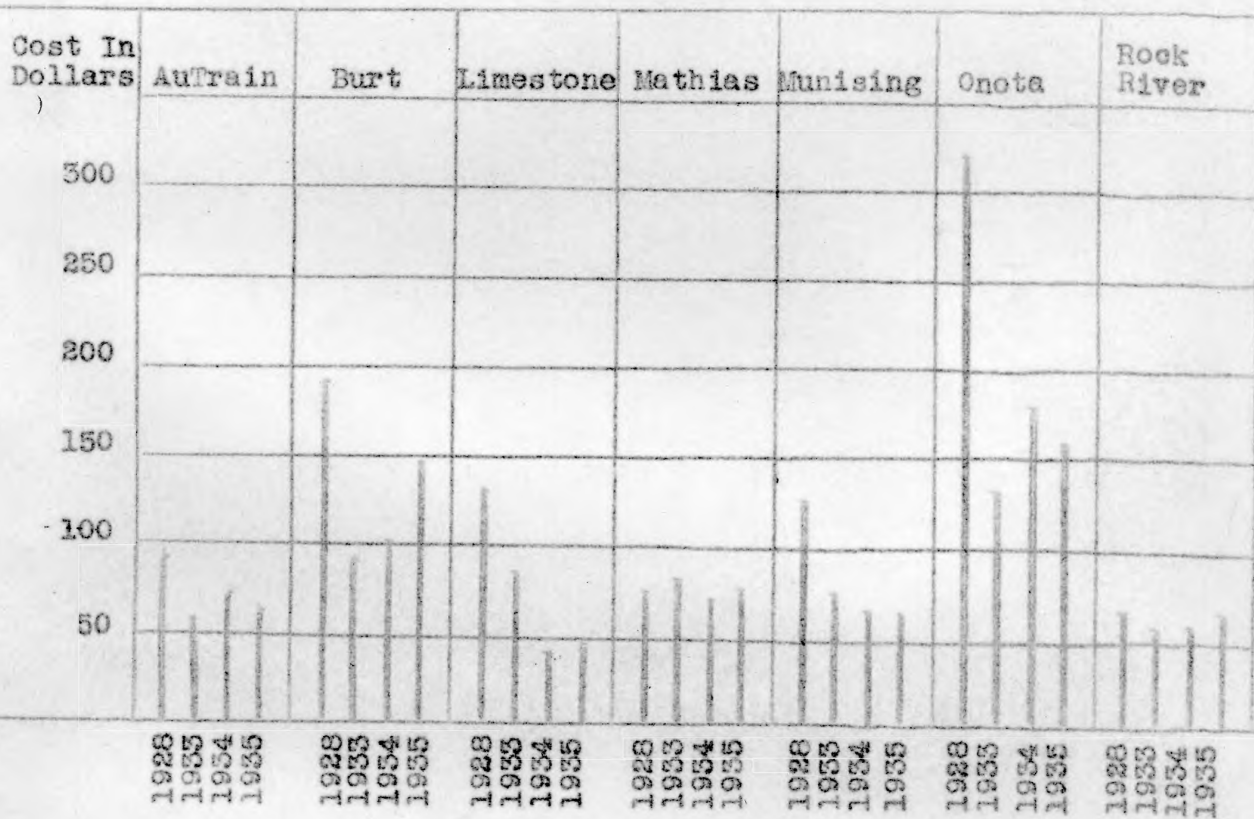

GRAND ISLAND:

DEER

During the year we shipped forty-three live deer at an average price of \$35.81, or a total amount of \$1,540.00. This is compared with a shipment of forty-two deer at a total of \$1,475.00 for 1934.

The prospects for the sale of deer are good for the coming year but we find that these animals are very scarce on the Island and it is not proposed to make any shipments during the current year.

ELK

Very few of these animals are seen but the gamekeepers occasionally run across one on their trips over the Island.

GAME BIRDS

The partridge seem to be increasing on the Island but there are very few birds of other species.

PREDATORY ANIMALS

We have had considerable trouble during the past year with coyotes and a number were killed.

HUNTING

During the year a few hunting parties visited the Island and the following statement shows those who were there and the number of deer killed:

### MAPLE SYRUP

During the year we made 635 gallons of maple syrup compared with 720 $\frac{1}{2}$  gallons in 1934. We are finding it more difficult each year to dispose of this syrup at a price that would give us a proper return on this product and we are carrying a considerable inventory at the end of the year.

### ROADS

Only the regular work of maintenance was done on these roads by the Company during the year. However, under W.P.A., the Alger County Road Commission did considerable work on grading and cutting out along the side of the road where the underbrush had encroached.

### DOCKS

The docks on the Island are in good condition and during the year very little expense was necessary in their maintenance.

### BOATS

The large boat "OTTAWA" was in commission during the time the Hotel was open.

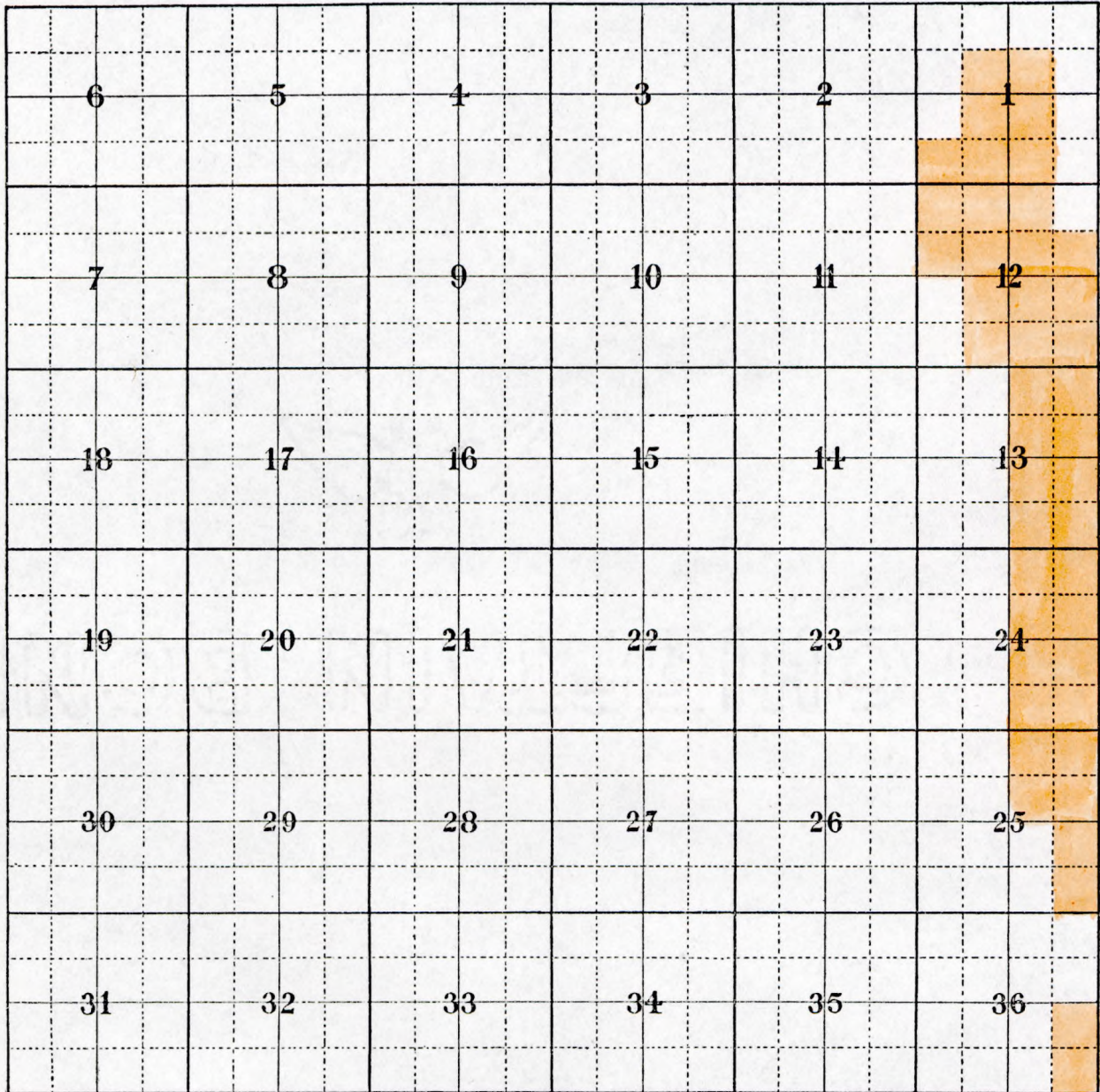
TOWNSHIP NO. 46<sup>OF</sup> RANGE NO. 20

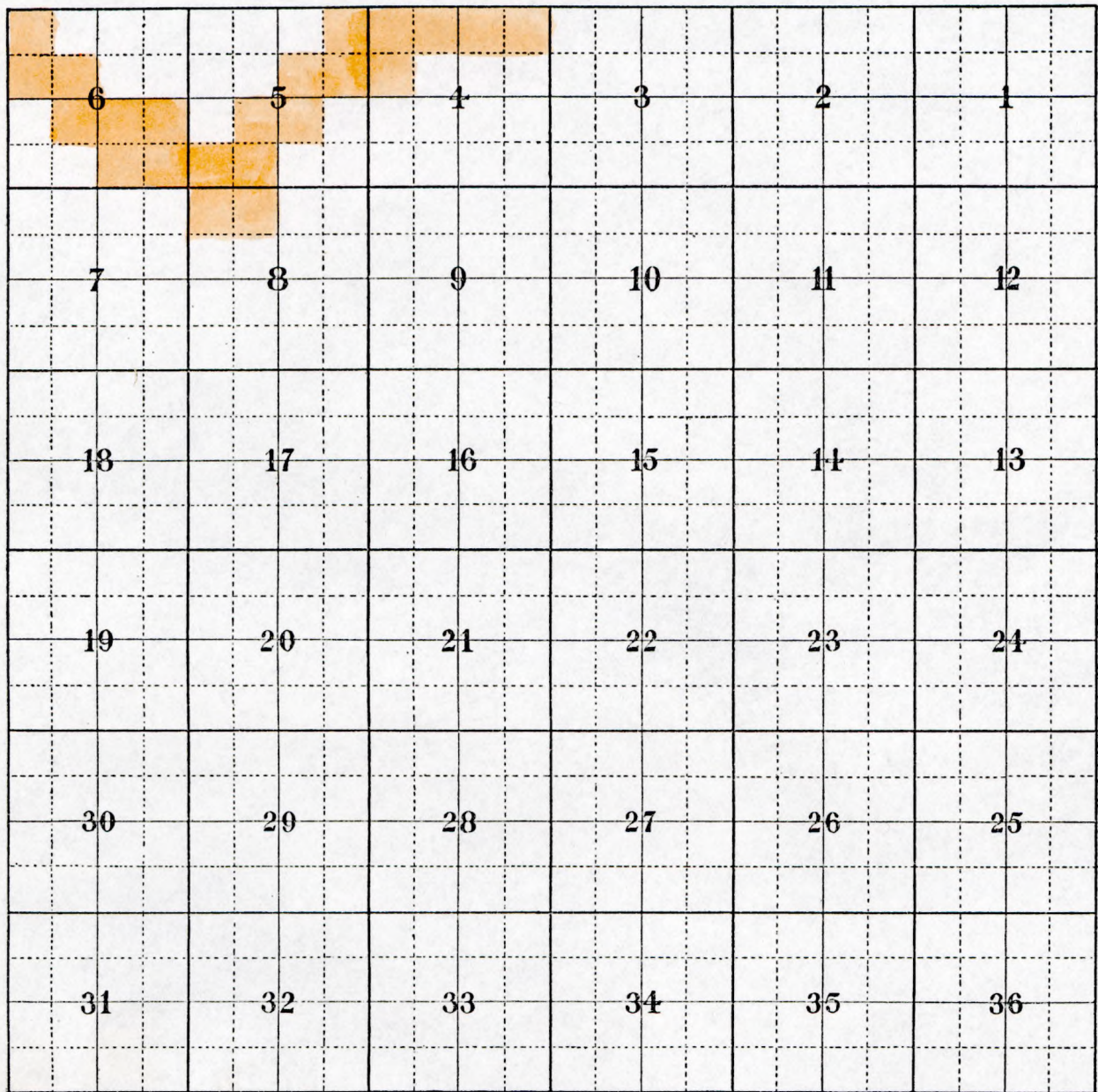

RANGE NO. 25

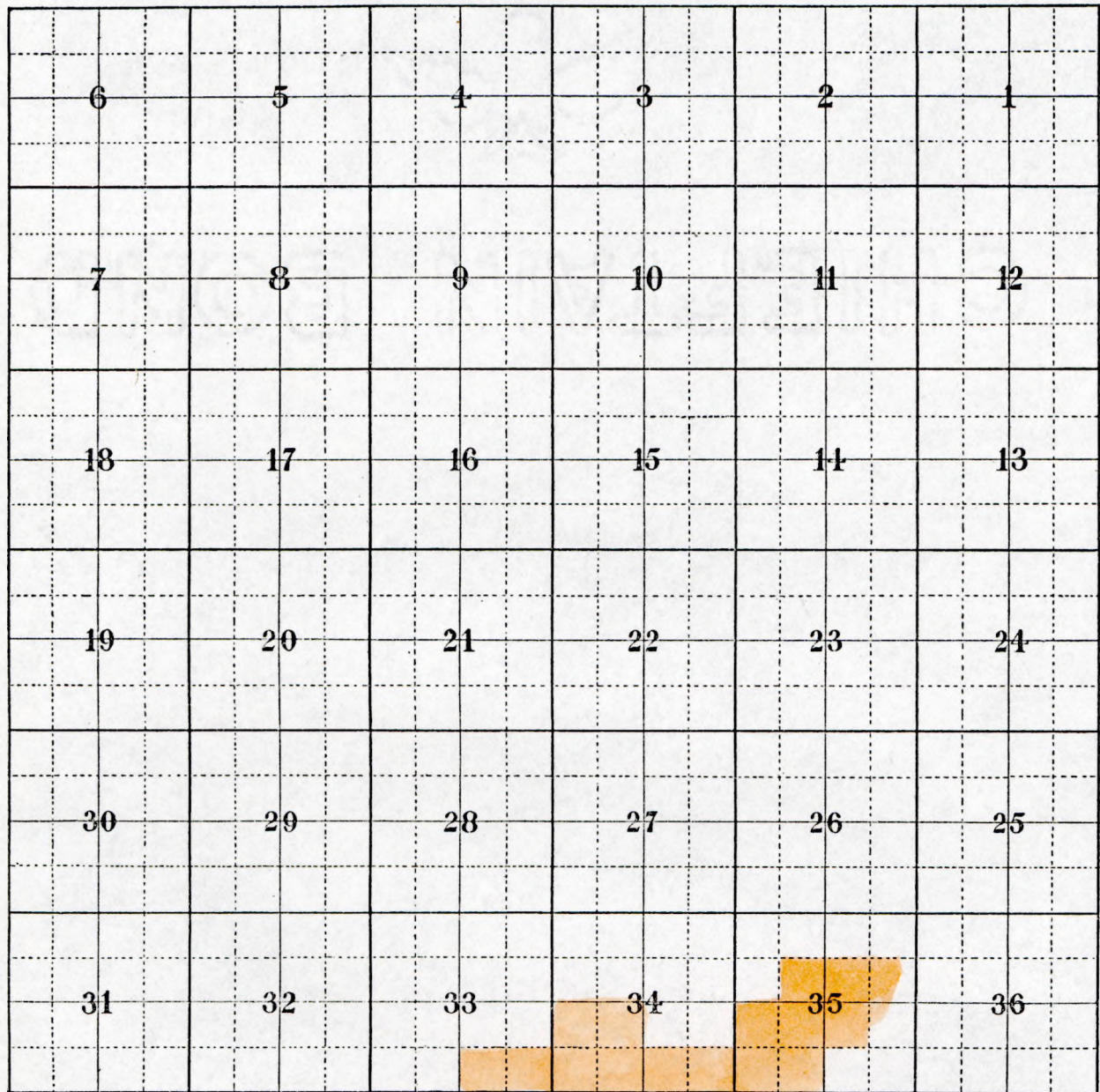

CHART SHOWING THE PERCENT OF THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF TAXES RAISED PAID BY C.C.I.CO.

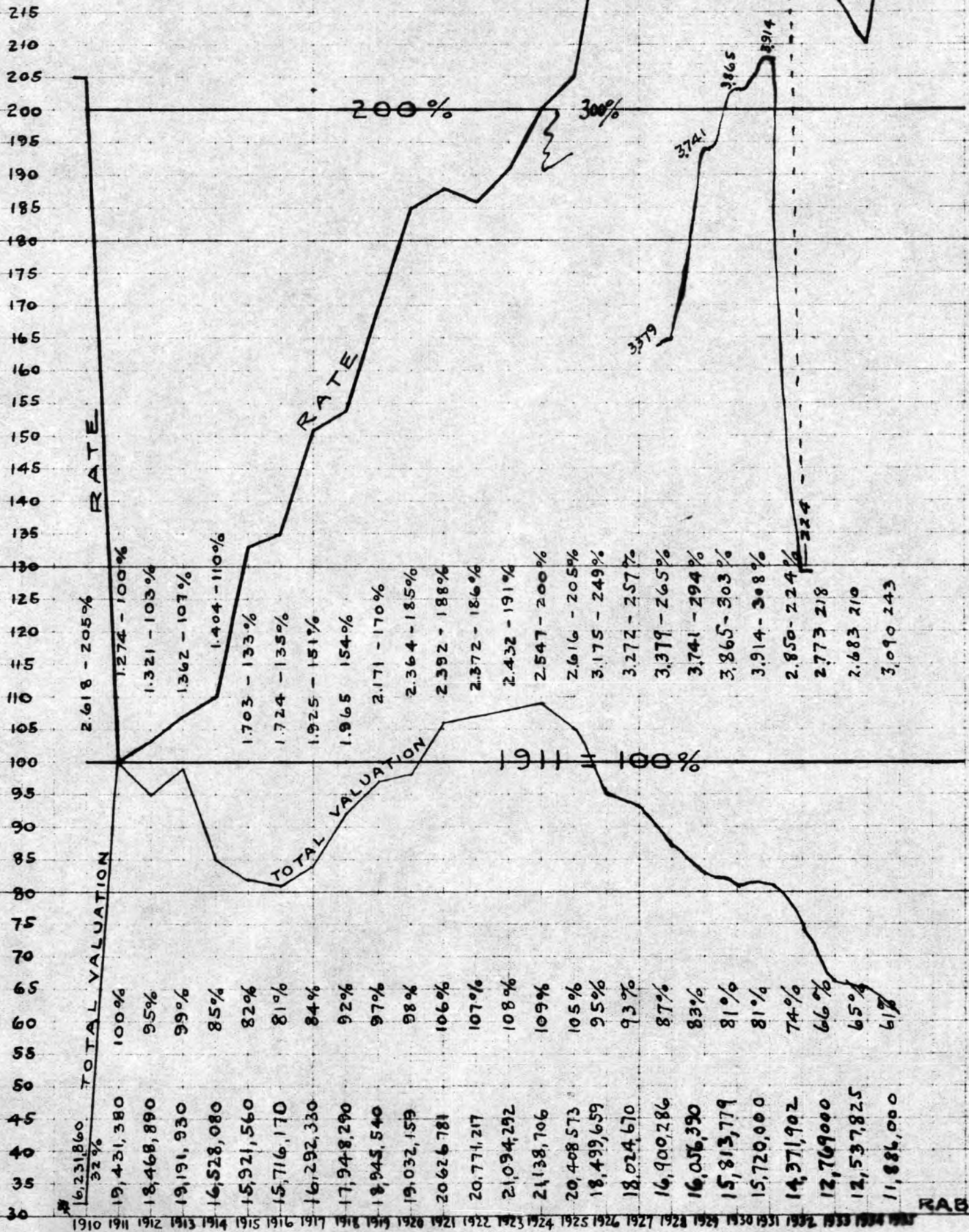

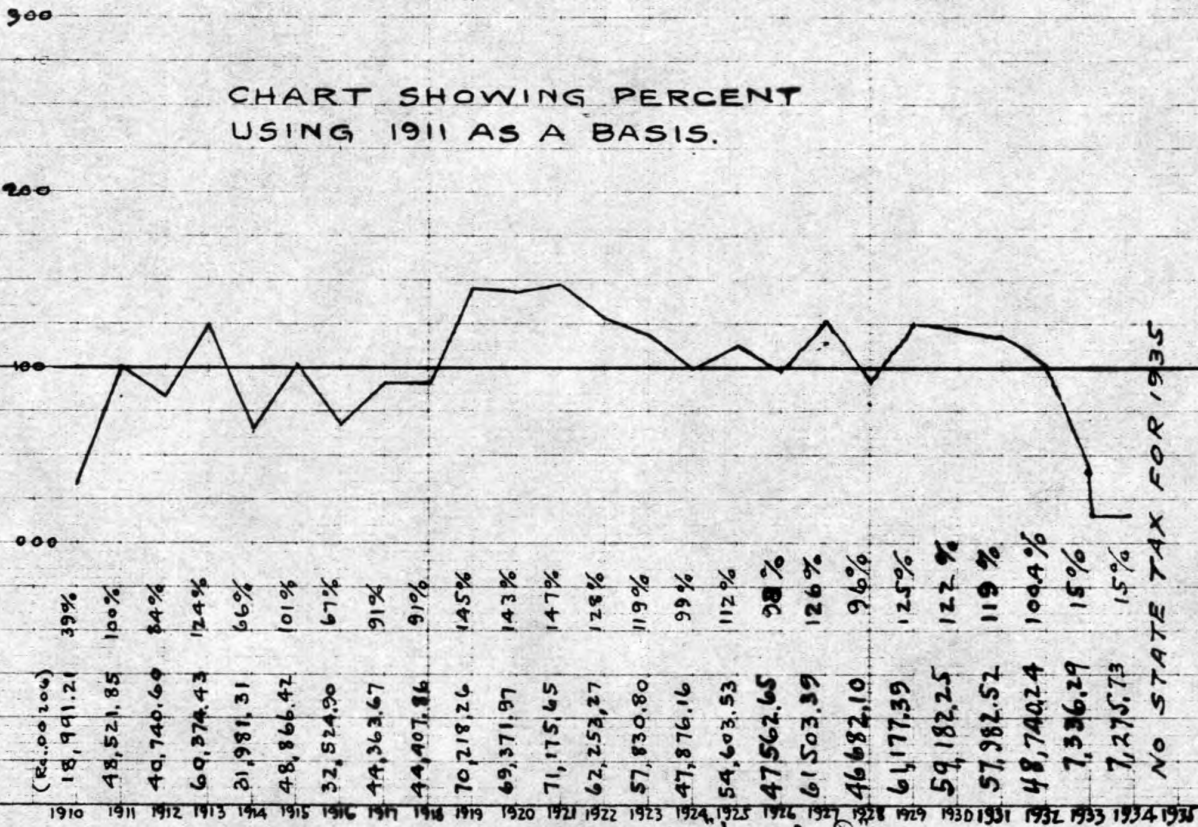

CHART SHOWING % OF TOTAL TAX PAID

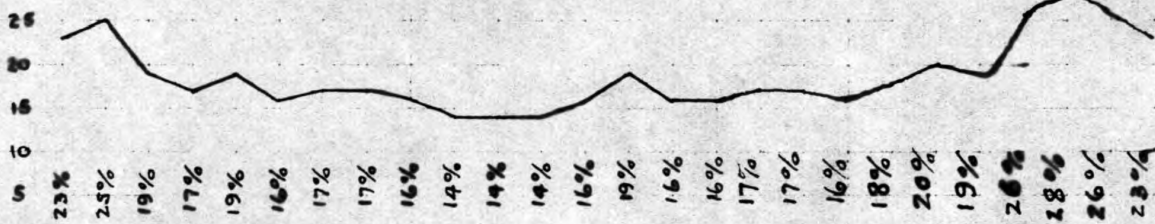
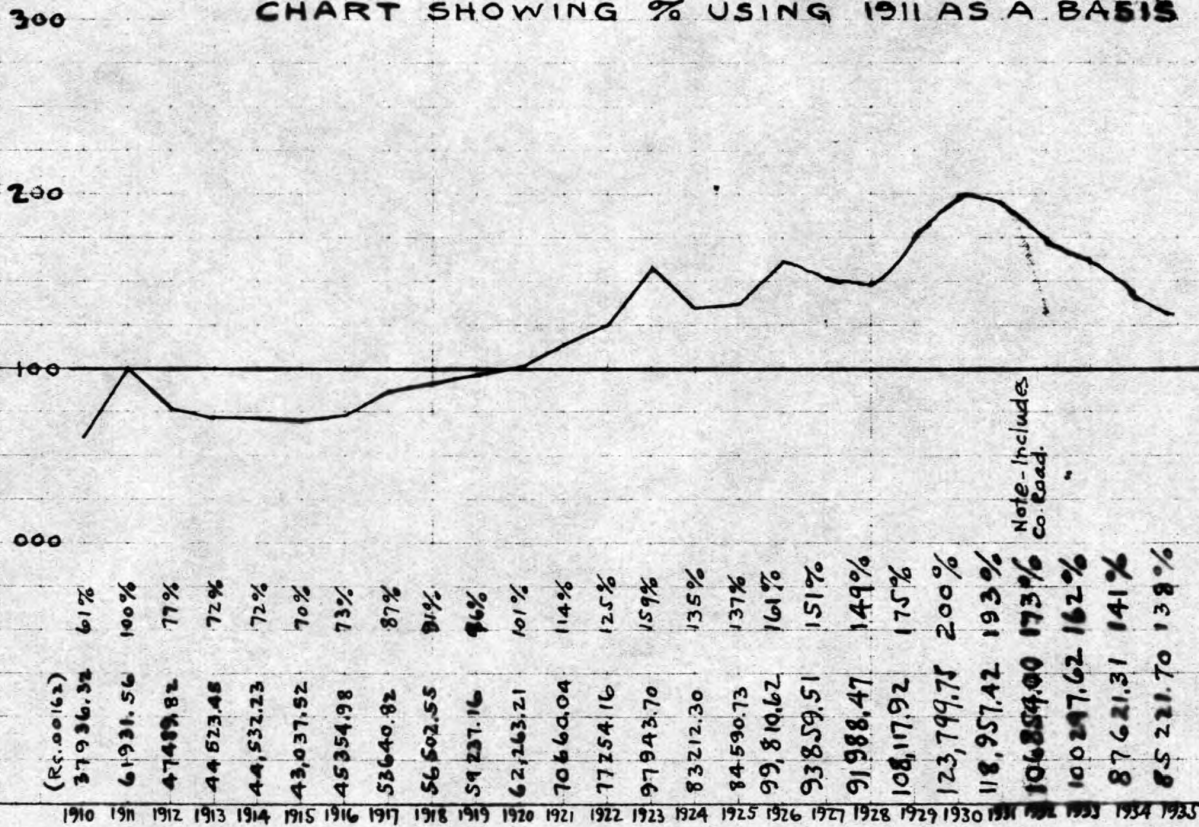


CHART SHOWING % USING 1911 AS A BASIS

CHART SHOWING % OF TOTAL TAX PAID.

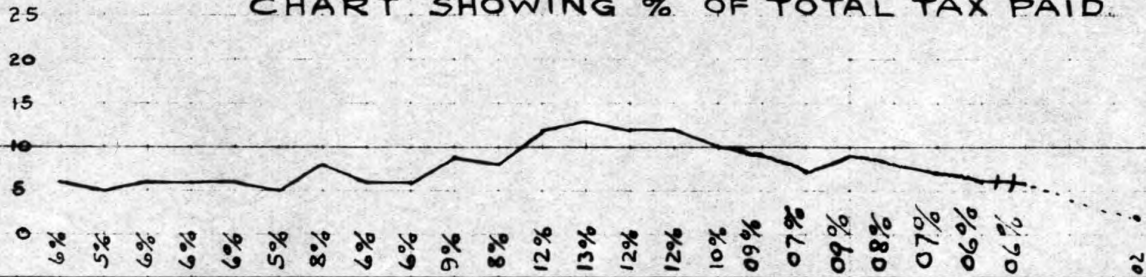
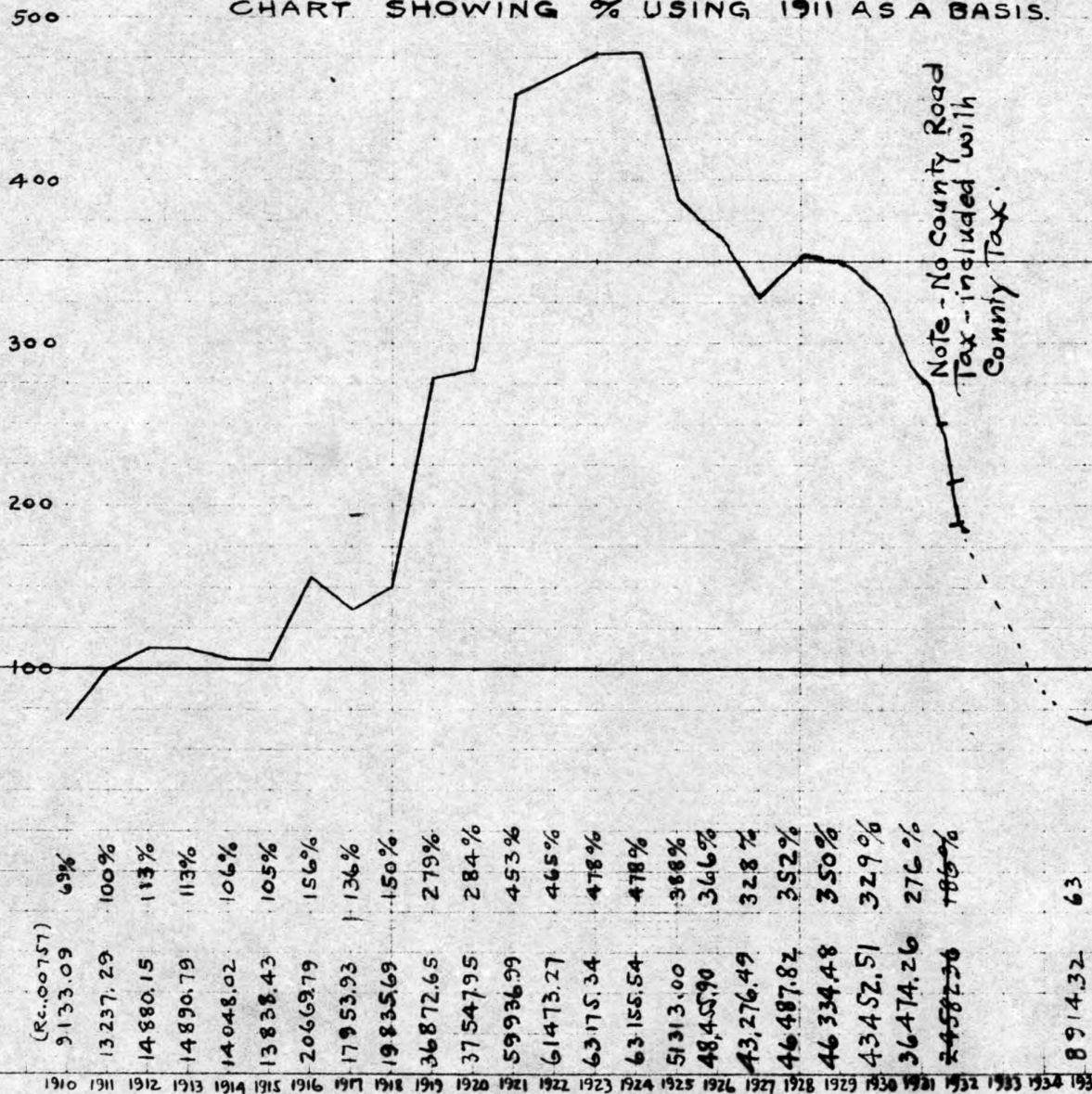

CHART SHOWING % OF TOTAL TAX PAID

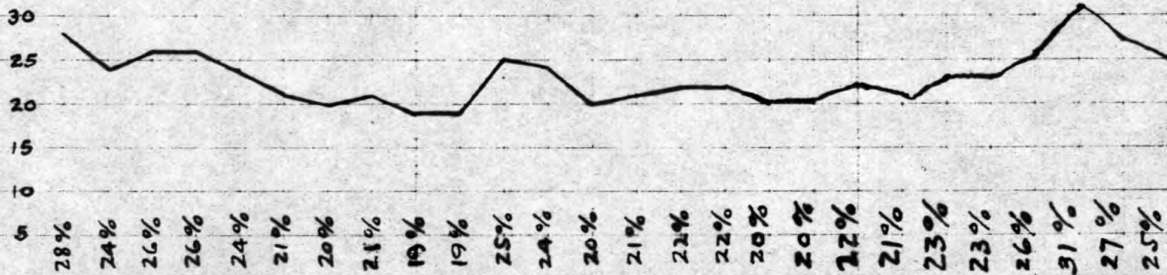
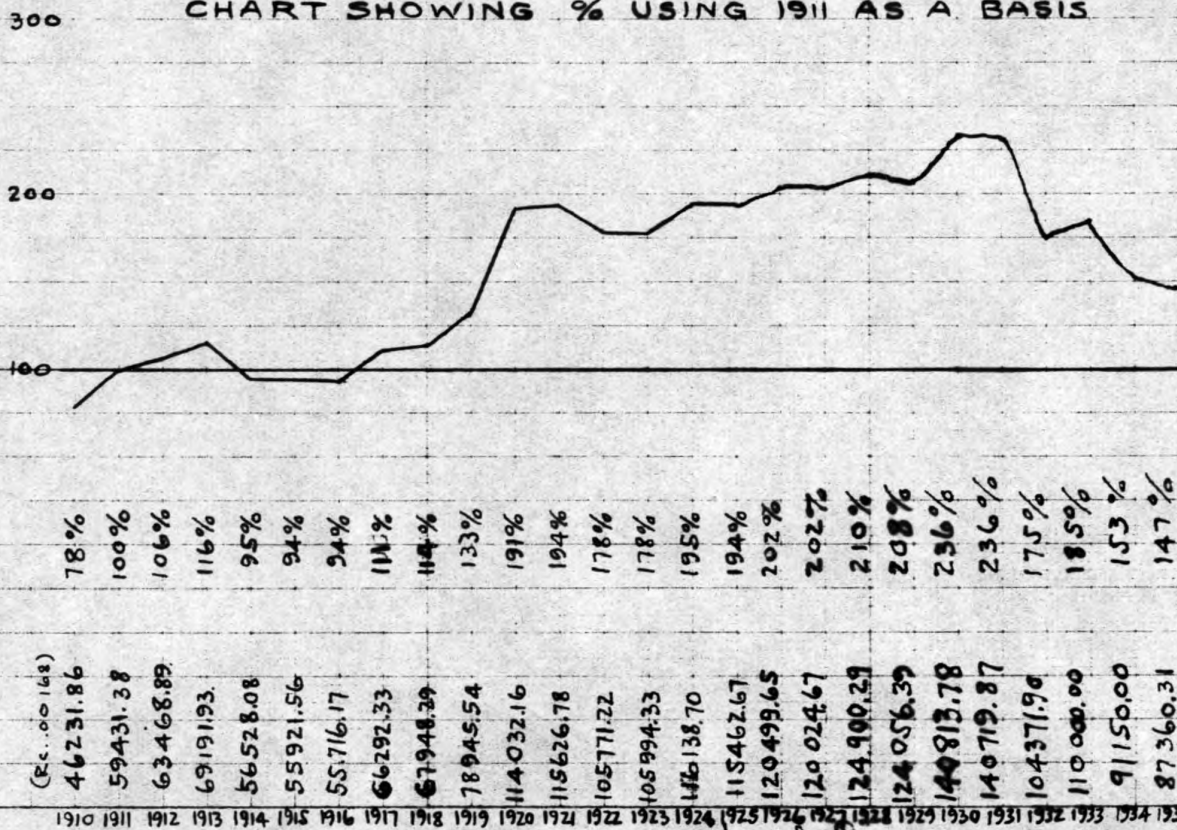


CHART SHOWING % USING 1911 AS A BASIS

REPORT OF MR. R. A. BROTHERTON FOR YEAR 1935.

SURVEYS:

A total of fifty-six surveys were made during the year to locate boundary lines, descriptions for leases and deeds, staking lots, locating and resetting corners, also location of twenty-four miles of railroad spurs on #196 Logging Operation, and eight miles on new operation on Group F. All measurements of grading finished were made and yardage of dirt computed.

FOREST FIRES:

There was a fifty percent decrease in forest fires during the year throughout Upper Michigan. Three large fires occurred during the month of May that endangered our land. The first one started May 20th and was not put out until May 23rd. This fire burned over about seventy-five acres in Section 21-44-25 and got within three hundred feet of our land in Section 16-44-25. No loss or damage on land owned by our company.

The second fire burned over about 420 acres of land in Sections 5, 6, 7, and 8-45-22. The fire started May 26th and was put out May 28th. Our land in the area of the fire was cut over some years ago on #119 Operation and what little timber left that was burnt was of small value. The greatest loss occurred to the second growth upon the area burned, which will take years to start again.



The third fire started in Section 29-46-20 and swept northward through the cut-over area in Sections 17 and 20 burning over about 1200 acres of land where the timber had been cut years ago. This fire started May 30th and was put out June 3rd and did considerable damage to small timber and second growth.

HIGH WIND:

On October 3rd a very high wind occurred coming from the Northwest, causing considerable windfall and damage to our standing timber. On #196 Logging Operation, nearly all of the large Elms and other trees left standing under the Code requirements were blown down. Logs were recovered from nearly all of the down Elm and other trees of commercial value. Many trees were down across on logging track and considerable time was spent clearing them out. Along Highway M-94 from Deer Lake to the township road south to Deerton, we counted 128 trees blown over.

LAND LOOKING:

During the year 560 acres of Michigan Mineral Land Company land were examined and reports made of land and timber. 1920 acres of The Cleveland-Cliffs Iron Company land were examined for fire loss and trespass.

FORESTRY - PINE FARM:

The work on the Pine Farm, consisting of pruning the trees, removing and thinning out of some of the defective and trees of poor growth, rebuilding the fence, and constructing fire lanes under the instruction of Mr. W. F. Ramsdell, Pack Professor of Forest Land Management, was completed during the summer. The work was done by Mr. Thole, Forester in Charge, with labor from the Big Bay C.C.C. Camp, at no cost to our company.

LAKE FRONTAGE:

No additional lake frontage was staked out this year as there was little inquiry for same.

REFINANCING:

Considerable time was spent during October and November making descriptions, acreage and maps of lands owned by The Cleveland-Cliffs Iron Company.

UNITED STATES FOREST EXPERIMENTAL STATION LOGGING:

No new cutting was done during the year and Contractor Marjaniemi finished the loading out of the forest material cut during the fall of 1934 and January 1935 in April. Following is a complete report of this operation:

Description and Cutting of this Operation:

The total area cut is 55 acres. About 43 acres is a mixed hardwood-conifer forest and the balance is swamp. The method of cutting proposed is in the nature of an improvement cutting, only the most over-matured trees were cut and practically all the merchantable Spruce and Balsam pulpwood, the Cedar of which a considerable amount is dead, will be made into 7-ft. lagging. All of the sound green Cedar will be made into ties.

LOGGING OPERATIONS:

OPERATION NO. 154

Camp 6 was operated on this Job until June 14th, 1935, when all timber was cut except some land adjacent to the AuTrain Power House and Forest Lake Location. The crew at this camp averaged one hundred men, twenty teams, two tractors on sleigh haul, two loaders, cutting timber from Sections 29, 30, 31, and 32-46-20. Upon the completion of this job in June the camp crew and equipment was moved to Camp 8, 196 Job. Cutting was done on this Job under the Code requirements until May 27th, 1935, when all codes were abolished and we went back to our old method of clean cutting. Map of the area cut, charts showing logging cost, production, and efficiency are attached and following is a complete summary of the job from its start.

OPERATION NO. 196

Camp 7 was operated the entire year with two loader operating units and due to shortage of chemical logs it was necessary to operate Camp 8 with a one loader operating unit. This Camp was opened on February 4th and operated as a one loader camp until June 15th, when the crew was moved to Camp 9 and the crew from Camp 6 - 154 Operation took over the camp and operated a two loader unit. Camp 9 operated a one loader unit from June 15th to December 31st.

All camps were operated thirty-four hours per week from January 1st to January 23rd, forty hours per week January 23rd to June 30th, and 48 hours per week from July 1st to December 31st, 1935. All cutting on this Job was done under the Code requirements until May 27th when all codes were abolished and we went back to our old method of clean cutting.
