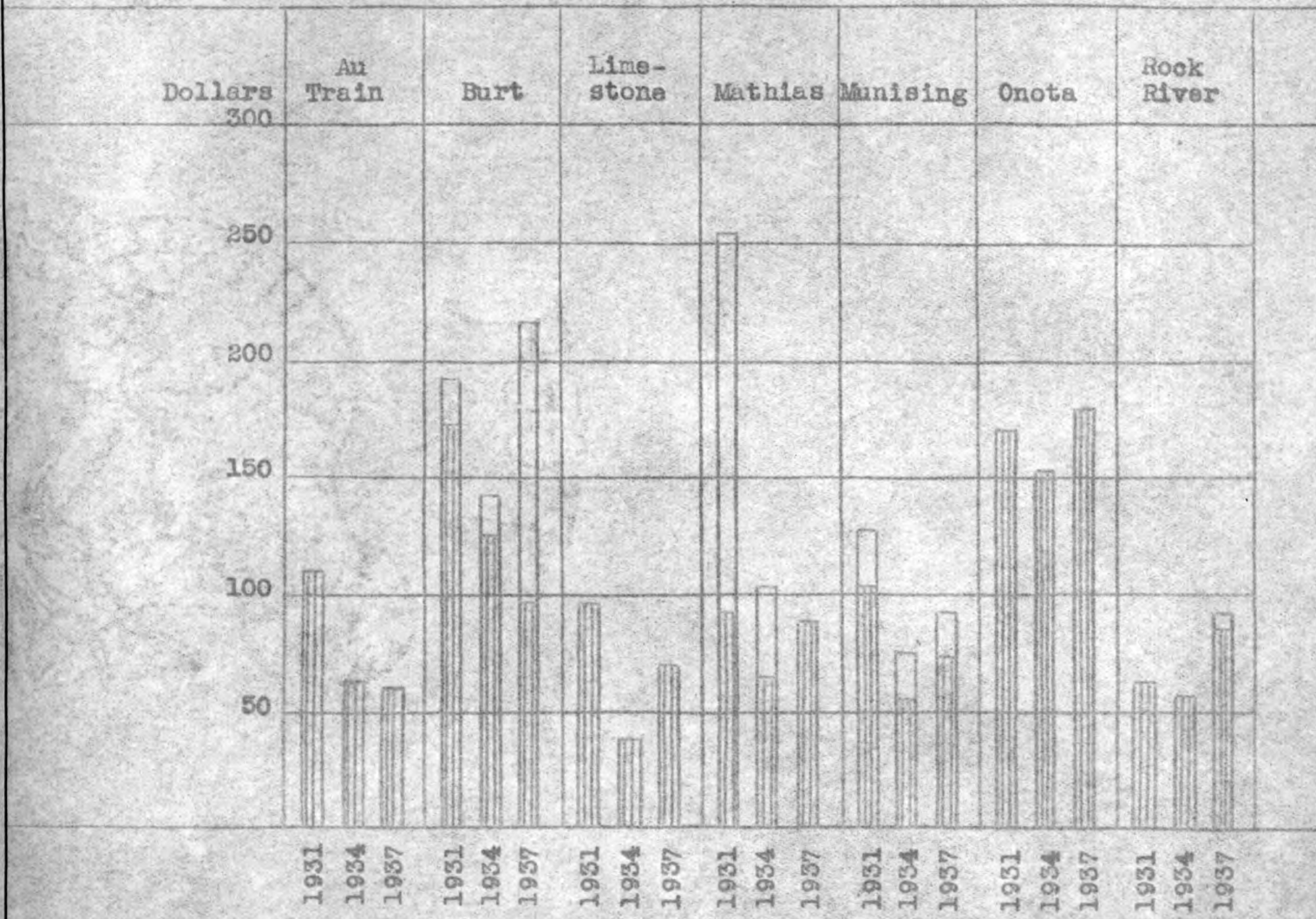

MAPLE SYRUP

During the year we made 630 $\frac{1}{2}$  gallons of Maple Syrup compared with 600 gallons in 1936.

ROADS

Only the regular work of maintenance was done on these roads by the Company during the year. The County Road Commission of Alger County used some W.P.A. labor on some of these roads at no expense to the Company.

### DOCKS

We completely rebuilt the dock at the Hotel during the year at a cost of \$800.21. During the coming winter it is going to be necessary to make extensive repairs to the merchandise dock.

### BOATS

The large boat "Ottawa" was in commission during the time the Hotel was open. We also purchased 8 new row boats during the year and 2 outboard motor boats.

### AUTOMOBILES

We purchased two new Chevrolet Carryalls to replace old cars worn out and these were in service during the time the Hotel was open.

### EXPENSES

The following statements give a report of the expenses and revenues of the Island for the years 1937, 1936, and 1935.

### WORK DONE FOR OTHER DEPARTMENTS:

During the year we prepared for the Mining Department lot contracts covering 8 sales of West Ishpeming lots, 3 of Gwinn lots, 8 contracts covering sales of houses in the New Addition, Negaunee, 16 contracts covering sales of houses at Ishpeming, Republic, and Gwinn, and in addition thereto, we prepared 5 bills of sale for miscellaneous houses and 3 covering New Addition houses.

In addition thereto, we are looking after collections of the various house and sales accounts and the rental of the lots in the New Addition, including those held by The Negaunee Mine Company.

We also spend considerable time preparing documents and doing other work in connection with the acquisition of land near the Athens Mine from The Duluth, South Shore and Atlantic Railway Company.

### LABOR:

On May 24th, 1937, our woods operations and the woodworking plant at Munising were tied up for two weeks due to a general strike of woods and sawmill workers which extended throughout the Upper Peninsula of Michigan. This labor strike and situation has been the subject of numerous reports to the Cleveland Office.

On February 23rd, we attended a meeting of the Alger County Board of Supervisors, called for the purpose of discussing the financial affairs of the County and to act on a suggested increase of the County's millage. After considerable discussion by members of the Board and the taxpayers present, the Board voted to drop the question of increasing the millage and to continue to run the County's affairs as at present.

During the year, we have made frequent checks of the County treasurers' records to ascertain the amount of delinquent taxes outstanding on lot leases, which our tenants are required to pay. The first check, about the first of the year, showed the amount to be \$10,077.27. We immediately notified the tenants in our various locations to pay these taxes to the County treasurers. The last check shows the amount reduced to \$4,007.06. We are keeping after this item and expect to see this amount materially reduced before the tax sale on May 3rd, 1938.



A careful check of the delinquent tax lands of the Superior Realty Company was made and it was agreed to pay all back taxes where the timber and agriculture values might warrant the expenditure. On August 25th, a payment was made as follows:

Attached plats show lands upon which The Cleveland-Cliffs Iron Company owns the timber only and the final dates for the removal of same.

LANDS OWNED AND CONTROLLED - ACREAGE STATEMENT:

Attached statement shows acreages as of December 31st, 1937, owned by the various companies under Land Department supervision and Lands Owned and Controlled shows lands under control of the Land and Mining Departments.

LANDS PURCHASED:

No purchases made during the year.

TRESPASSES:

The total amount collected for trespasses during the year was \$405.07.

ANNUAL TAX SALES:

No tax sale was held this year and none since 1932. The next sale will be held on May 3rd, 1938.

The Michigan Legislature passed several tax laws, giving relief to the delinquent taxpayers as follows:

1. 1932 and prior years taxes can be paid in ten annual installments with interest at the rate of 4%. This law went into effect September 1st, 1935.
2. 1933, 1934, and 1935 can be paid in ten annual installments, commencing September 1st, 1937, with collection fee of 2% provided 1936 taxes are paid in full.

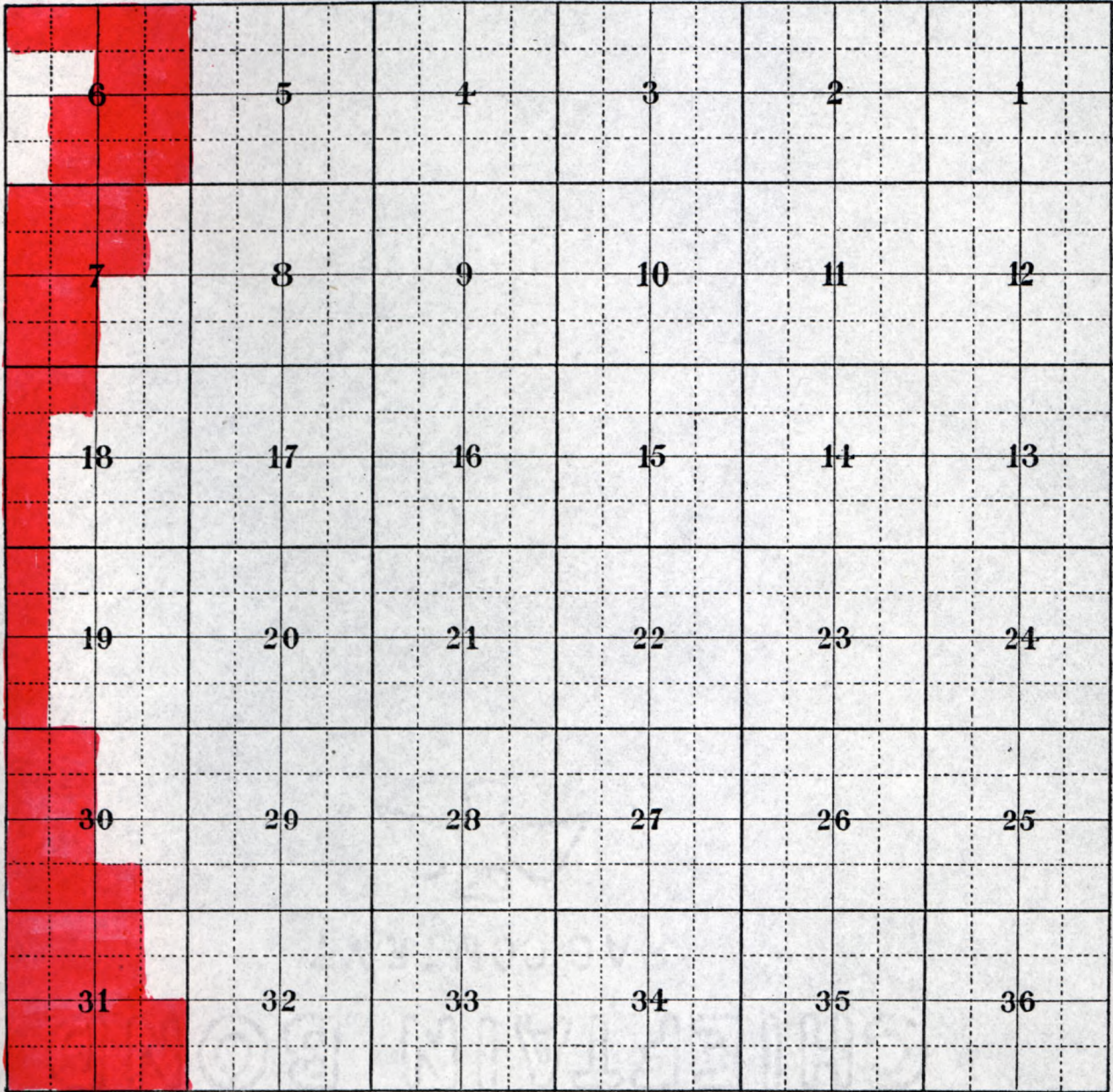

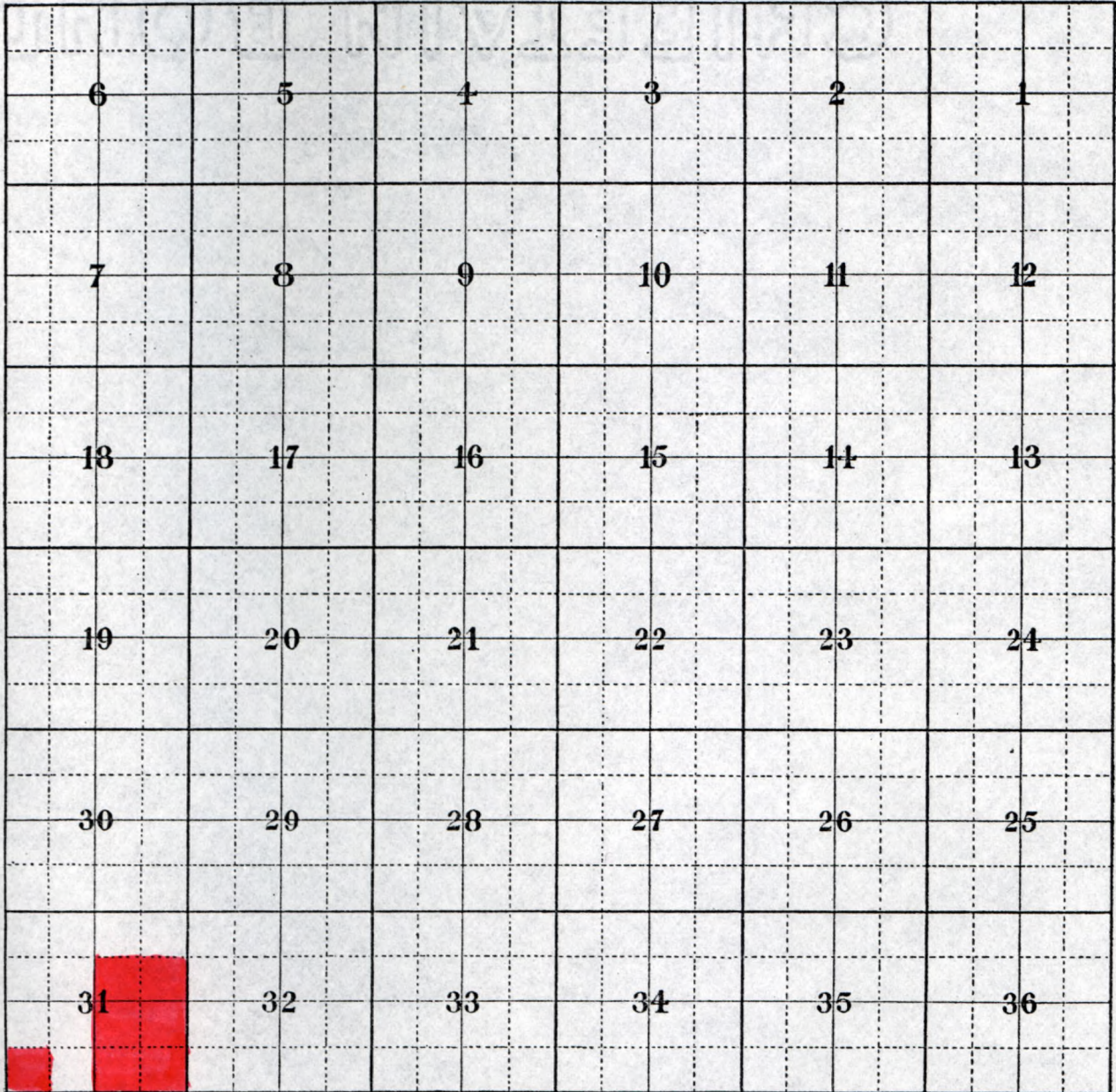

COUNTY, STATE OF



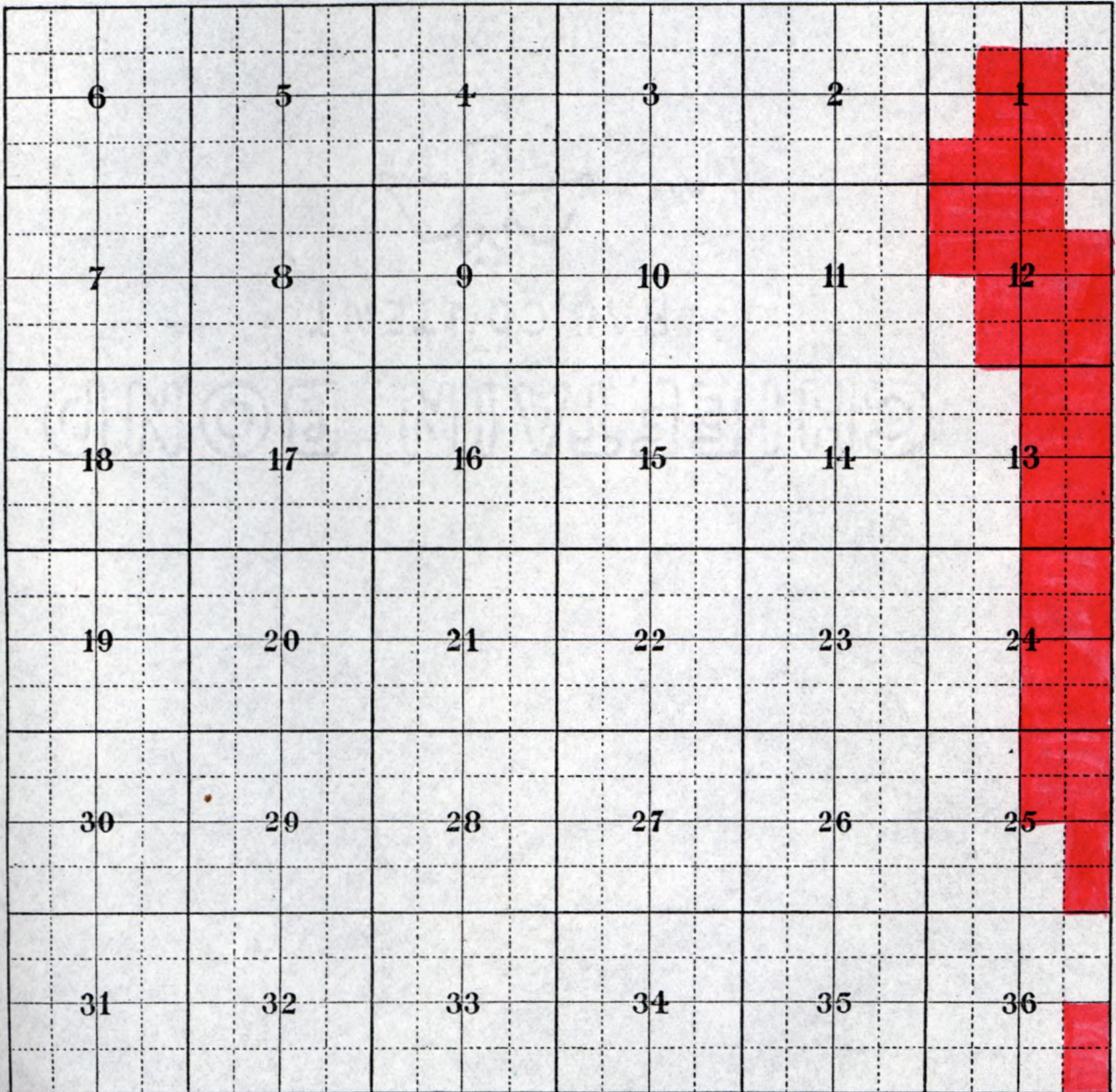


# DIAGRAM

COUNTY, STATE OF



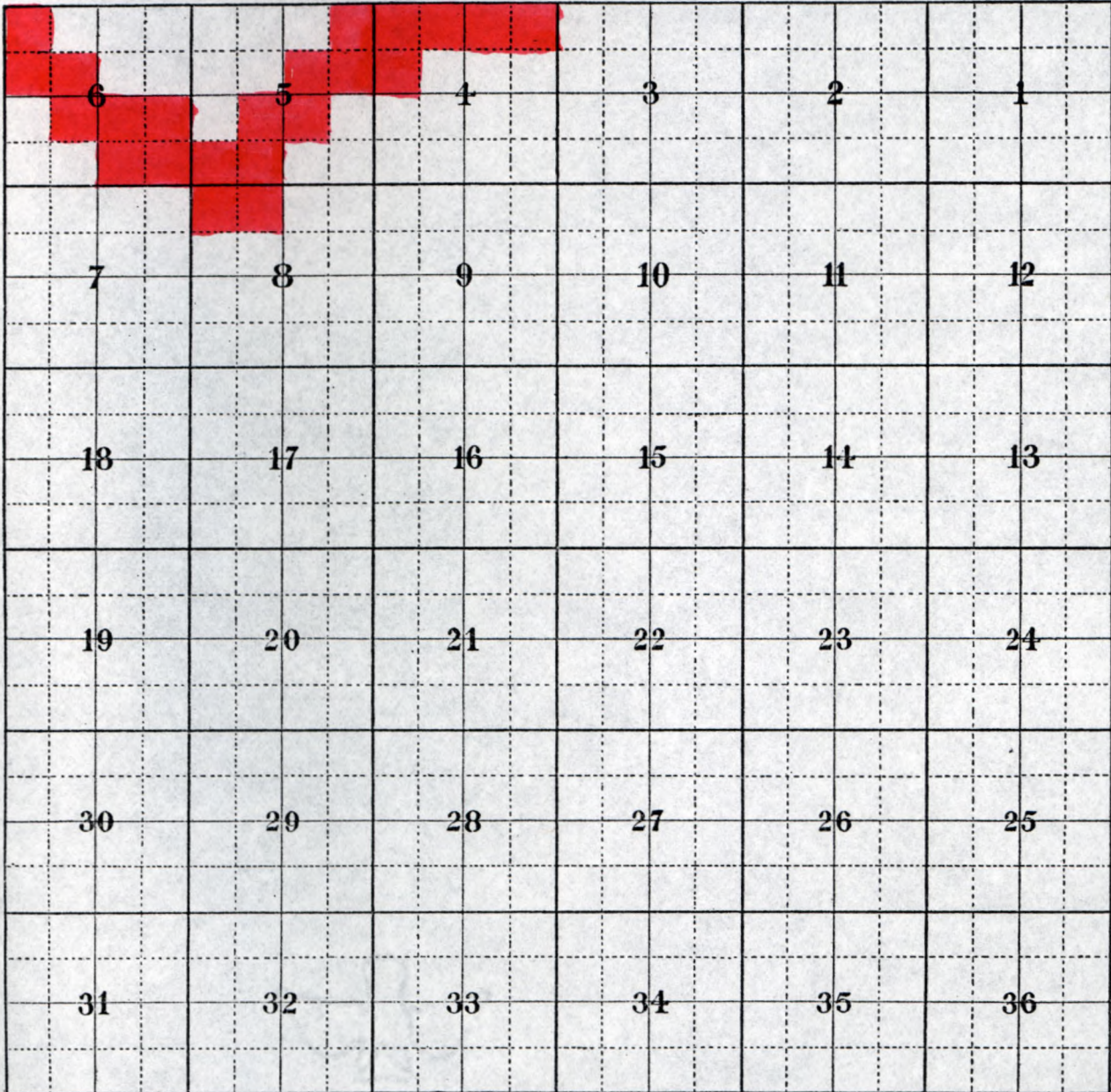


# DIAGRAM

COUNTY, STATE OF



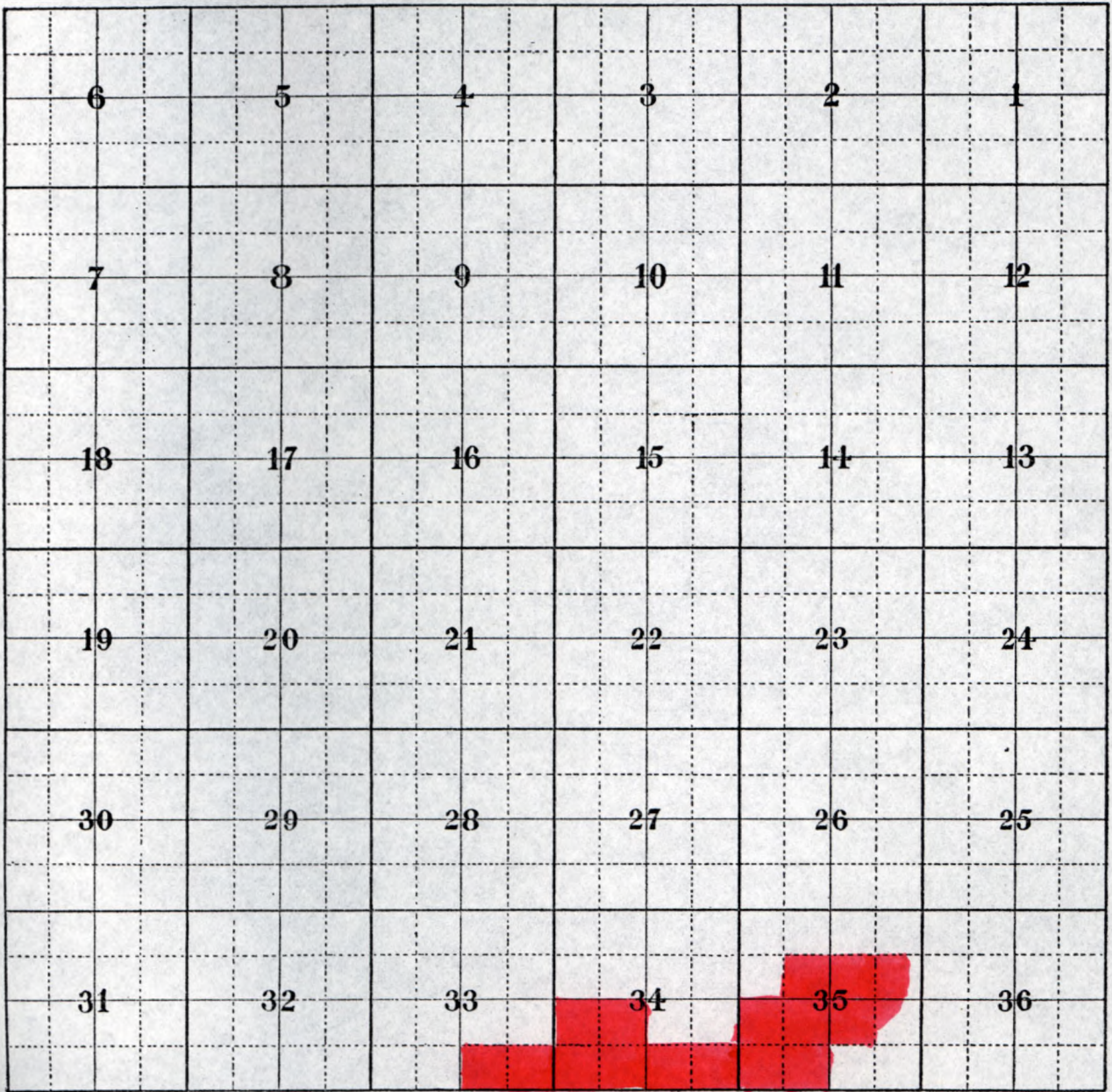

COUNTY, STATE OF



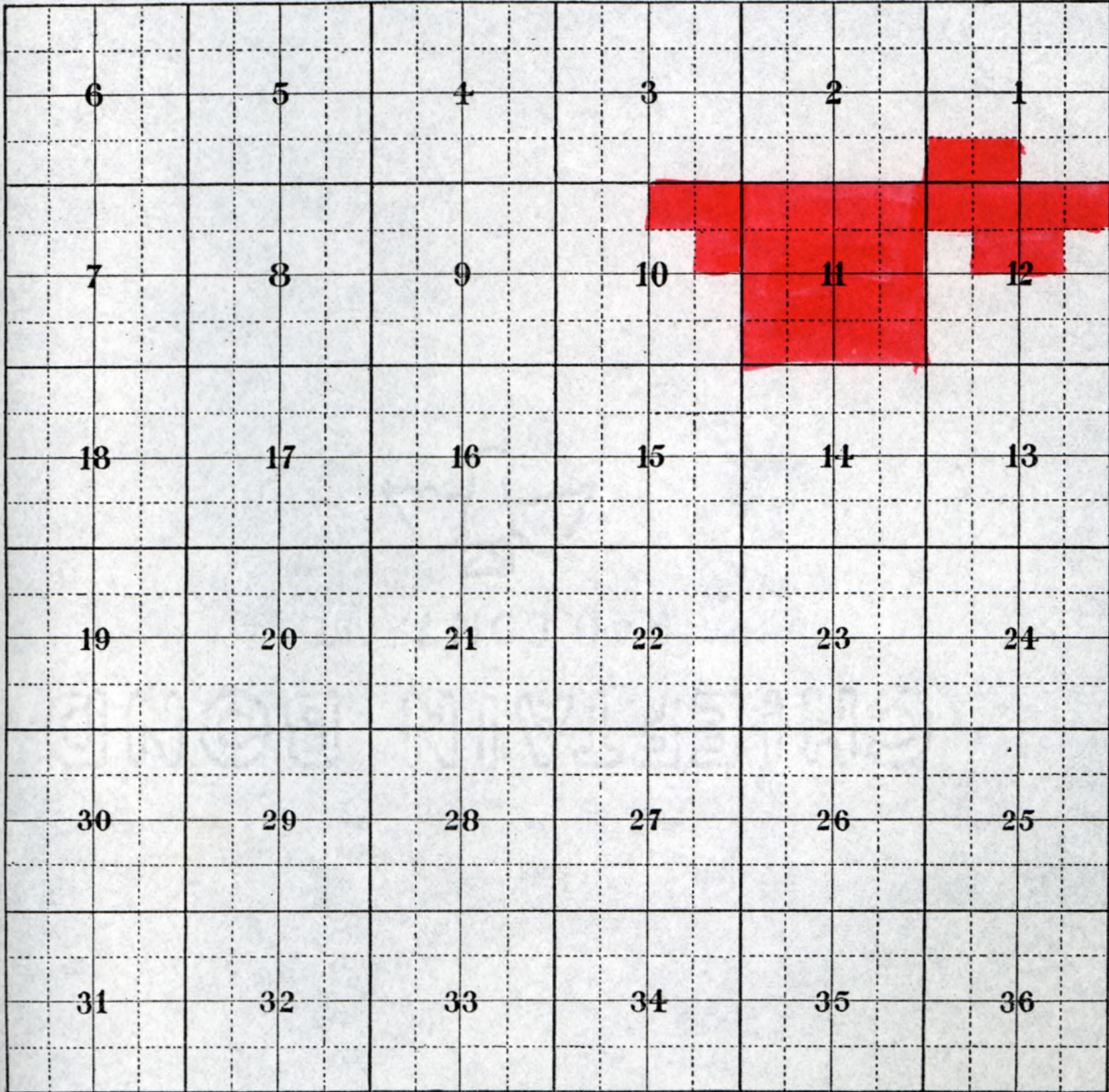


# DIAGRAM

COUNTY, STATE OF



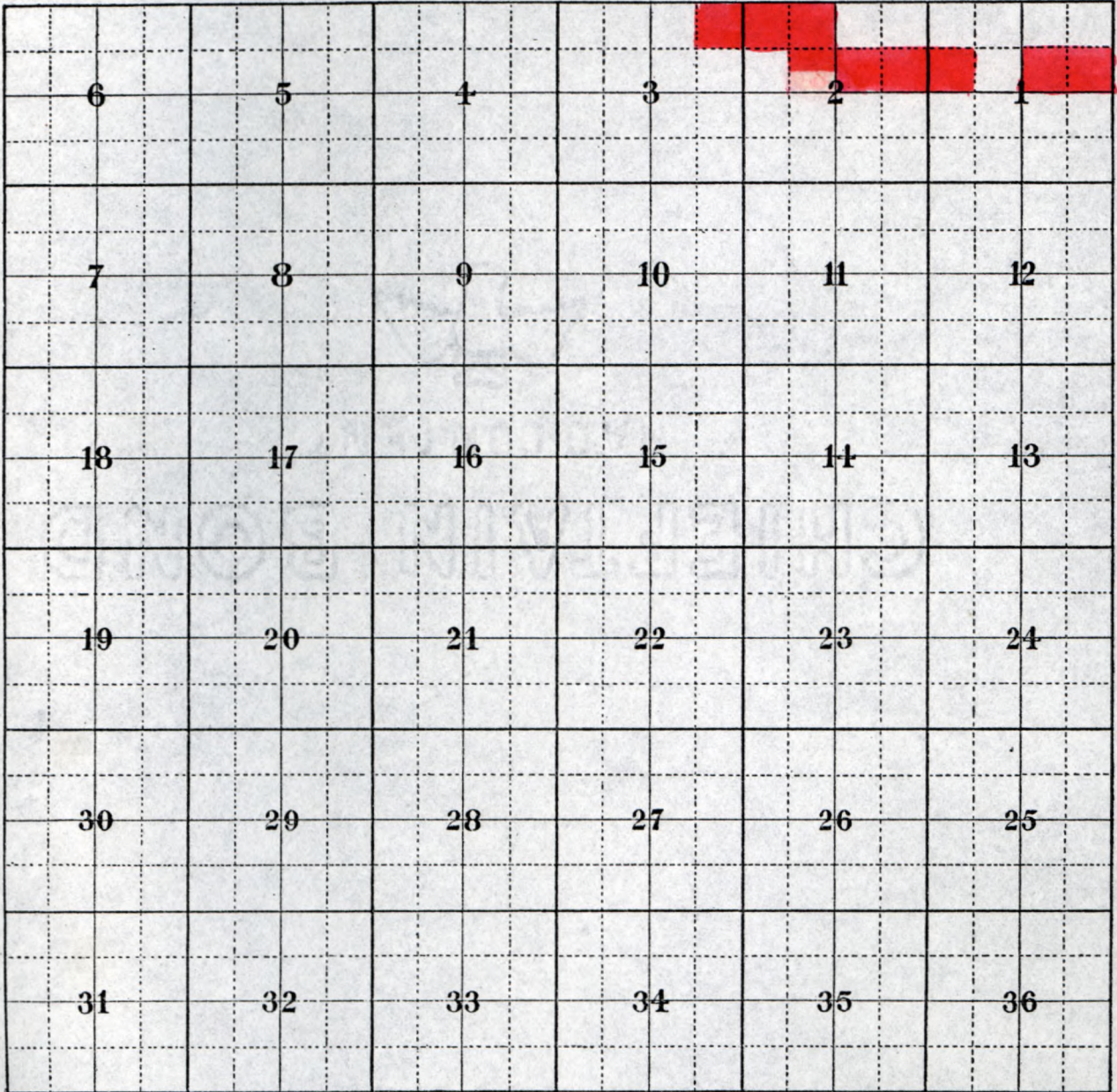

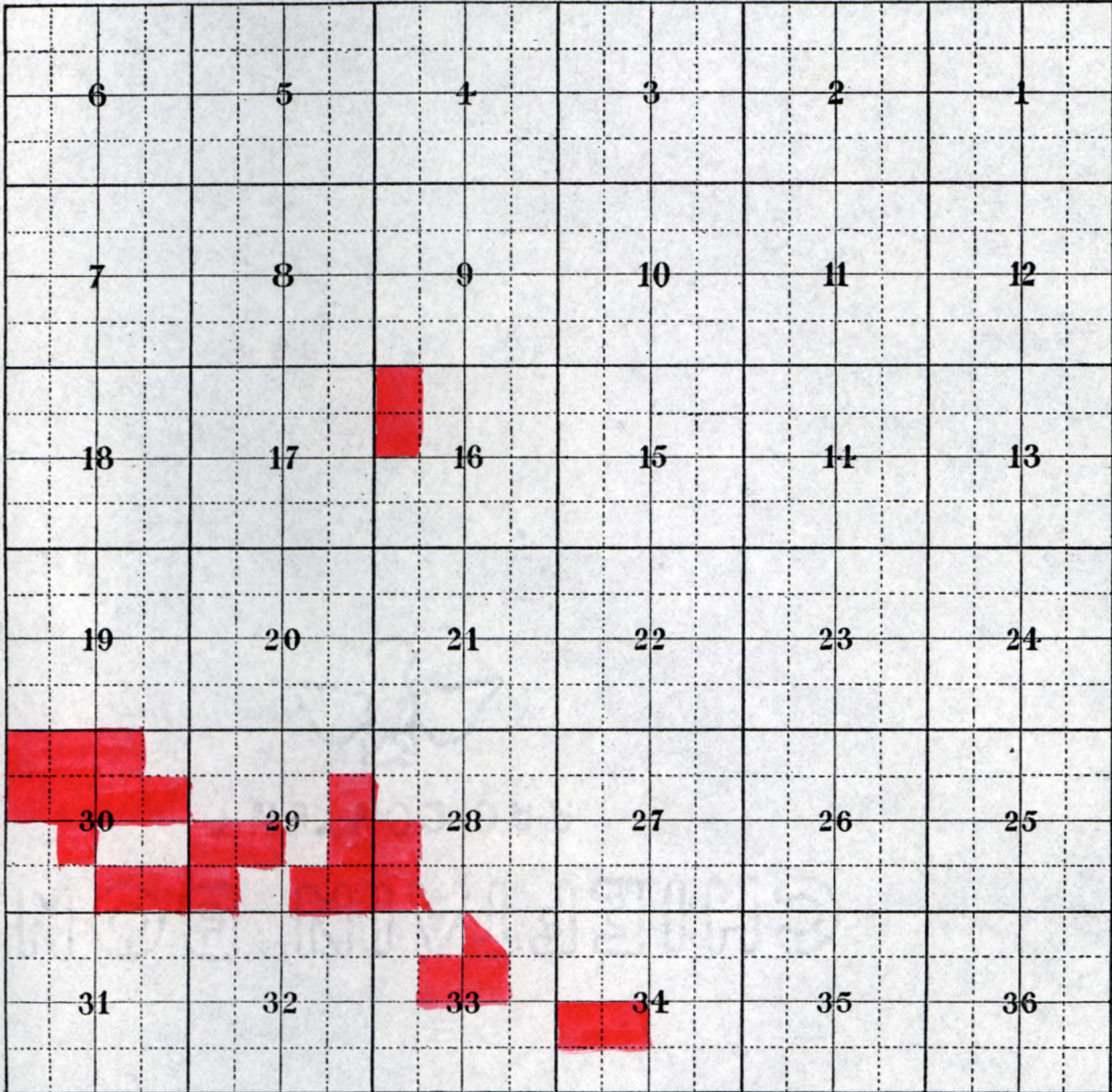

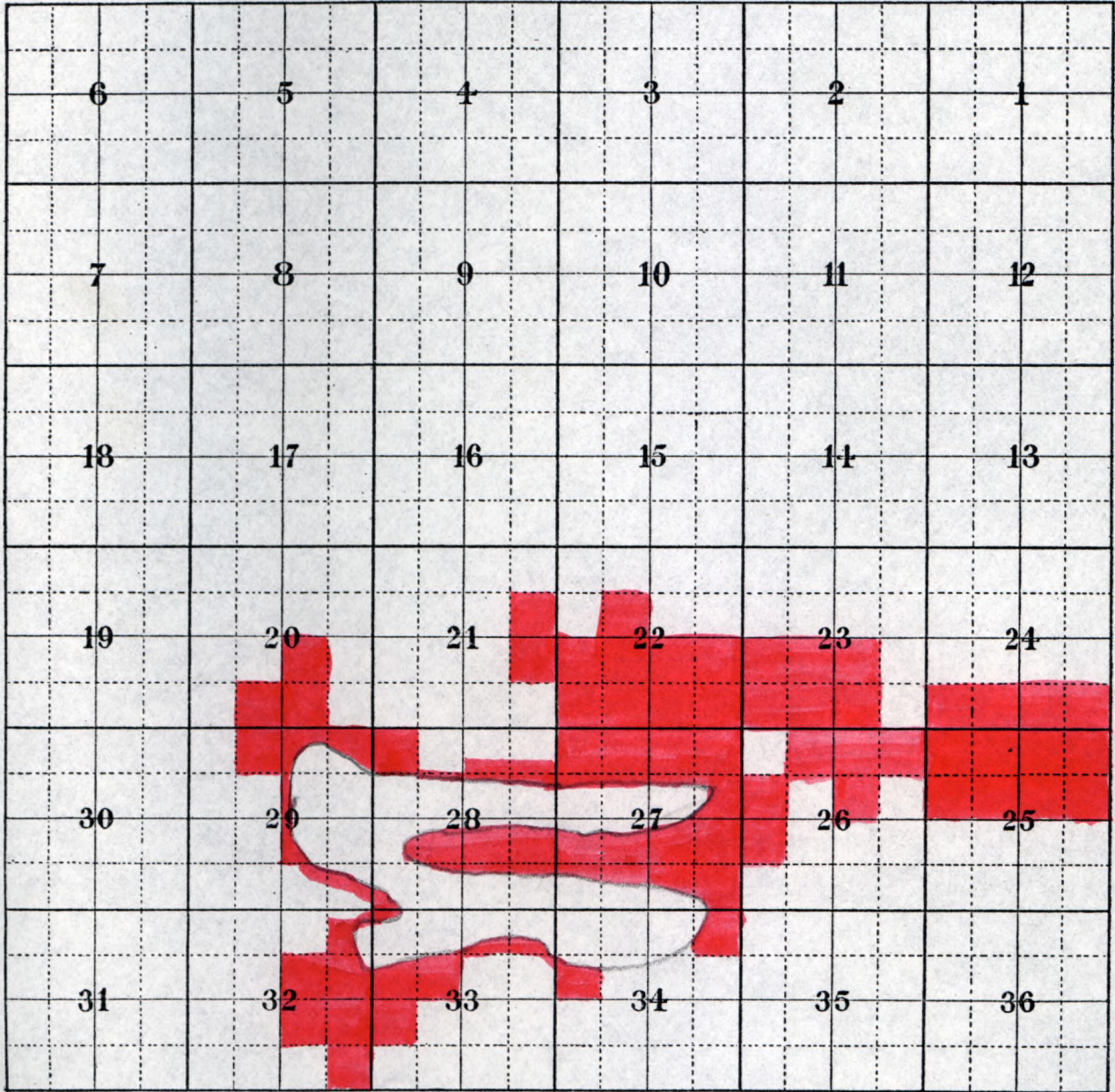

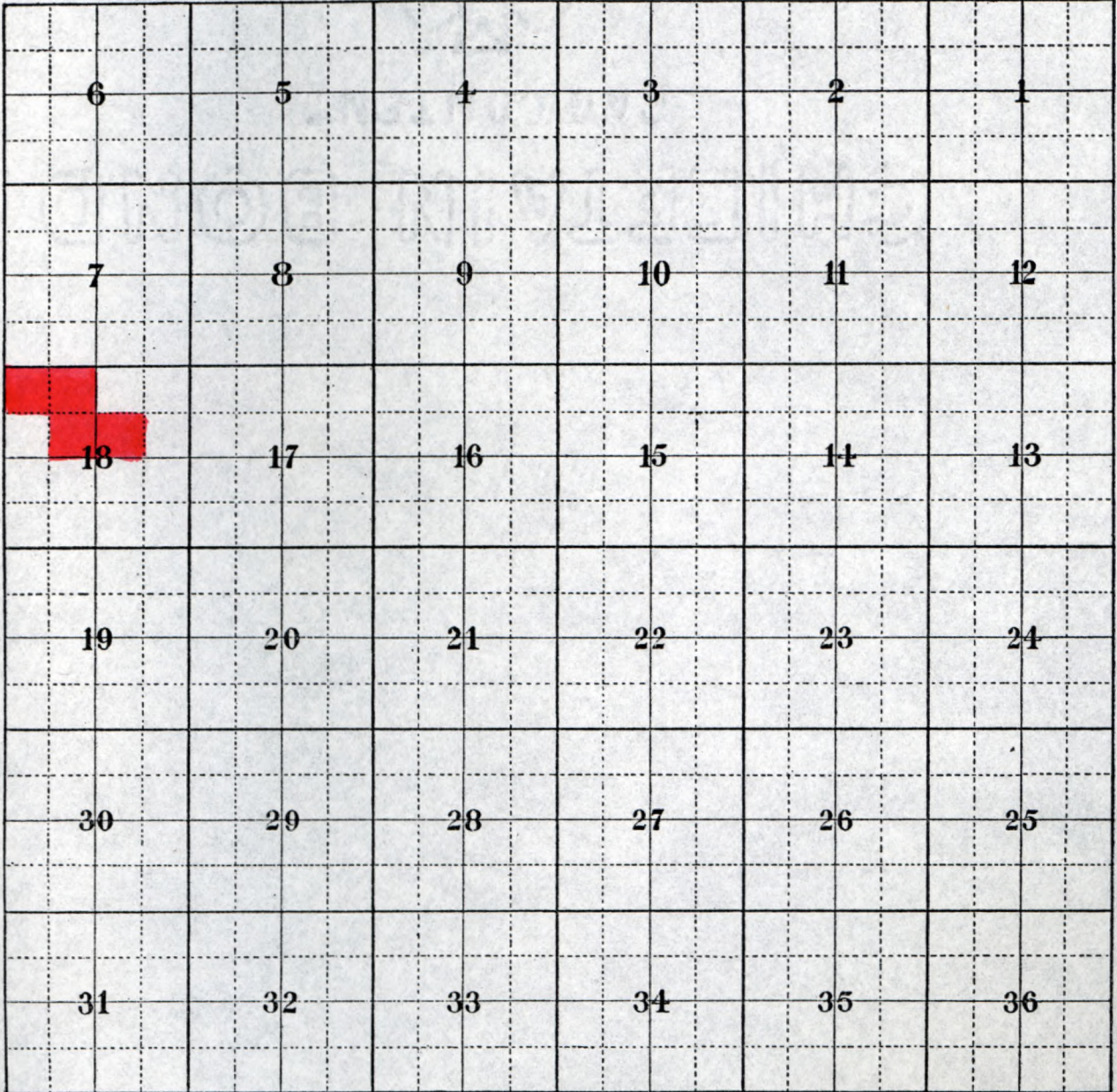

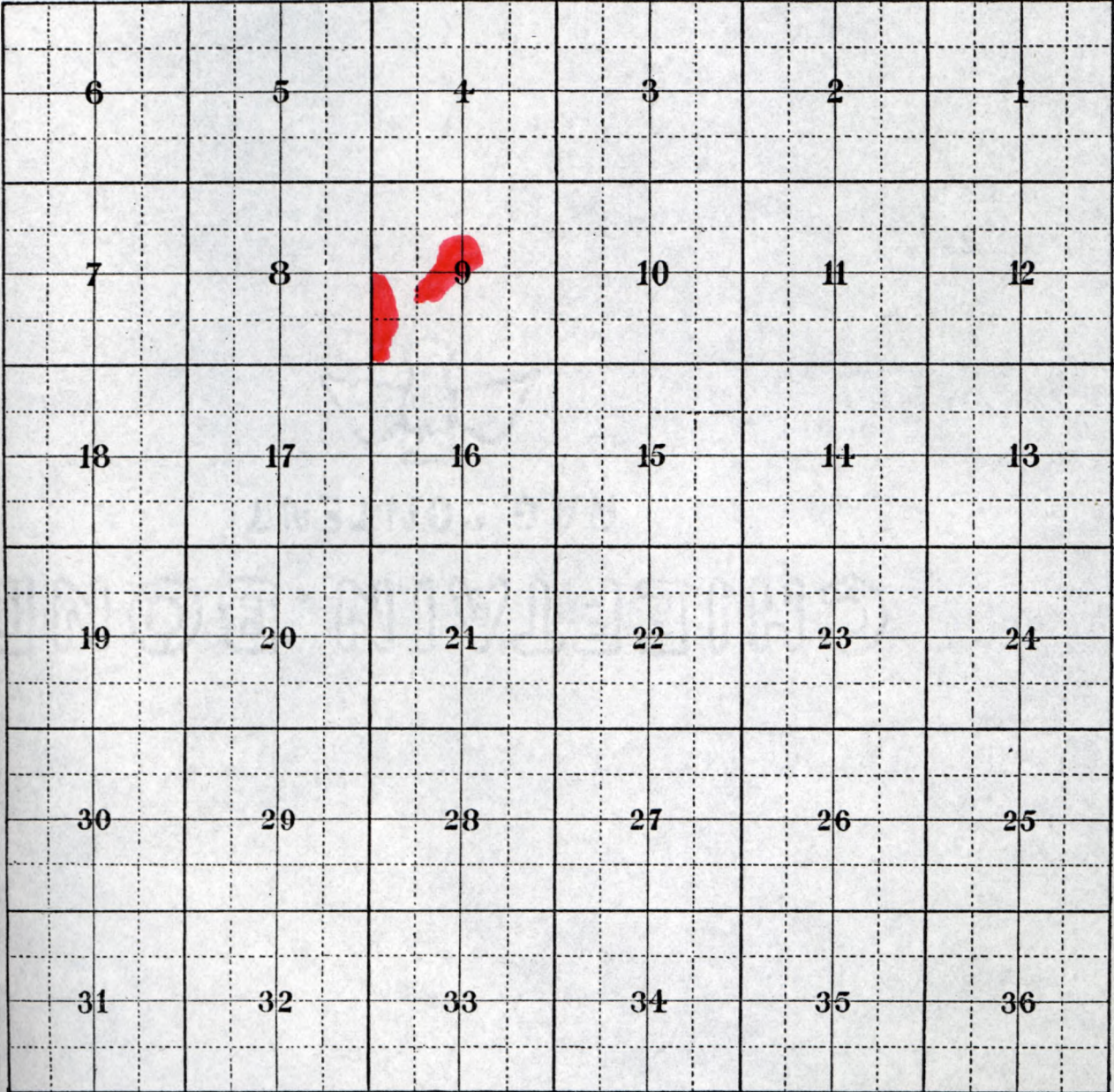

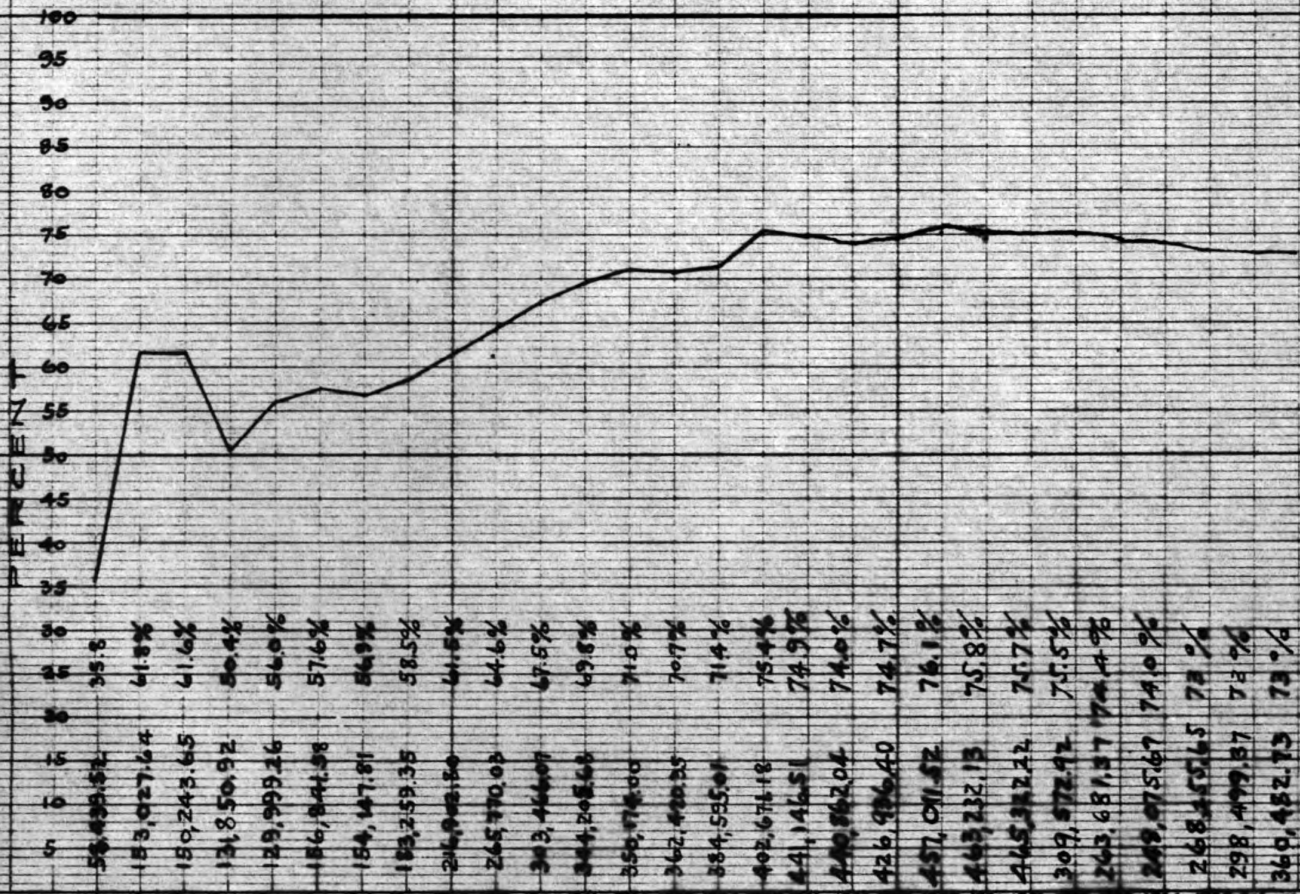

CHART SHOWING THE PERCENT OF THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF TAXES RAISED PAID BY G.C.I.CO.



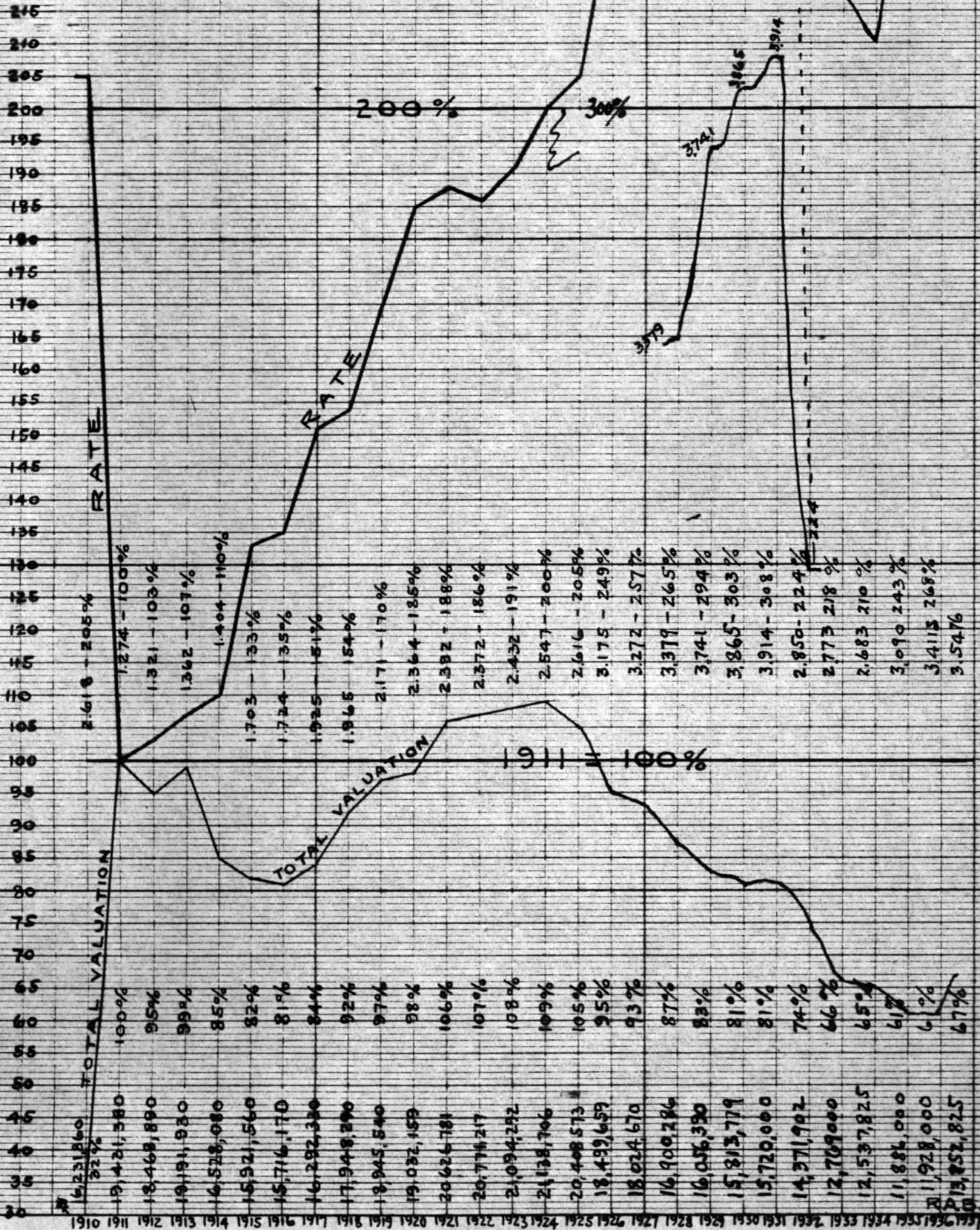

CHART SHOWING RATE PERCENT OF TOTAL TAX PAID

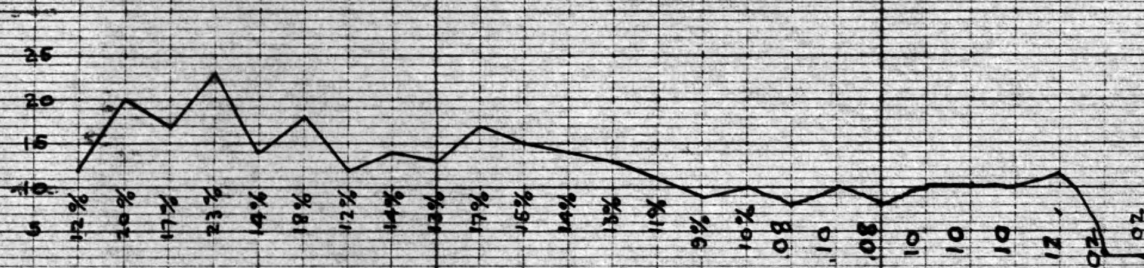
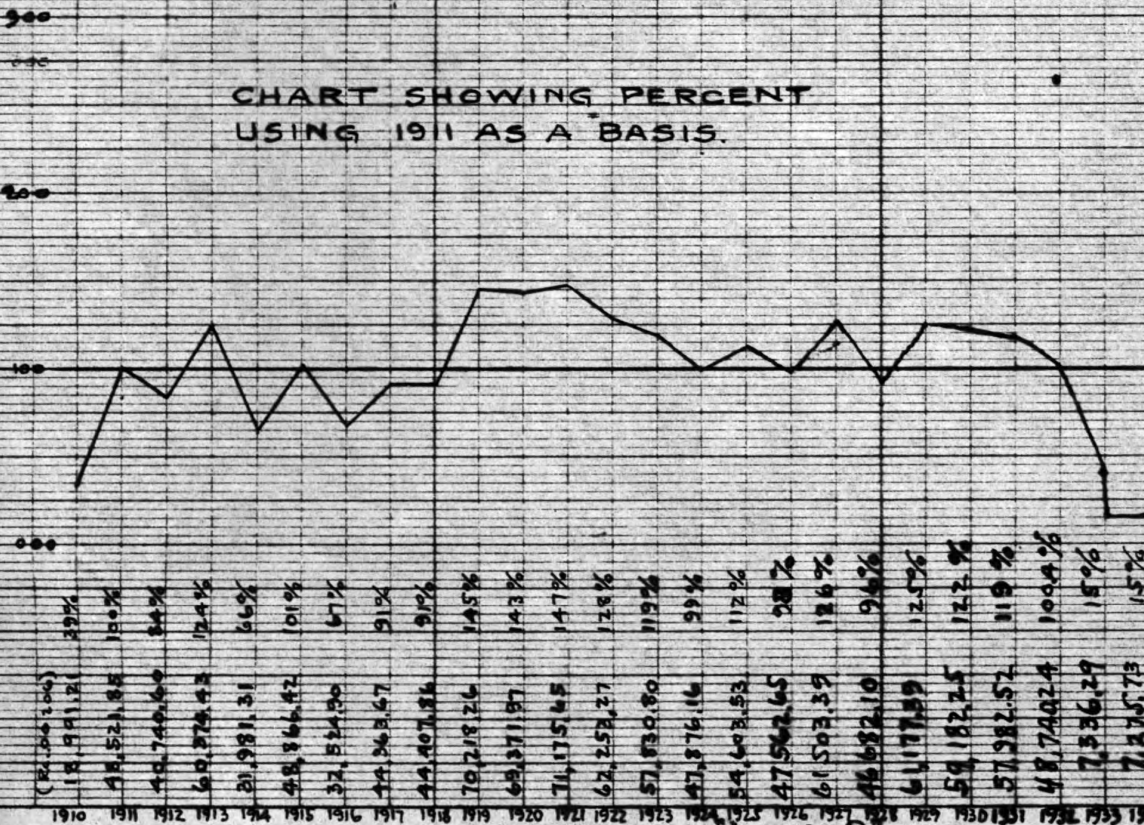


CHART SHOWING PERCENT USING 1911 AS A BASIS.

CHART SHOWING % OF TOTAL TAX PAID

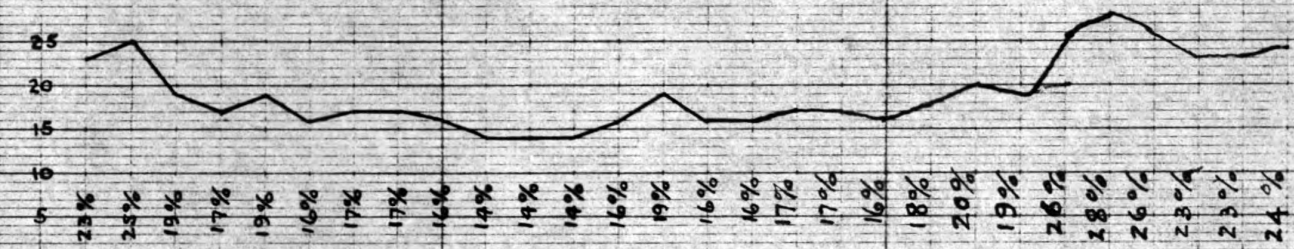
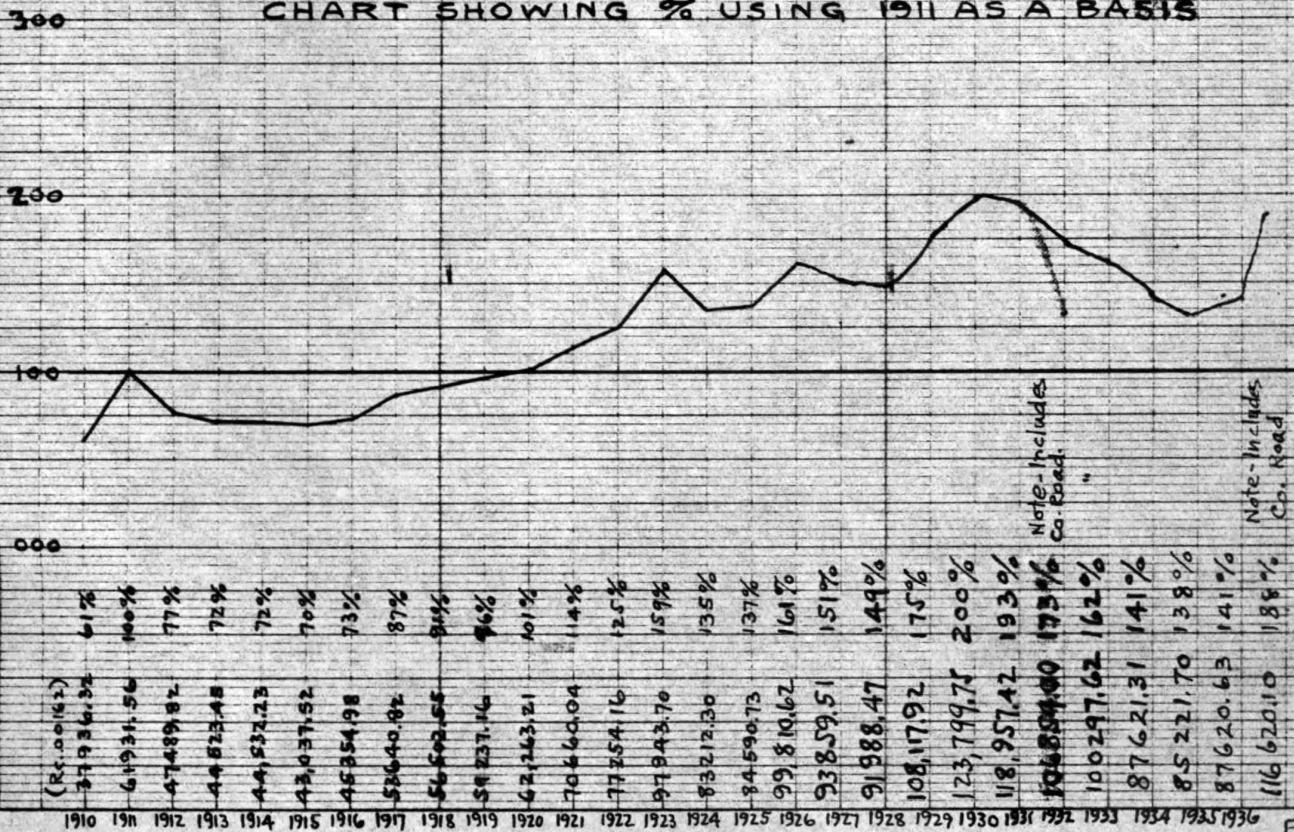


CHART SHOWING % USING 1911 AS A BASIS

CHART SHOWING % OF TOTAL TAX PAID.

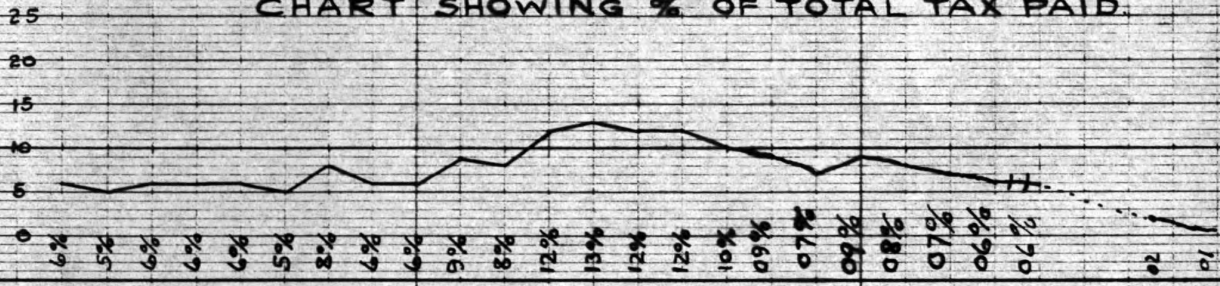
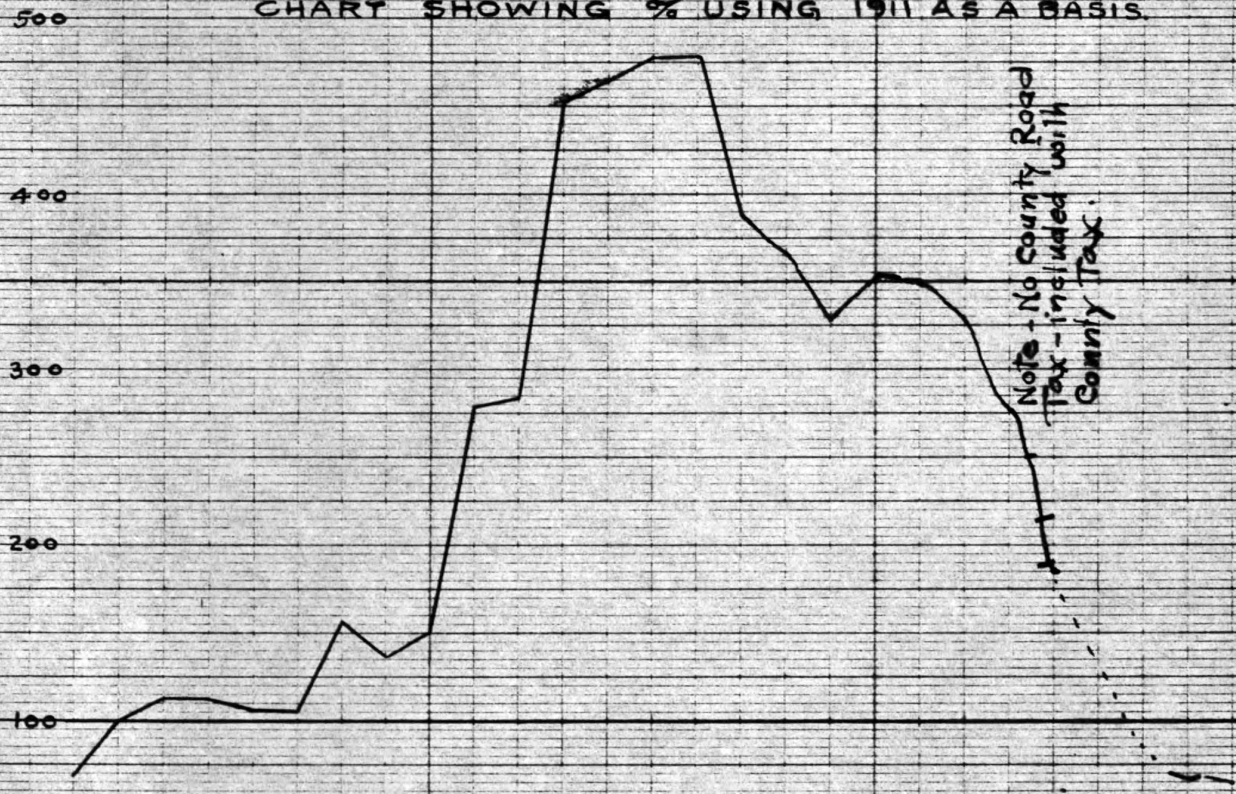

CHART SHOWING % OF TOTAL TAX PAID

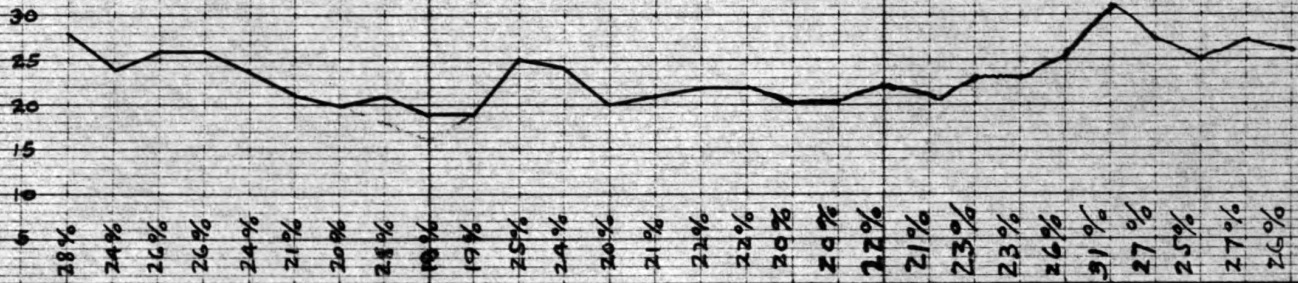
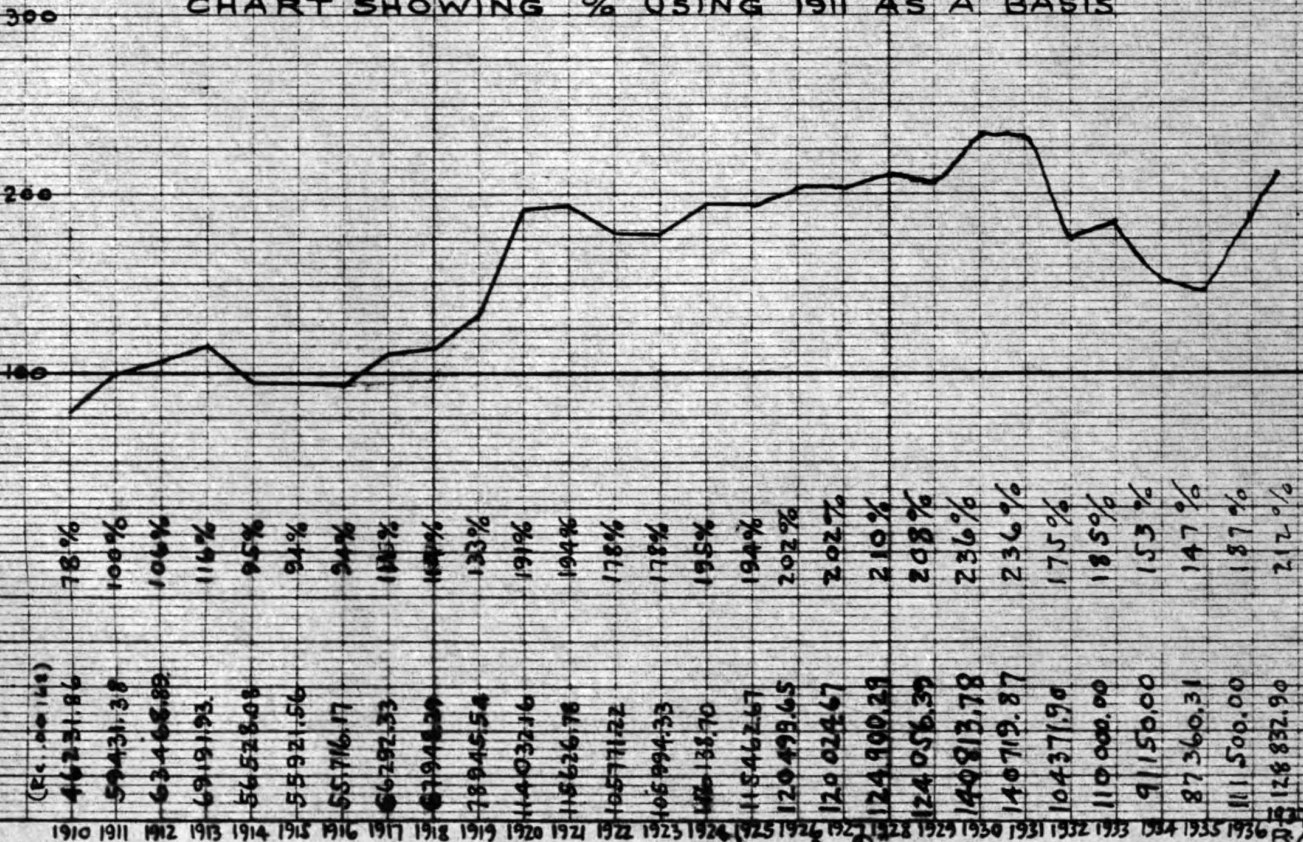


CHART SHOWING % USING 1911 AS A BASIS

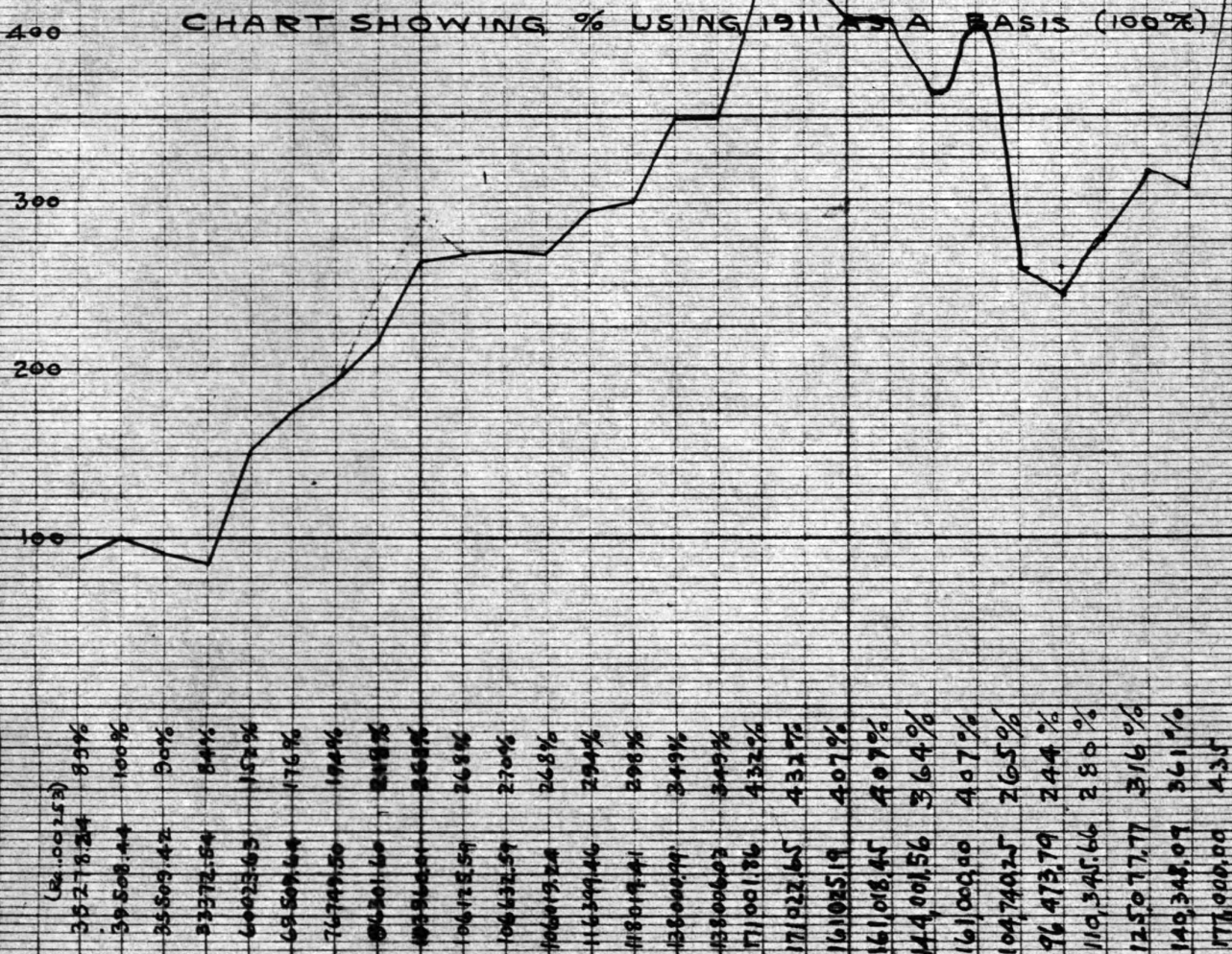
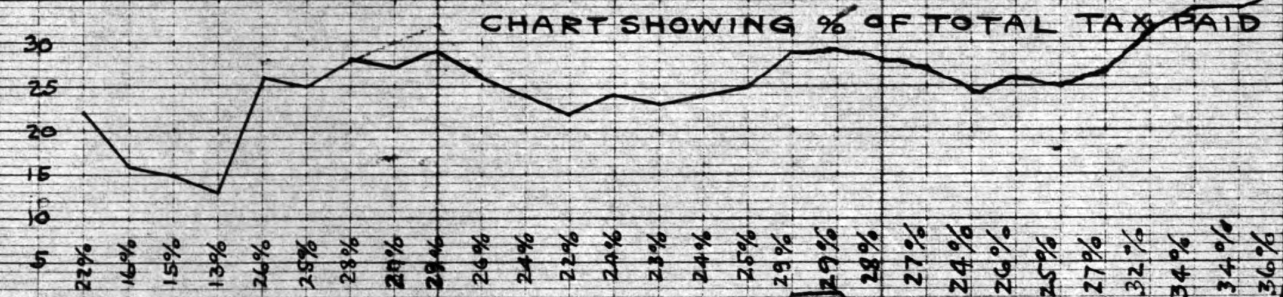

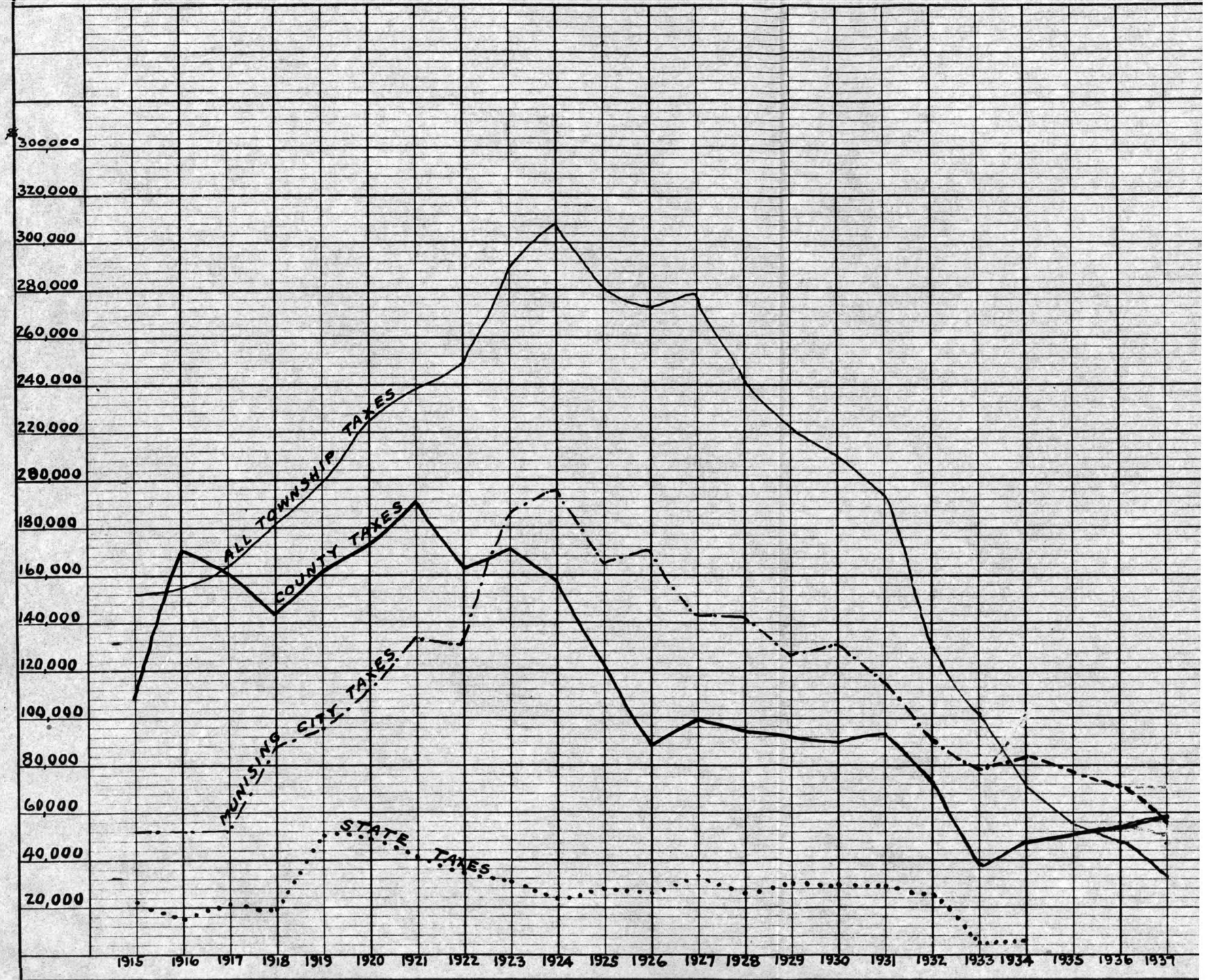

REPORT OF MR. R. A. BROTHERTON FOR YEAR 1937.

SURVEYS:

A total of 56 surveys were made during the year to locate boundary lines, descriptions for leases and deeds, staking lots, locating and resetting corners, and location of 20.5 miles of railroad spurs on Logging Operation #203. 16.93 miles of this railroad surveyed were graded and steel laid on 24.93 miles; also 27.15 miles were lifted from Job #196. All measurements of grading, yardage removed, steel laid and lifted were made.

FOREST FIRES:

None occurred on our land to cause any loss; one fire in slashing on Section 32-47-17 on August 23rd but was put out before doing any damage to standing timber.

LAND LOOKING:

A total of 12,050 acres of land were examined in Upper Michigan and Minnesota, also 14 days were spent checking lands operated by jobbers and 8 days on trespasses.

FORESTRY PINE FARM:

No work was done on this project during the year but an inspection was made by Professor W. F. Ramsdell and Professor Young of the University of Michigan.



LAKE FRONTAGE:

No additional lake frontage was surveyed during the year but the land on Johnson Lake was restaked and a few lots sold.

UNITED STATES FOREST EXPERIMENTAL STATION LOGGING - DUKES, MICHIGAN:

A contract was made with Seeli Marjaniemi to selectively log 60 acres of land in the Northwest quarter of Section 35-46-23, and it is expected to cut 90 M feet of logs and 270 cords of chemical wood. He started this work in December but will not finish until March 1st, 1938, so a later report will be made at that time.

LOGGING OPERATIONS:

OPERATION NO. 196:

Camp 7 was operated continuously with two loader units, cutting timber from Sections 19, 29, and 30, 47-17, and 25-47-18, cutting a total of 551 acres, and was moved on July 22nd to Operation #203 - Camp 11.

Camp 8 was operated continuously with two loader units, cutting timber from Sections 18 and 19, 47-17, and 13, 14, 23, 25, and 26, 47-18, cutting a total of 222 acres, and was moved to Operation #203, Camp 10, on May 1st.

Camp 9 operated continuously, except during the strike, with one loader unit, cutting timber on Sections 22, 28, 30, and 32, 47-17, cutting a total of 410 acres, and on November 27th was moved to Operation #203, Camp 12.

OPERATION NO. 203:

Camp 10 - Operations were started from this camp on May 1st and two loaders were operated continuously except during the strike, cutting a total of 679 acres from Sections 22, 23, 28, 29, 32, and 33, 47-18.

Camp 11 - Operations were started from this Camp on July 22nd and two loaders were operated continuously, except during the strike, cutting a total of 415 acres of timber from Sections 1 and 2, 46-18.

Camp 9 - Operations were started from this camp on November 27th, and a total of 38 acres were cut on Section 8-46-18.

Three shower bath cars and one hospital car were constructed during the year; also elevated water storage tanks were added to each camp unit.

Maps of area cut, charts showing the logging cost, production, cost of meals, and labor efficiency are attached.
