sup. Aug. 1970.

Since 1956 Resene has been dumping taconite tailings into Lake Sup. Orig. permits were granted by both the state of Minn. and U.S. Army Corps of Engineers on the assumption that tailings were inert chemically and would be carried into Superior's "deep trough" by a heavy ~~flow~~ current.

In Dec. 1968 the U.S. Dept. of Interior, under the direction of then Regional Coordinator Charles H. Stoddard, completed <sup>a 6-month</sup> studies showing that pollution existed and recommending to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers extend its permit <sup>conditionally</sup> only for 3 yrs. to enable the Co. to build on-land waste disposal facilities.

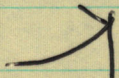
Were result of July 1967 Army-Interior agreement at the request of the Corps prior to its renewal of a permit to allow Resene to continue its discharges.

Five Interior agencies took part.

Monthly

In April 1970 another report concluded that "The scientific ev. clearly points to the fact that Lake Sup. is being irreparably damaged by taconite tailings which are causing basic changes in the lake leading to eutrophication."

The Minneapolis Tribune for Fri. Aug. 14, 1970 has a front-page article by Don Way telling that the Federal-State Enforcement Conference held on Thurs. the 13th. ordered Reserve Mining Co. to cut its pollution of Lake Sup. by following a specific timetable for altering discharge of taconite tailing from its plant at Silver Bay, Minn. and directed the Co. to outline ~~on~~ a plan by Dec. 1 for ~~on~~ "altering its discharge to meet federal and state pollution requirements."

Chairman of the conference was Murray Stein, enforcement officer for the Federal Water Quality Administration.

The order came after a federal water quality scientist, Dr. Donald J. Marmat, testified that a portering of Reserve's tailings are not only being carried into Lake Superior waters but <sup>they</sup> are endangering Lake Superior residents.

Conference first convened 15 months ago but state of Minn. wouldn't join so had due to foot-dragging of Gov. Harold LeVander so <sup>the</sup> conference had to show interstate pollution <sup>felt</sup> (state able to cope with it)

Article says Reserve could comply or (2) not comply & (3) fight in court.

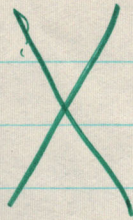
