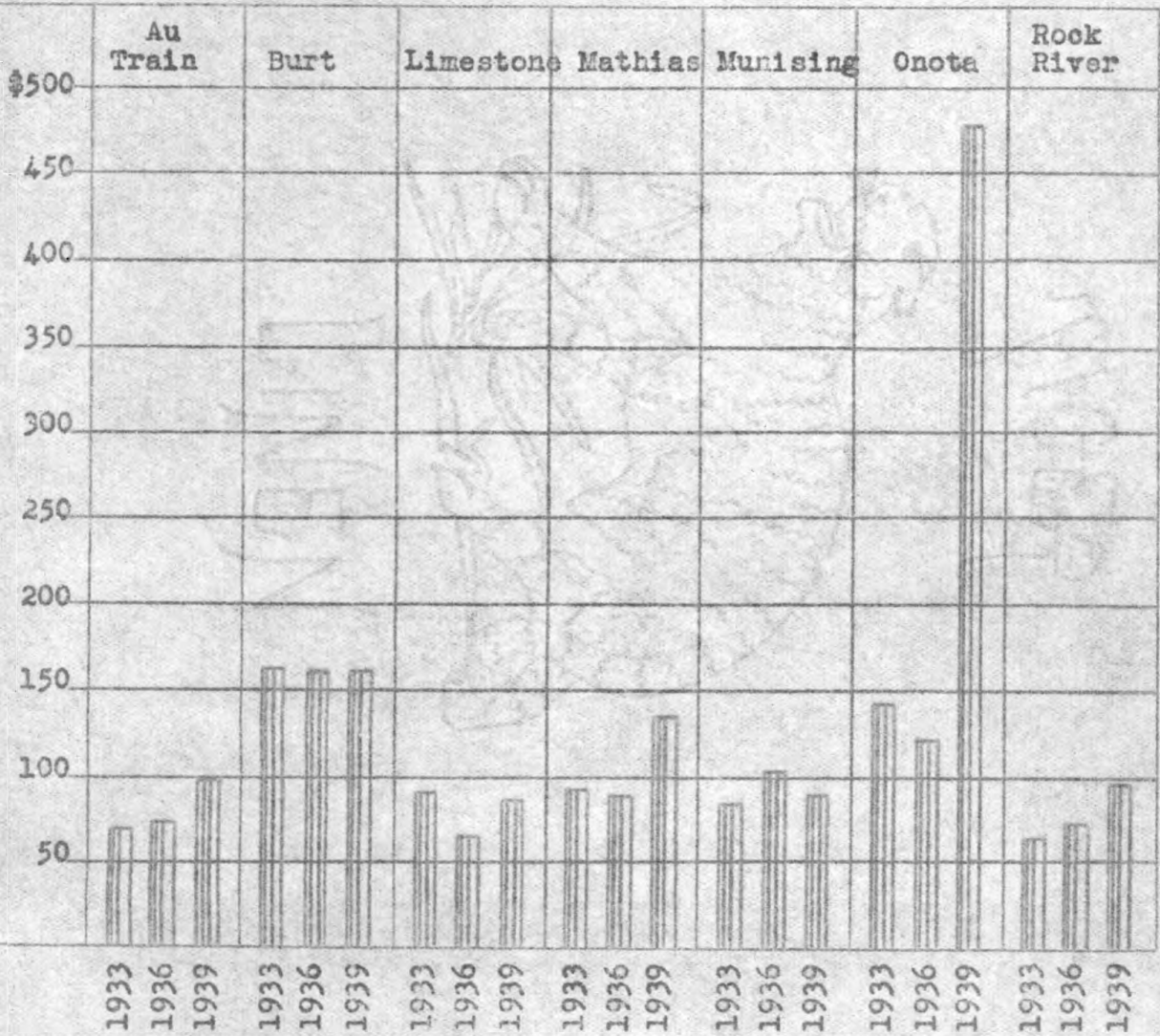

CRUISERS:

During the past year, we have kept as many men at work as were necessary cruising and looking after the lands of the company.

HOTEL WILLIAMS AND COTTAGES:

This resort was operated by us during the past year, with a guest list comparable with 1938, and was under the management of Mrs. Langan J. Foard of Marquette, Michigan.

The following statements show receipts and expenditures for the year 1939.

GRAND ISLAND:

DEER:

No deer were shipped during the year, and it is not planned to make any shipments during the coming 12 months on account of the scarcity of these animals on the Island.

ELK:

Our foreman reports that he does not see any of these animals at very frequent intervals. However, during the year he has come in contact with them on his trips over the Island.

GAME BIRDS:

There has been no increase of game birds on the Island.

PREDATORY ANIMALS:

We continue to have more or less trouble with coyotes and have had the State Conservation Department ranger assist us in trapping these animals.

HUNTING:

During the year the usual hunting parties visited the Island, and in addition thereto there was one other party, headed by Leslie Woodward, which was secured us by Mr. Carlton of the Coal Department.

Only the regular repair work on the docks was necessary during the year.

BOATS:

The OTTAWA was put in commission during the year, as the arrangement for serving the Island by local boat concerns did not work out satisfactorily.

AUTOMOBILES:

No new cars were purchased during the year, and the only work done on those on hand was regular maintenance.

WORK DONE FOR OTHER DEPARTMENTS:

During the year 10 of the Mining Department contracts for houses at Ishpeming were completed and this department prepared the bills of sale, and we also prepared the bill of sale for the property sold to Dr. Crane. One house was sold in The Cleveland-Cliffs Iron Company's First Addition, Negaunee, and this department prepared the contract.

As we have done for several years, we continued looking after the surface of the Mining Department lands, including those of The Negaunee Mine Company, The Athens Iron Mining Company, and The Cliffs Power & Light Company. Collections were made of all of the rentals on the leases of these lands and also the payments on the sales of the houses in the New Addition at Negaunee.

MAPS:

We attach hereto a set of maps showing the land owned by The Cleveland-Cliffs Iron Company and its subsidiaries, as of December 31, 1939.

LOGGING:

No operations are being carried on in the woods by the Land Department and all of the forest products being brought out are being logged by independent contractors. Shipments are being made to The Piqua Munising Wood Products Company at Marquette and Munising, the Atlas Plywood Corporation at Munising, and there have been a number of smaller shipments going to the Veneer Plant at Escanaba; together with hardwood and softwood ties, pulpwood, etc.

We purchased tax titles in Marquette County to protect our mineral interests to the amount of \$2,039.38, and in Iron County tax title purchases amounted to \$15.40, for the account of the Inland Lime & Stone Company.

Redemptions during the year amounted to \$778.31 in the Tax Titles Purchased account, leaving a balance in this account of \$5,456.81. These tax title claims are all located in Marquette County.

TAXES:

The Cleveland-Cliffs Iron Company's comparative tax statement shows taxes paid for the year 1939 in the amount of \$88,691.02. The total taxes paid for 1938 was \$80,651.61. The amount of taxes charged to Accounts Receivable in 1938 was \$5,804.91 and in 1939, \$7,023.18. Eliminating these items, the result shows an increase in taxes for 1939 of \$6,821.14, and this is accounted for by the fact that the taxes paid for 1938 on the Weber mortgage lands were not included in the 1938 taxes, and there was also a slight increase in Alger County, which was offset by decreases in other counties.

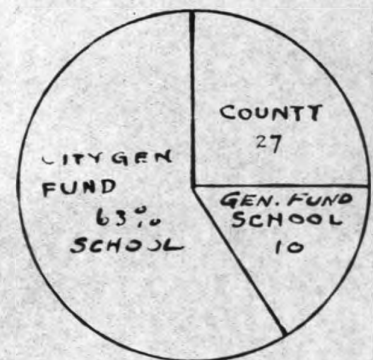
MARQUETTE CITY TAXES

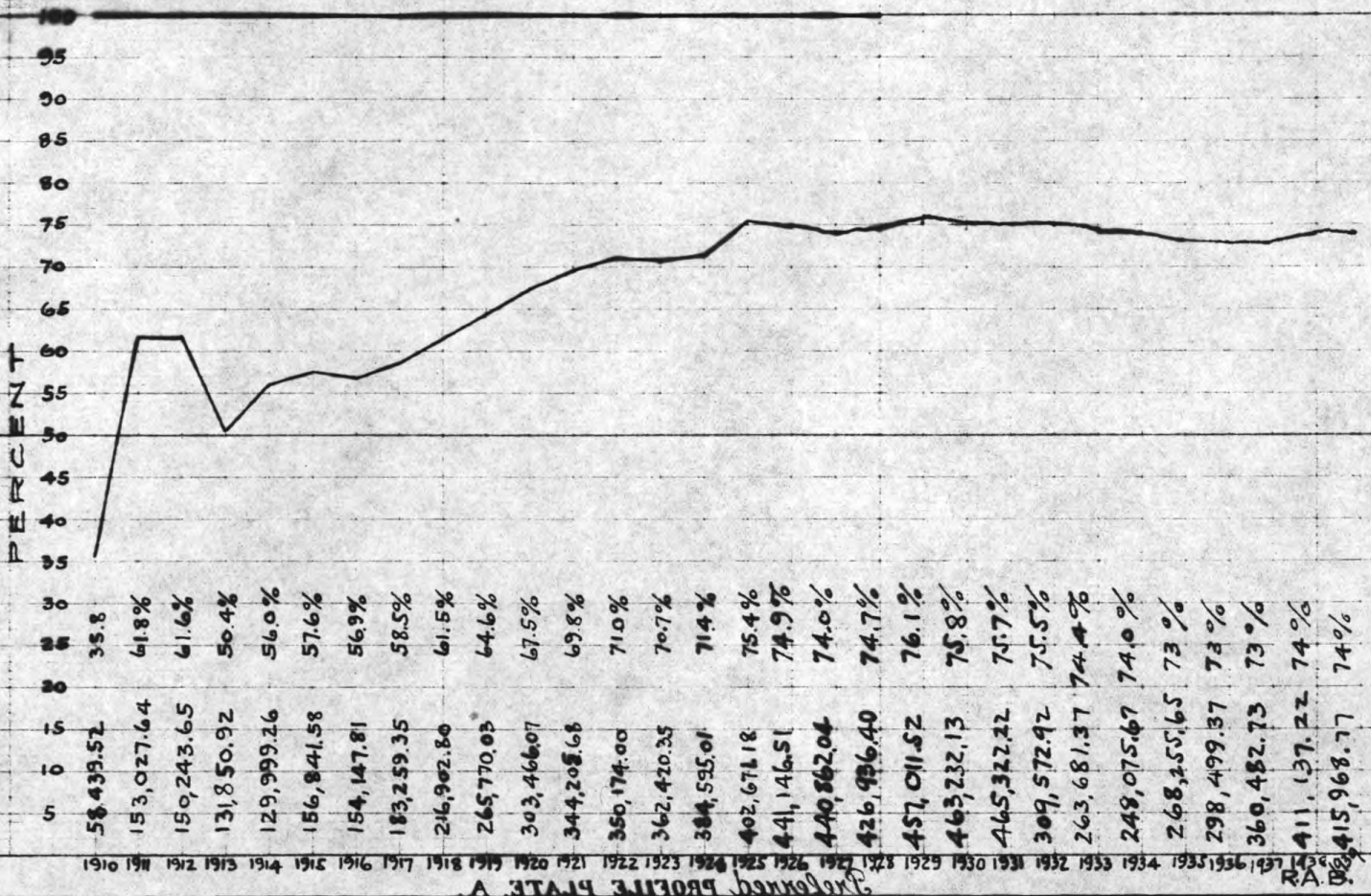

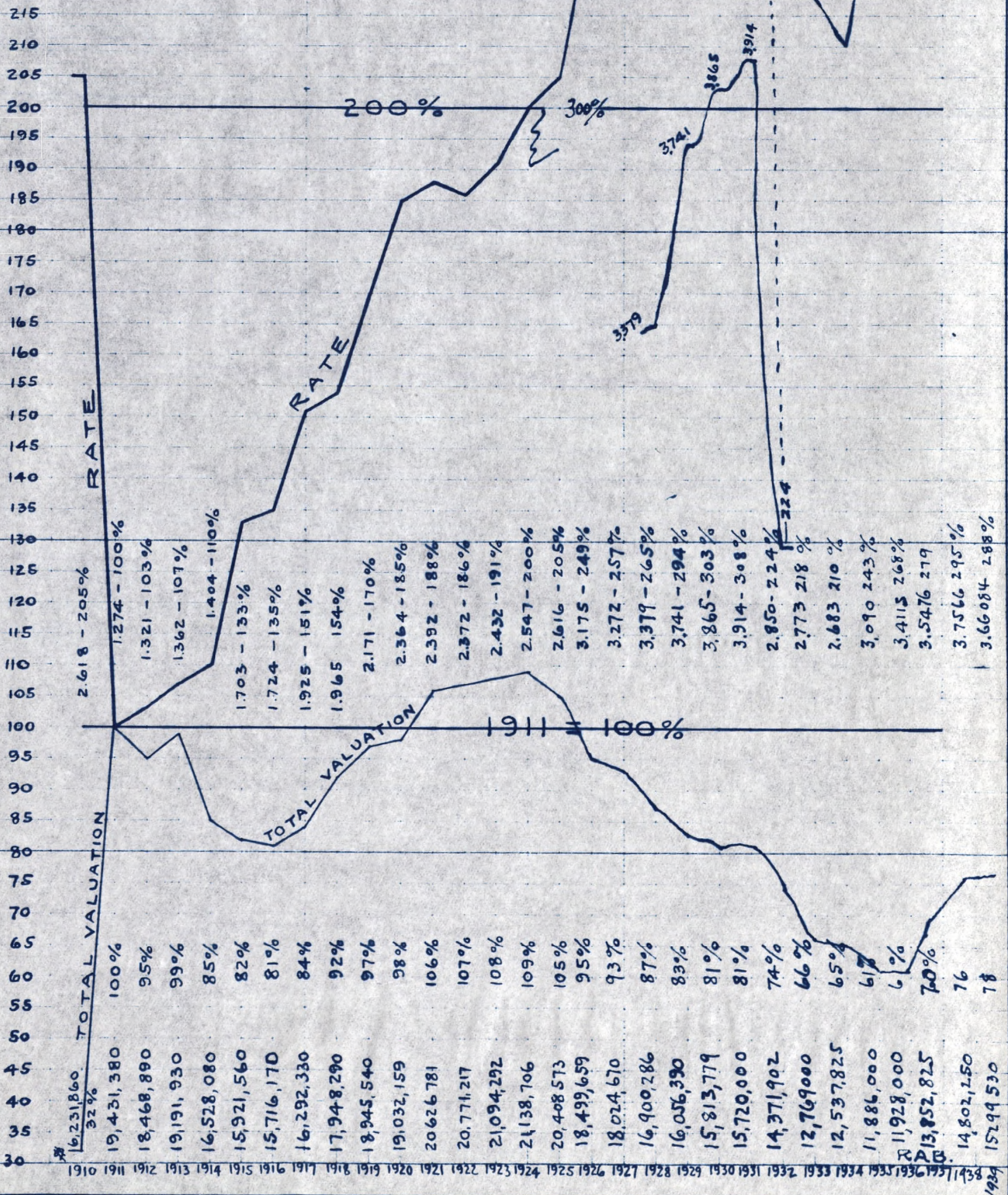
CHART SHOWING THE PERCENT OF THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF TAXES RAISED PAID BY C.C.I.CO.

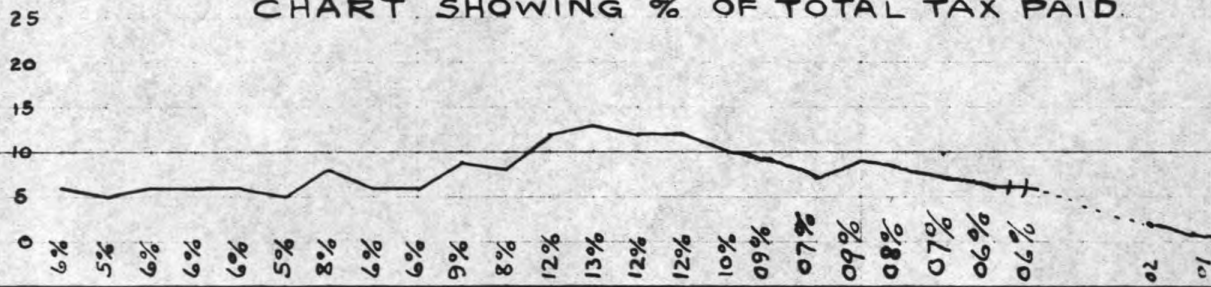
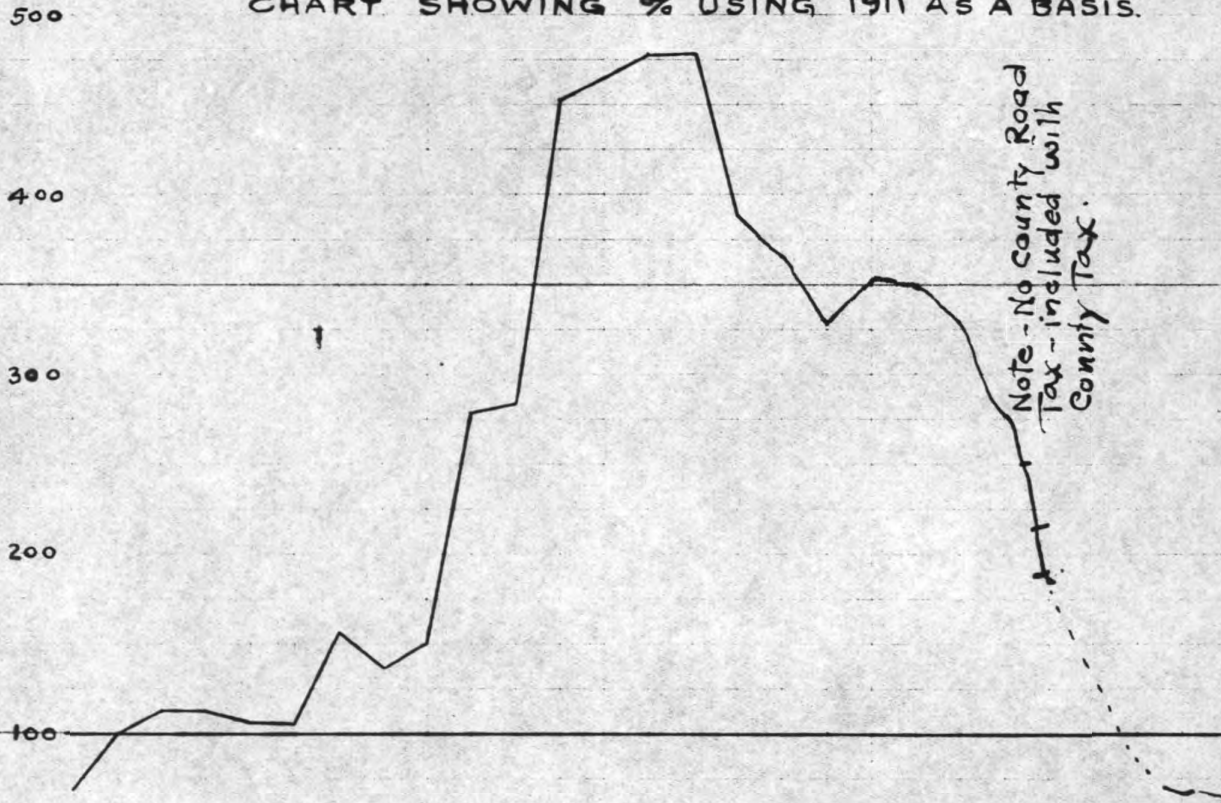

CHART SHOWING % OF TOTAL TAX PAID

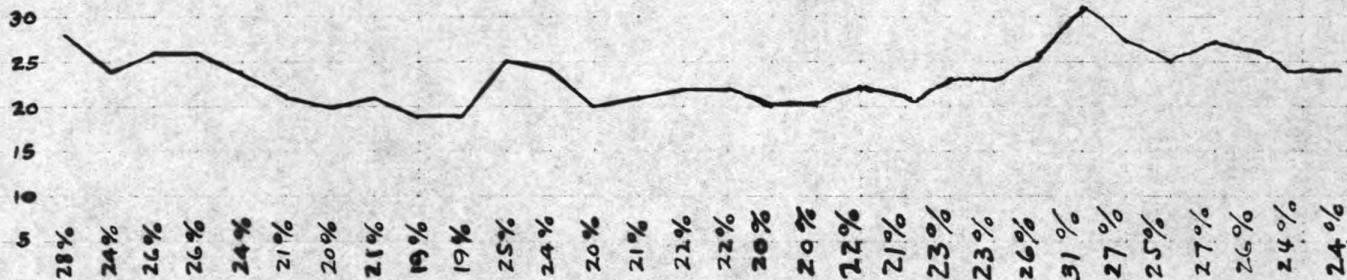
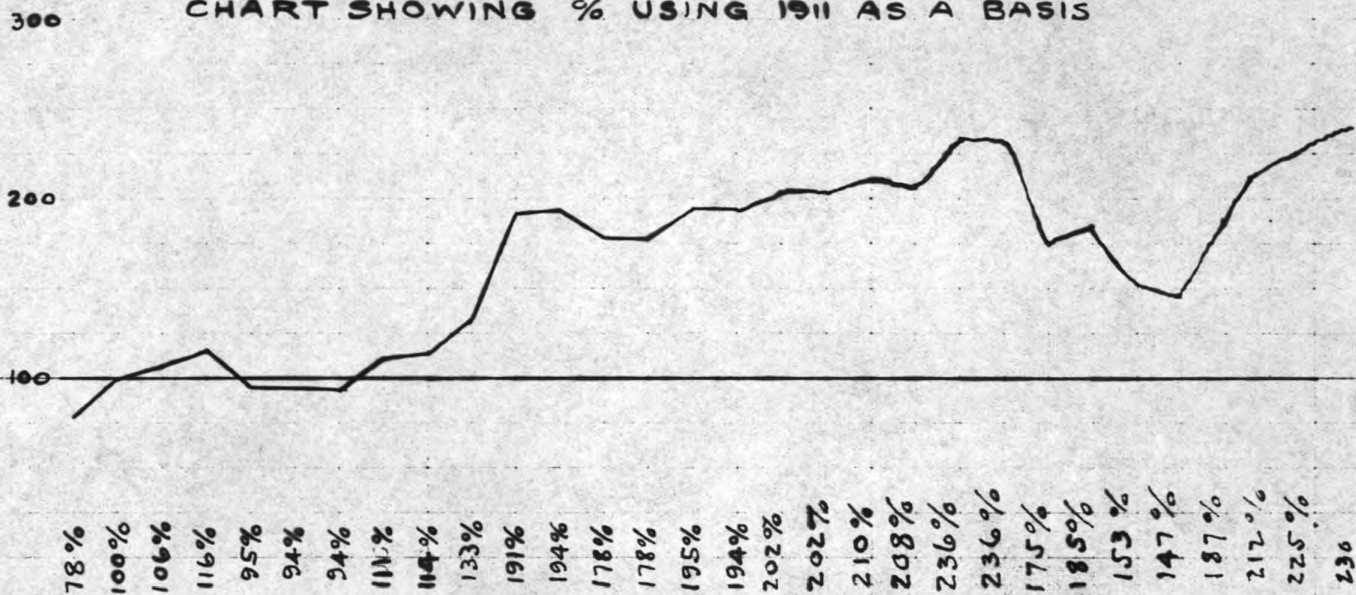


CHART SHOWING % USING 1911 AS A BASIS

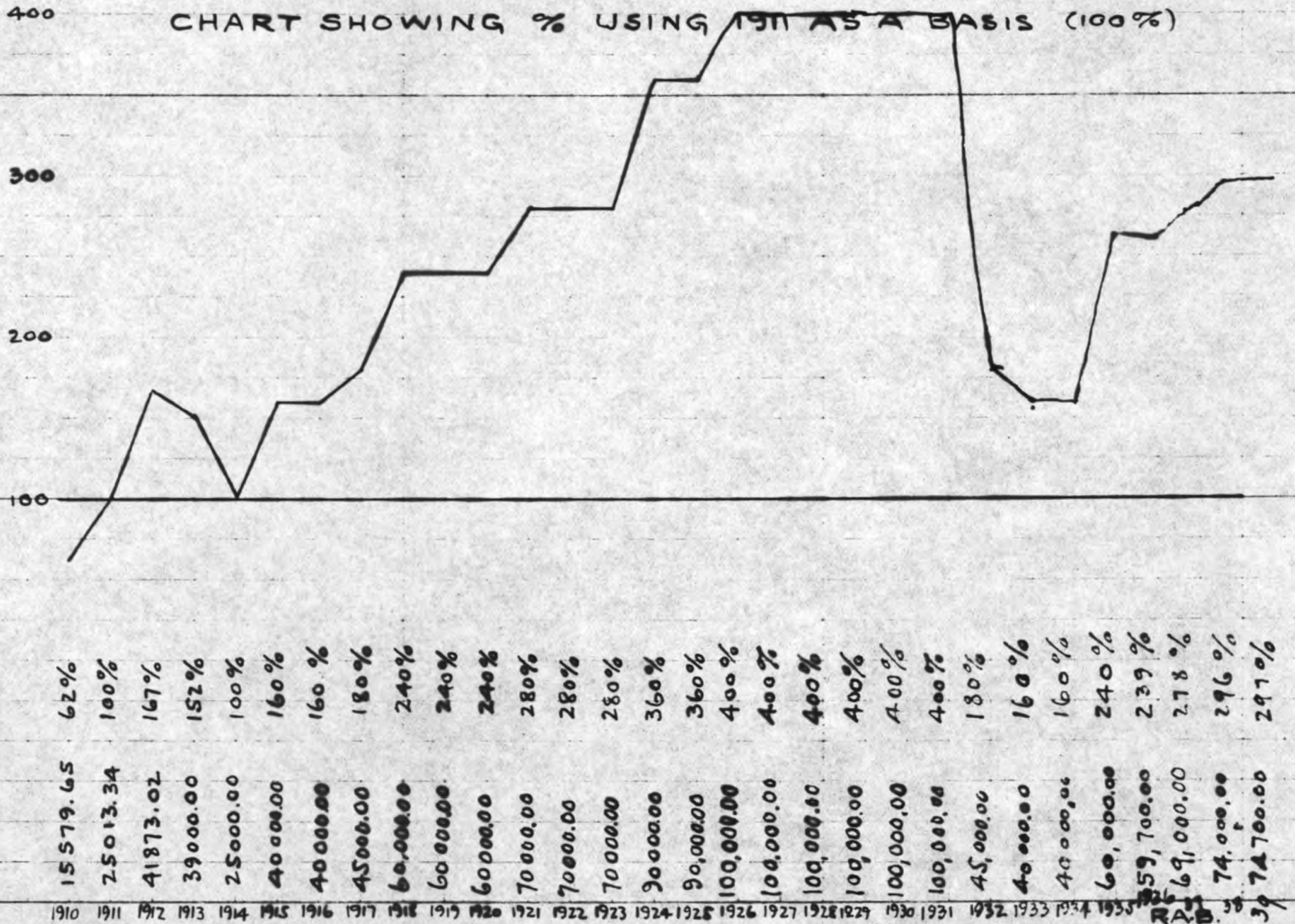

CHART SHOWING % OF TOTAL TAX PAID

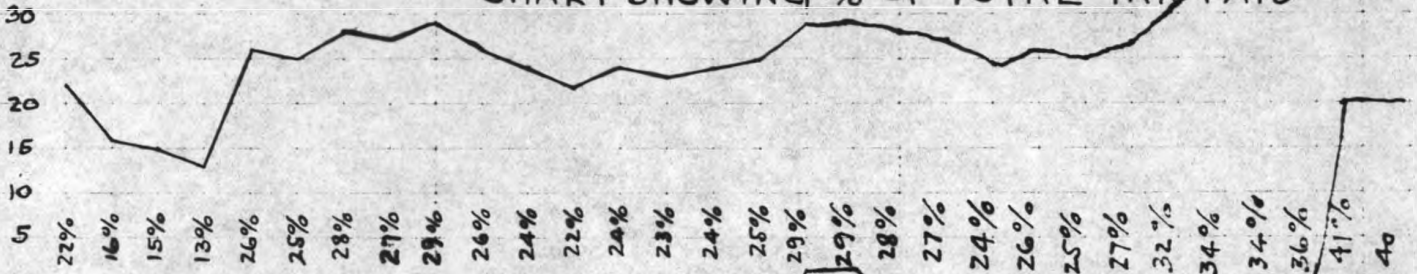
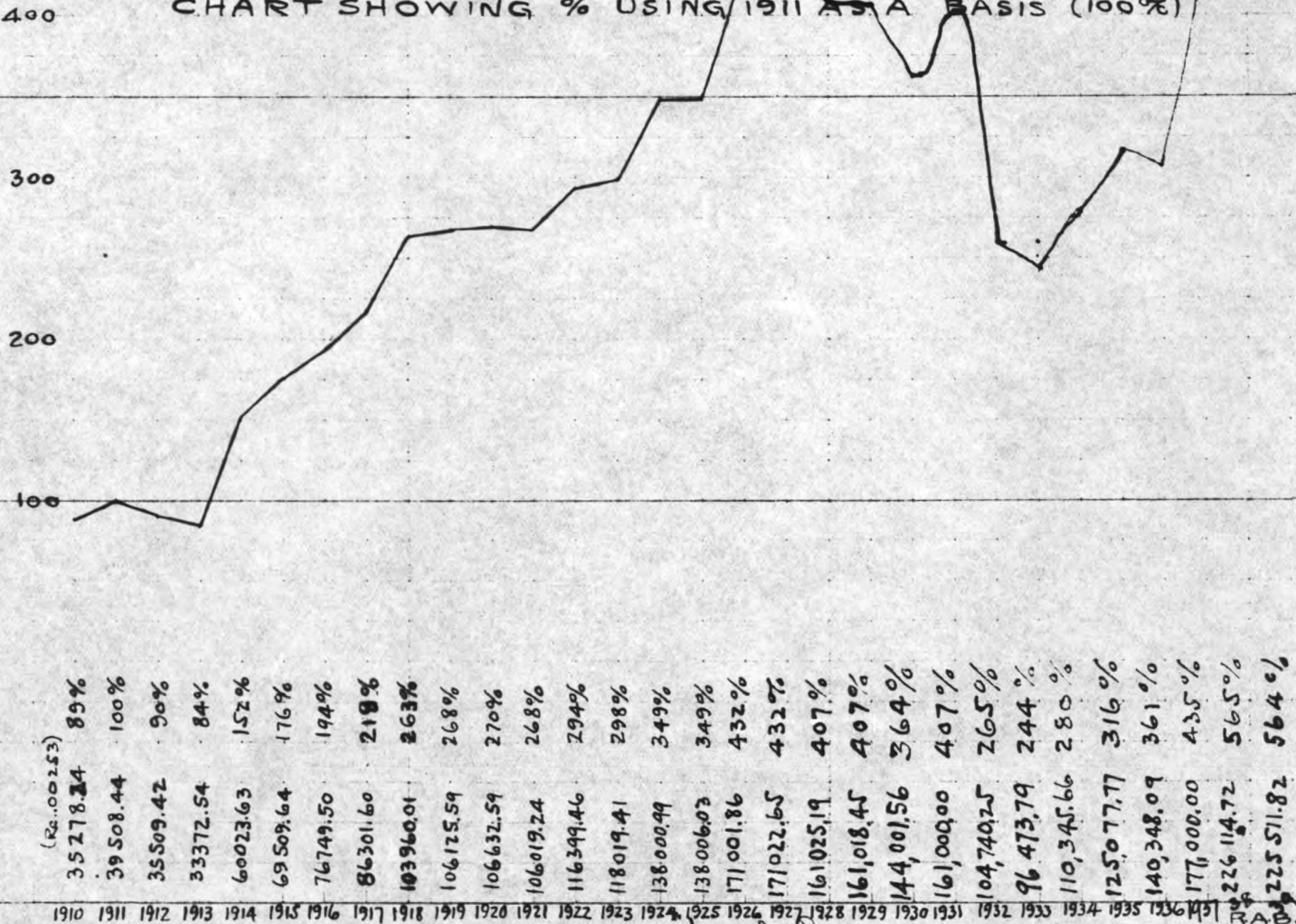

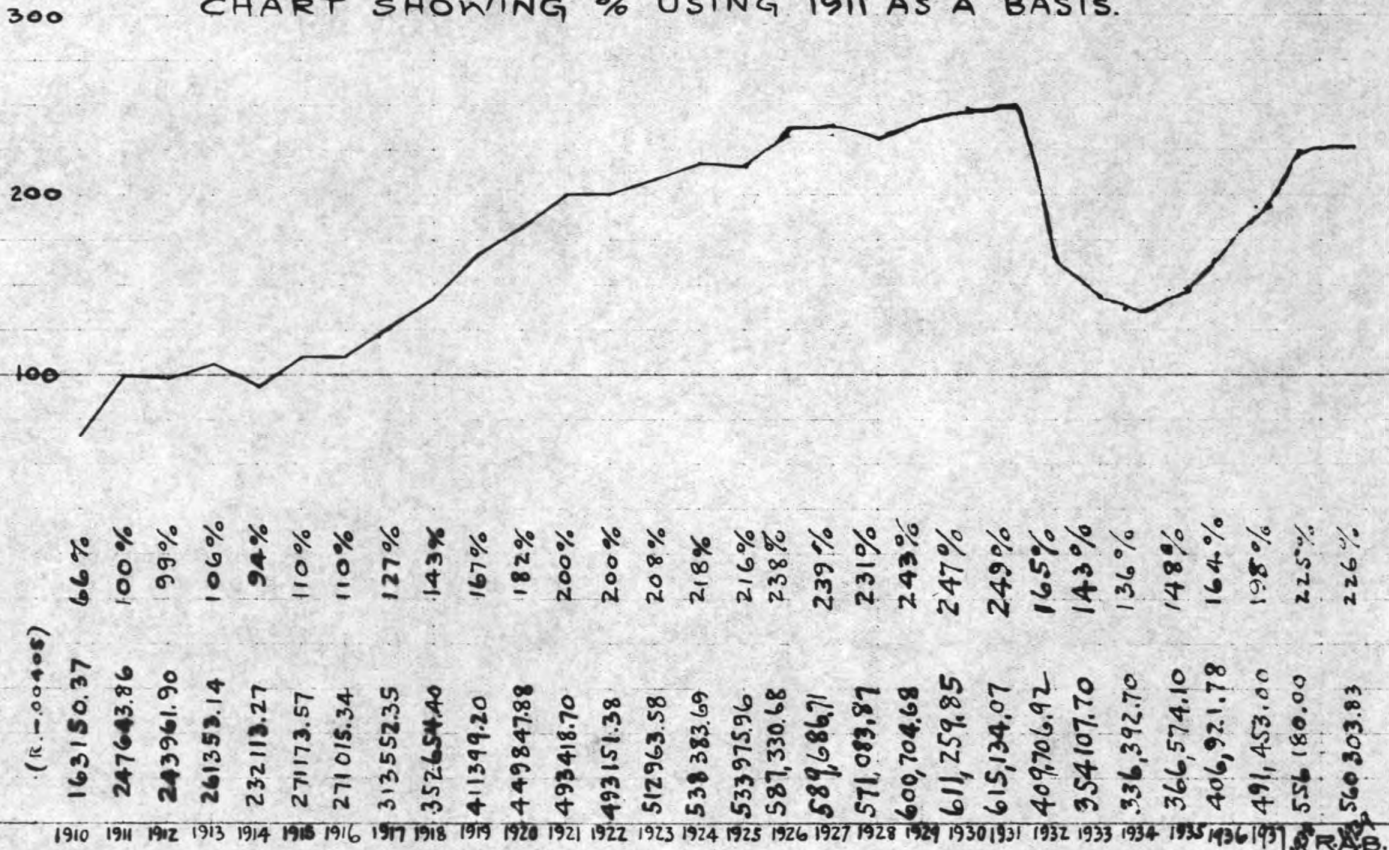
