GRAND ISLAND

DEER

During the year we shipped 17 deer at an average price of \$50.00, or a total amount of \$850.00. We had orders for additional deer but due to the small fall of snow we were unable to get the animals to enter the traps and were, therefore, unable to complete our contracts.

The prospects for the sale of deer during the coming year are not good and at the present time we have orders on our books for only 5 animals.

ELK

A number of these animals are seen from time to time by the gamekeepers and they apparently are in good condition.

GAME BIRDS

Few birds of any character are seen on the Island but the partridge during the past few years have increased in number.

PREDATORY ANIMALS

From time to time a number of coyotes get on the Island and during the past year six of these animals were killed.

HUNTING

During the past season hunting parties consisting of Carter H. Harrison and party were at the Island for a few days and, in addition to these, a few of the State officials of the Y. M. C. A. were also there.

We had as our guests a party of railroad men from Chicago who occupied the Lodge.

MAPLE SYRUP

During the year we made 517 gallons of maple syrup, compared with 582 $\frac{1}{2}$ gallons last year. We were unable to dispose of all this syrup and still have a small inventory on hand.

ROADS

No new roads were built on the Island during the year but we did considerable repairing to present roads.

DOCKS

The docks on the Island are in excellent condition and we were under no expense at this point during the current year.

BOATS

The "OTTAWA" was in commission during the time the Hotel was open and was laid up on September 15th at the time the Hotel was closed. During that time she made schedule trips between the Island and Munising and the Pictured Rocks. The launches "Trout Bay" and "Williams Island" were used between the Island and Powell's Point on the mainland.

BOARD OF COMPENSATION CASES

During the year we had a number of compensation cases which had to be under the care of the doctor but were not of such severeness as to confine them to the hospital and in order to save the expense of boarding these men at boarding houses in Munising, we kept them at the boarding house on the Island.

EXPENSES

The following statements give a report of expenses and revenues of the Island during the years 1932, 1931 and 1930.

The expense of carrying this Island is lower during the current year than last year as all salaries and expenses were drastically reduced.

TAXES

The Cleveland-Cliffs Iron Company's comparative tax statement shows taxes paid for the year 1932 of \$73,401.36, to which must be added \$144,640.54, the amount deferred or a total of \$218,641.90 in order to compare with the year 1931. The total taxes paid and deferred for 1931 was \$295,955.66. The amount of taxes charged to Accounts Receivable in 1931 was \$17,624.94 and in 1932, \$13,717.58. Eliminating these items, the result shows a decrease in taxes paid for 1932 of \$73,393.90.

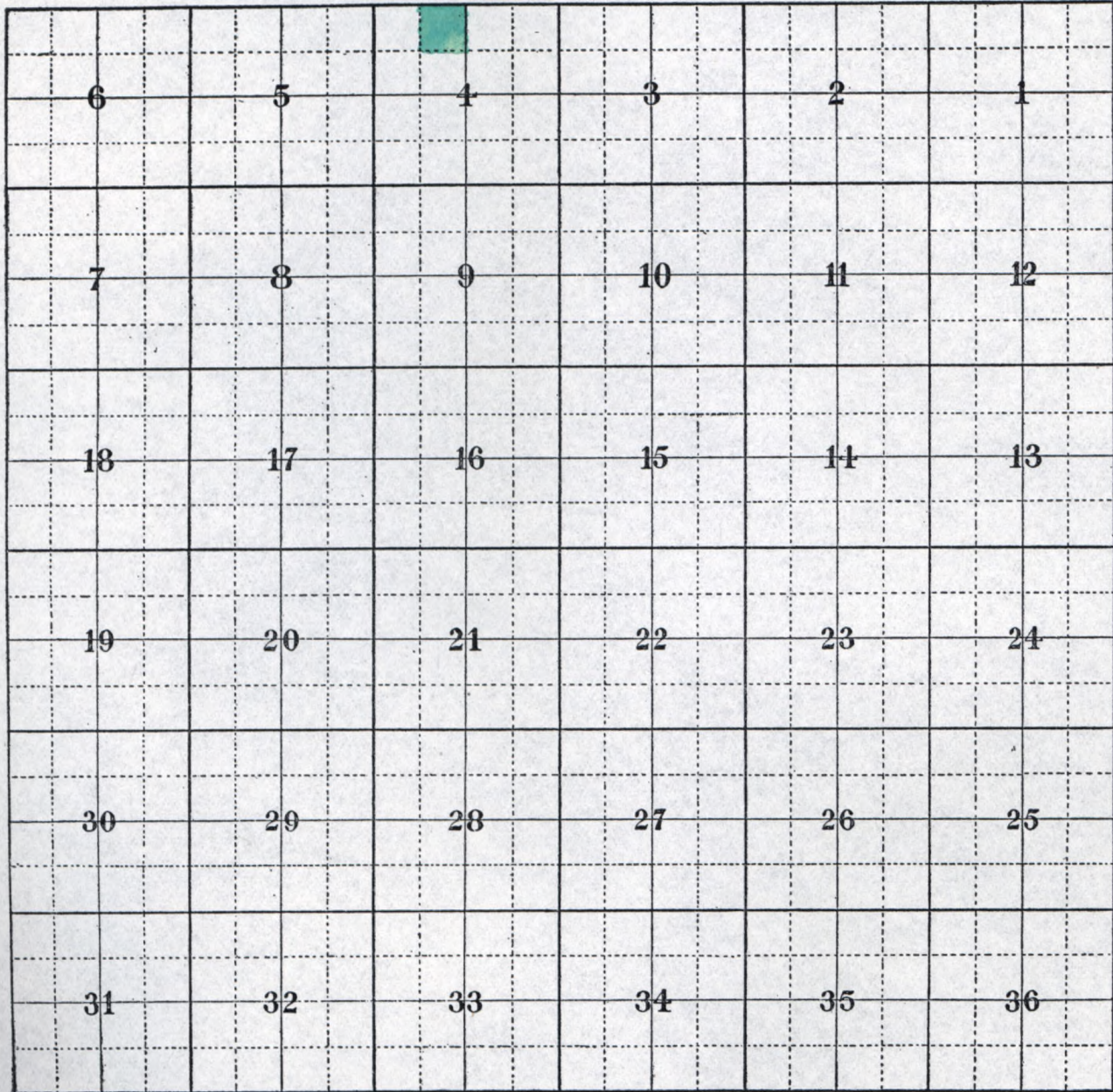

CHART SHOWING THE PERCENT OF THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF TAXES RAISED PAID BY C.C.I.CO.



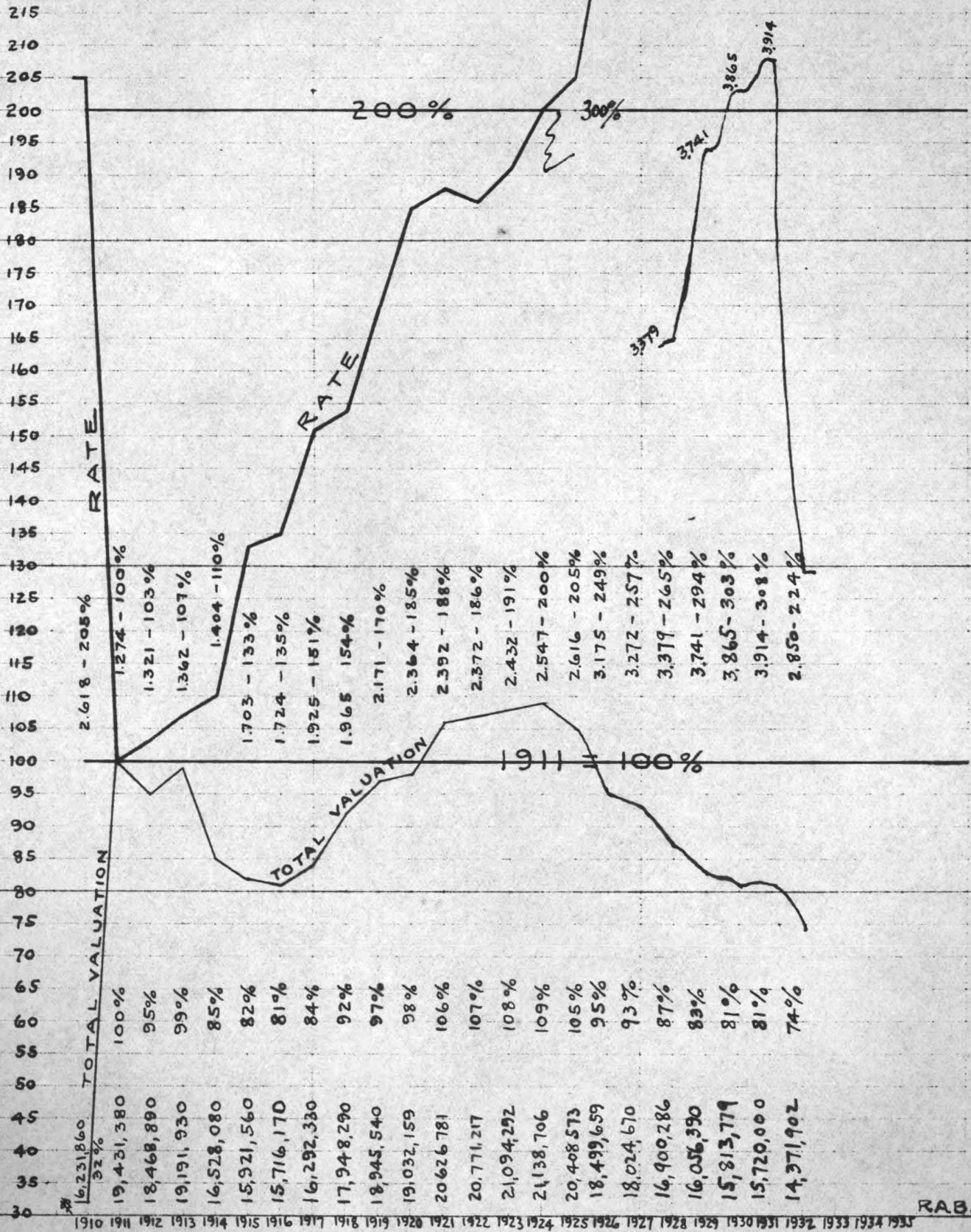

OF TOTAL TAX PAID

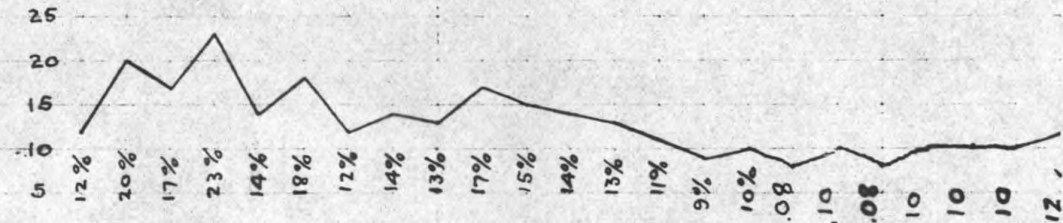
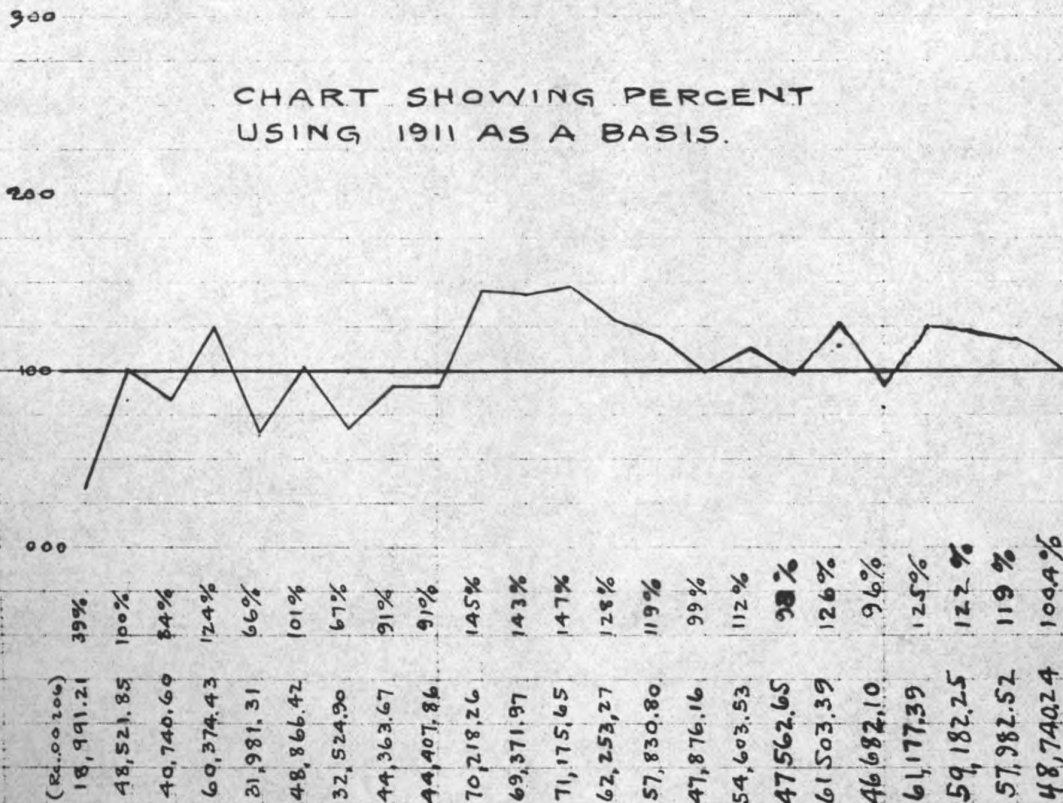

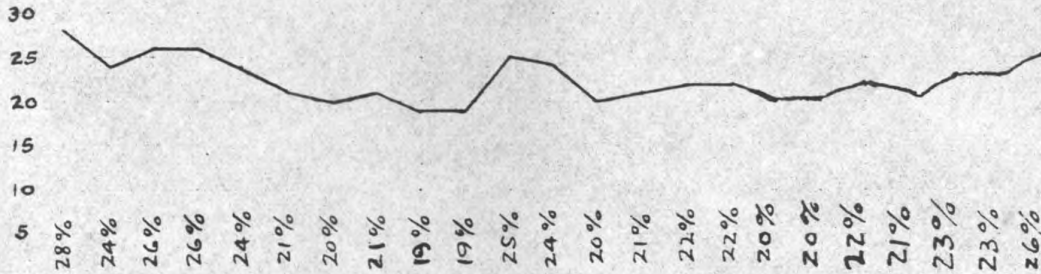
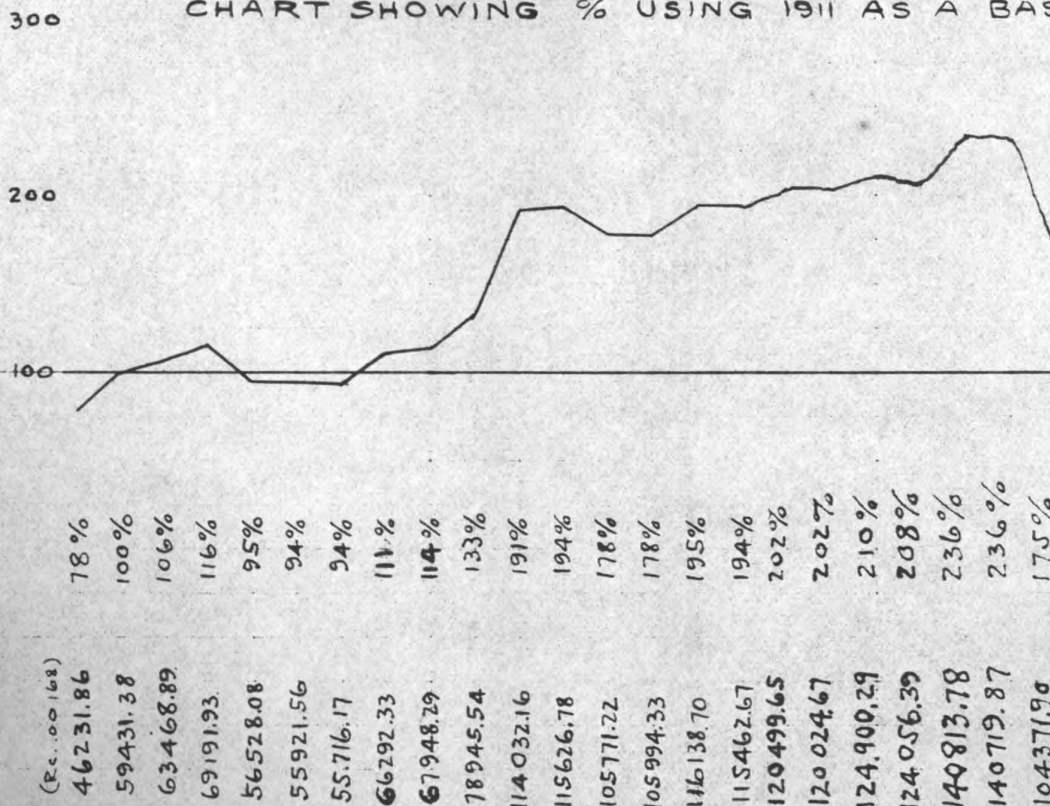


CHART SHOWING % USING 1911 AS A BASIS

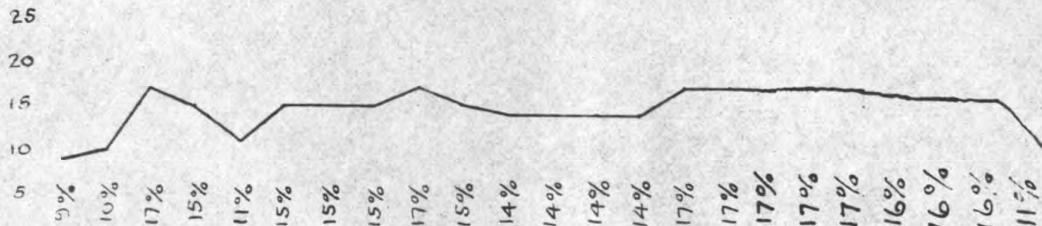
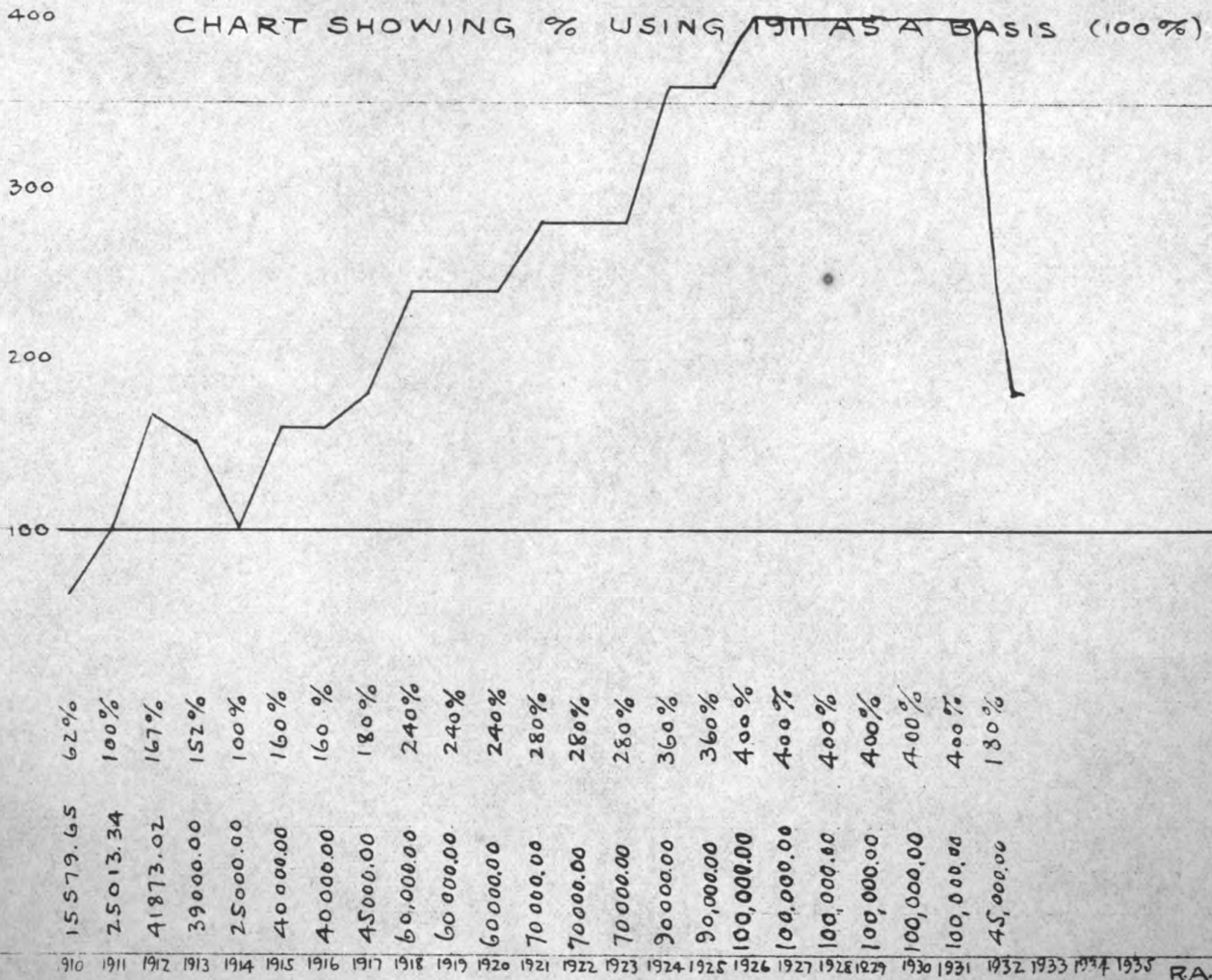

CHART SHOWING % OF TOTAL TAX PAID

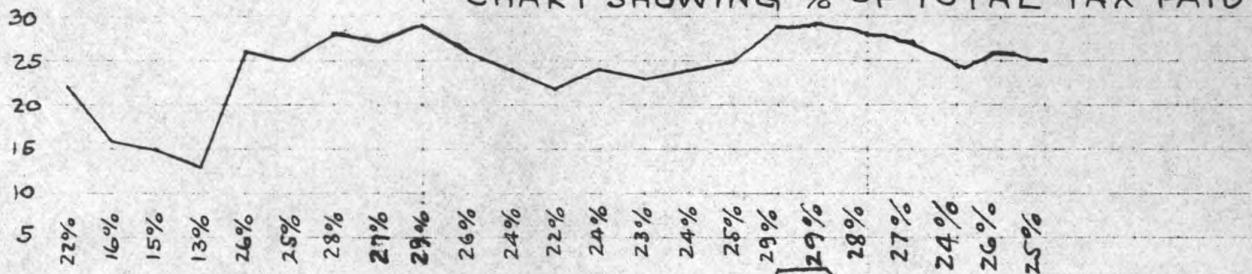
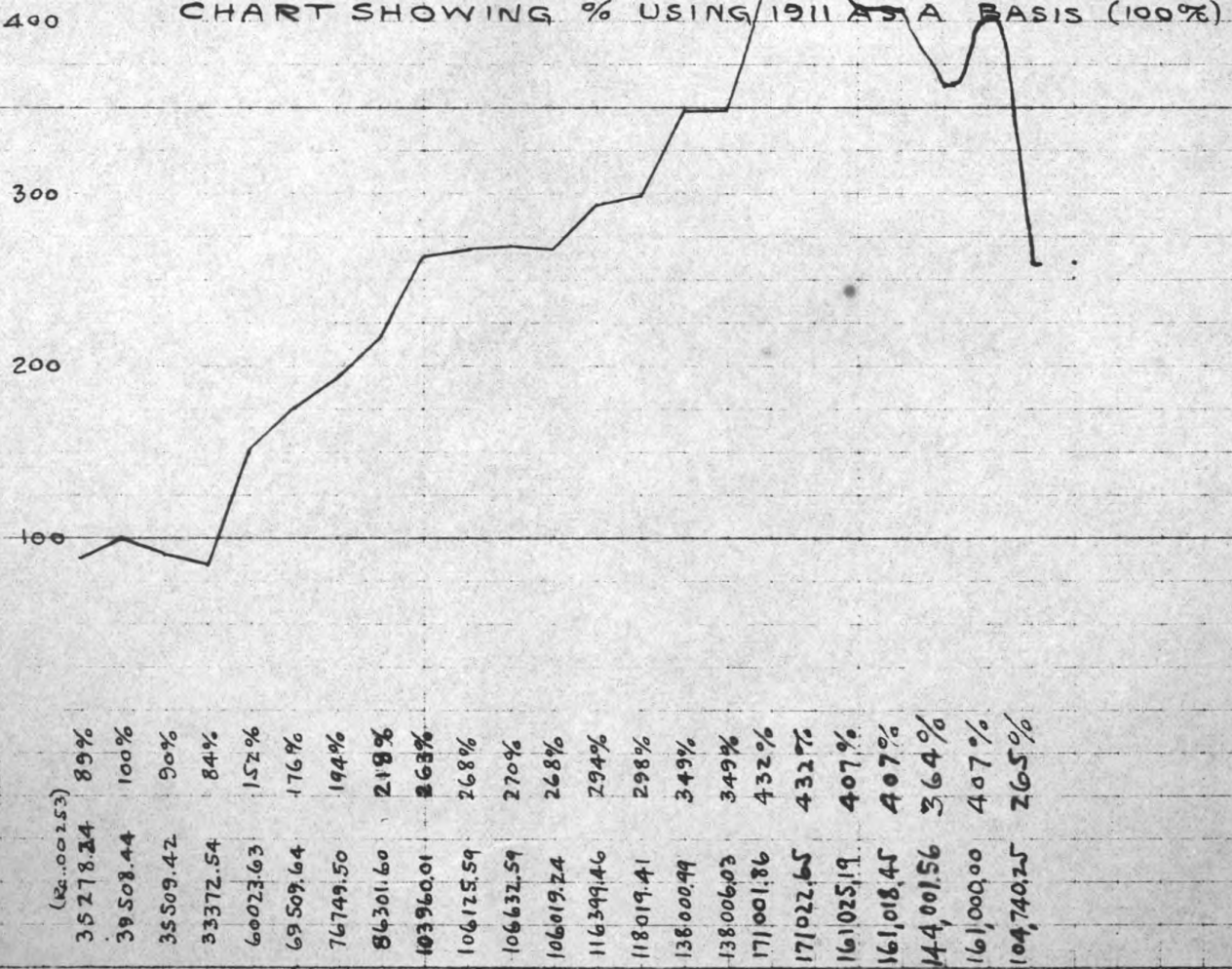

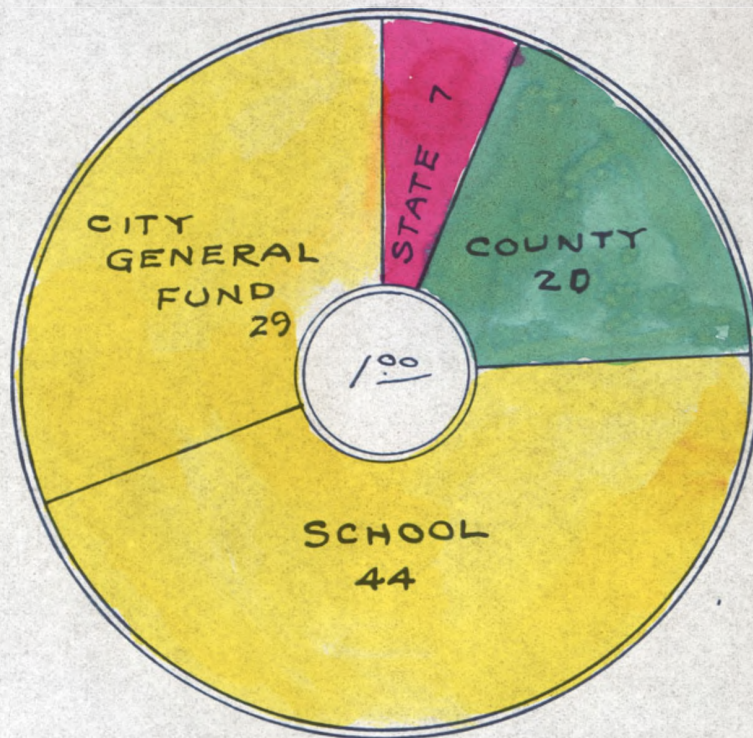
