ALGER COUNTY TAXPAYERS' ASSOCIATION:

This association, which was organized by your Land Agent about thirteen years ago, continues to operate in Alger County with excellent results. The annual report of the Manager is attached, and particular attention is called to the reductions of both assessed values and the amount of money raised in this county during the time the association has been operating.

CRUISERS:

We have kept the usual number at work during the year making necessary examinations and looking after the lands of the Company.

HOTEL WILLIAMS AND COTTAGES:

This resort was operated by us during the past season with a guest registration approximately 300 in excess of 1939. The hotel was again under the management of Mr. and Mrs. Langan J. Foard of Marquette, Michigan.

Statements in this report show receipts and expenditures for the year 1940.

GRAND ISLAND:

DEER:

We did not ship any deer from this game preserve during the year, and we do not plan to make any shipments during the coming 12 months.

ELK:

Our foreman reports seeing a few of these animals at different times, but evidently there has been no increase in their number.

GAME BIRDS:

Very few birds of any kind are seen on the Island, and only a few partridge were encountered during the year.

PREDATORY ANIMALS:

We have had more or less trouble with coyotes and have had help from the State Conservation Department trappers in endeavoring to exterminate these animals.

HUNTING:

During the year only one hunting party visited the Island, and that was composed of Carter H. Harrison Sr., Oscar F. Mayer, of Chicago, and party.

MAPLE SYRUP:

During the year we made 885 gallons of maple syrup, compared with 460 gallons in 1939.

ROADS:

BOATS:

The OTTAWA was in commission during the season and also the gasoline launches TROUT BAY and WILLIAMS ISLAND.

AUTOMOBILES:

No new cars were purchased during the year, and only the regular maintenance work was done on cars already owned.

WORK DONE FOR OTHER DEPARTMENTS:

The Mining Department was quite active in the sale of houses at Negaunee and also at North Lake and Ishpeming, with the result that this Department prepared contracts or bills of sale for 39 dwellings at Negaunee, 12 covering houses in the so-called "Second Addition" on West Empire Street in Ishpeming, 98 for dwellings at

North Lake and 11 covering miscellaneous houses at Ishpeming and one at Republic.

We continued looking after the surface of all Mining Department lands, including those of The Negaunee Mine Company, The Athens Iron Mining Company, and The Cliffs Power & Light Company, the same as we have been doing for a number of years. We also looked after the collections of the rentals on various leases on these lands and also all payments on the sales of houses in the new additions at Negaunee.

MAPS:

We attach hereto a set of maps showing the lands owned by The Cleveland-Cliffs Iron Company and its subsidiaries as of December 31, 1940.

LOGGING:

No operations are being carried on in the woods by the Land Department and all of the forest products being brought out are being logged by independent contractors. Shipments of logs are being made to The Munising Wood Products Company at Marquette and Munising; the Atlas Plywood Corporation at Munising; The Northwestern Veneer & Plywood Corporation at Gladstone, Michigan; and there have been a number of smaller shipments going to the Veneer Plant at Escanaba. We have also been getting out hardwood and softwood ties, pulpwood, etc.

Attached is a statement showing the prices at which hardwood logs are being sold on contract to the different industries.

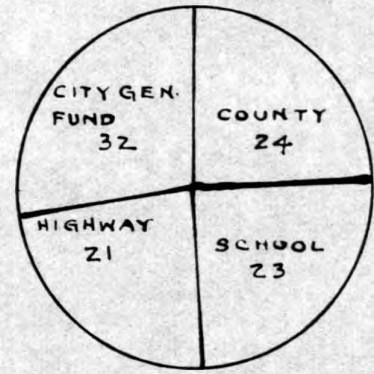
NEGAUNEE CITY TAXES

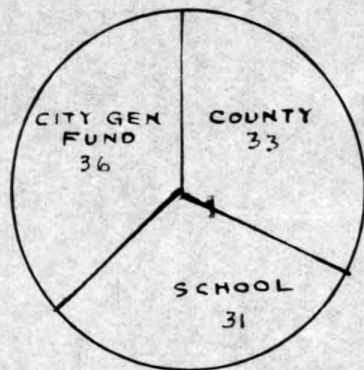
ISHPEMING CITY TAXES

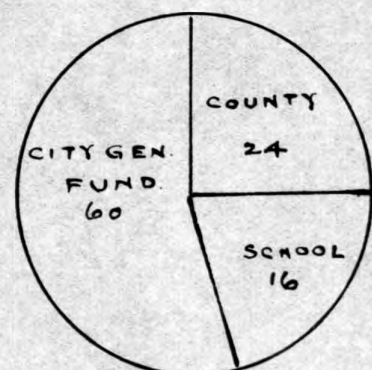
MARQUETTE CITY TAXES

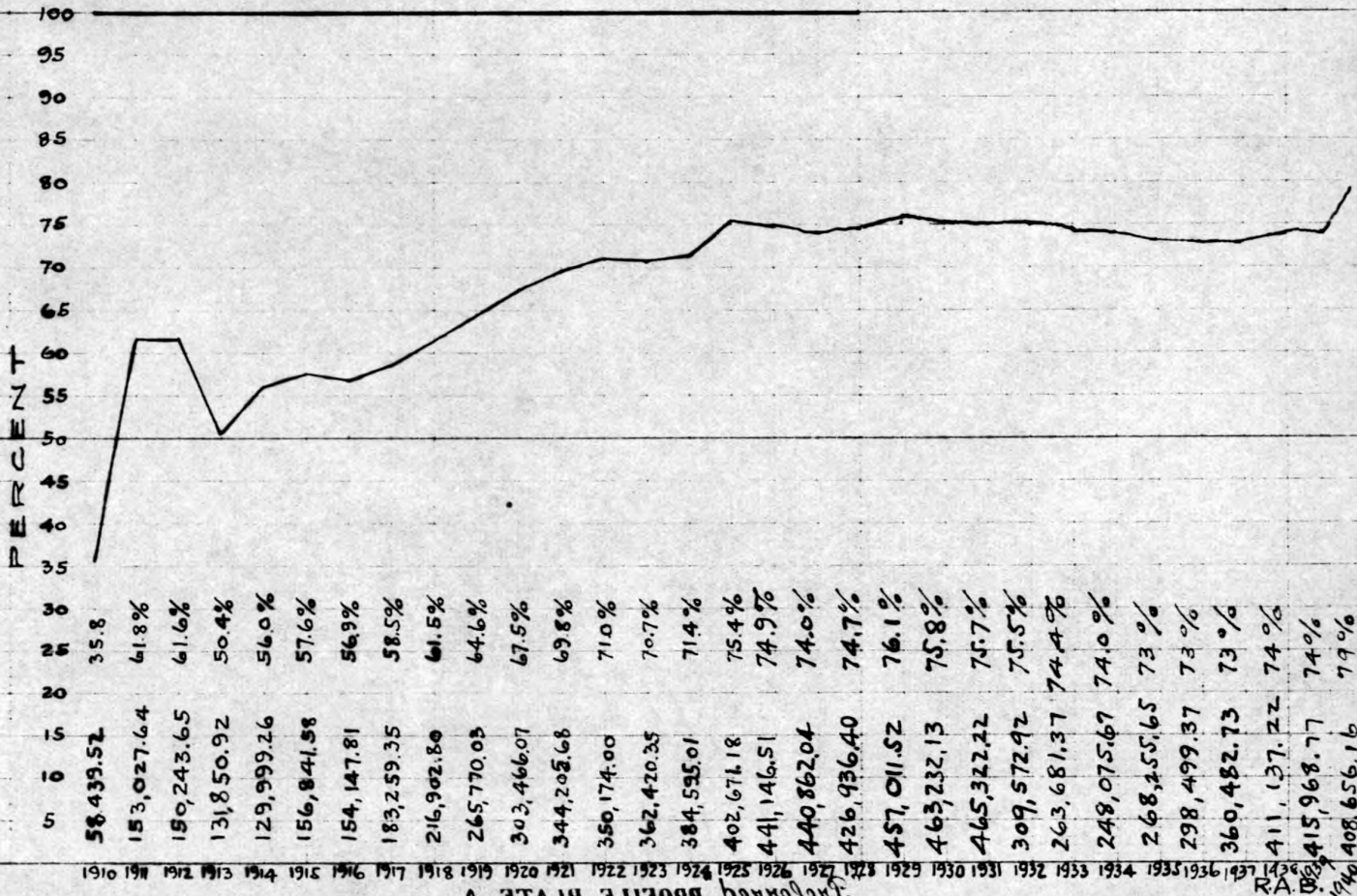

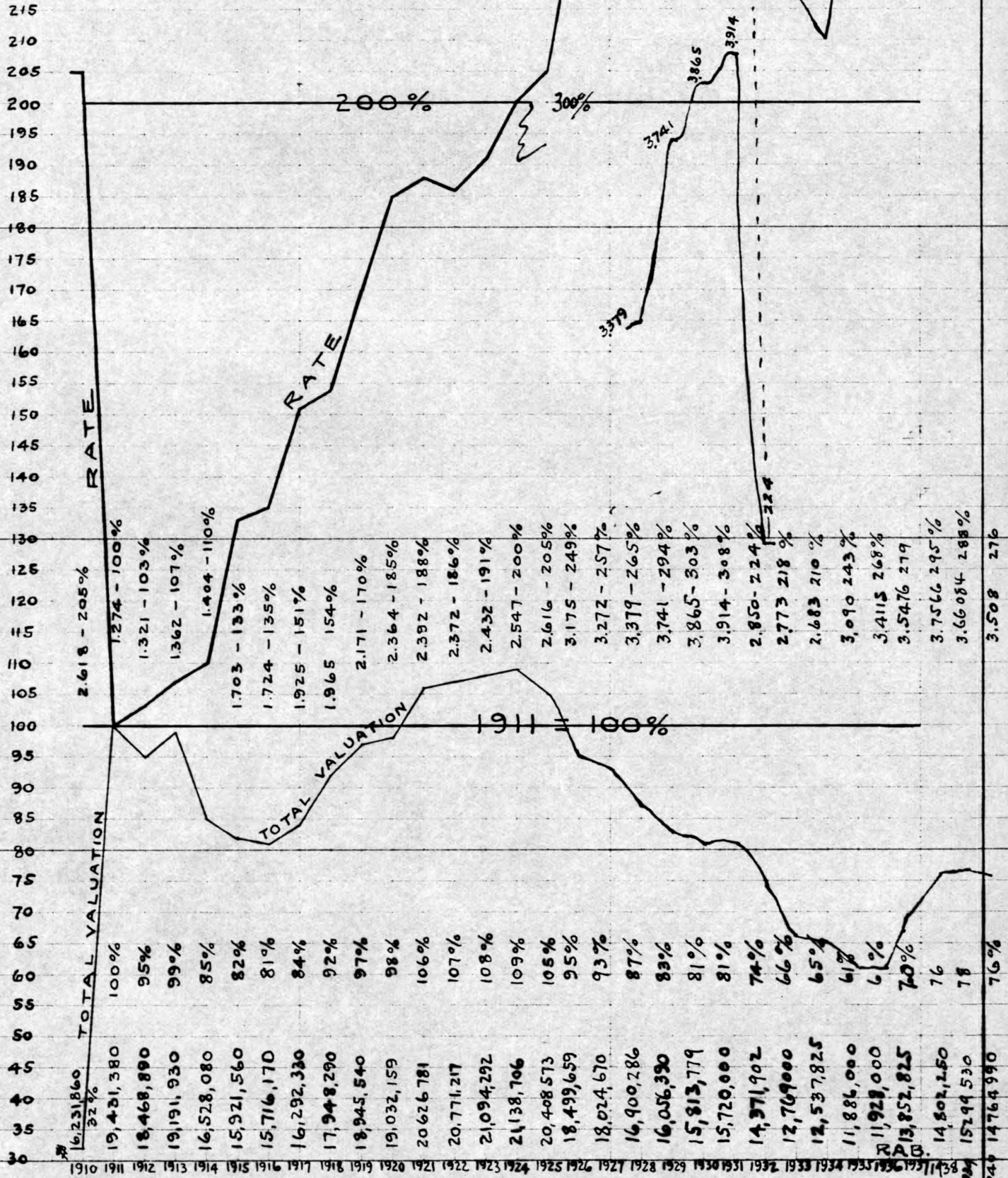

CHART SHOWING % OF TOTAL TAX PAID

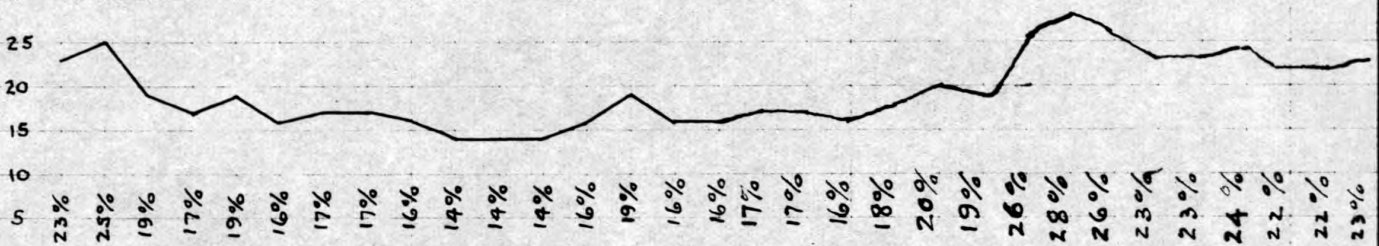
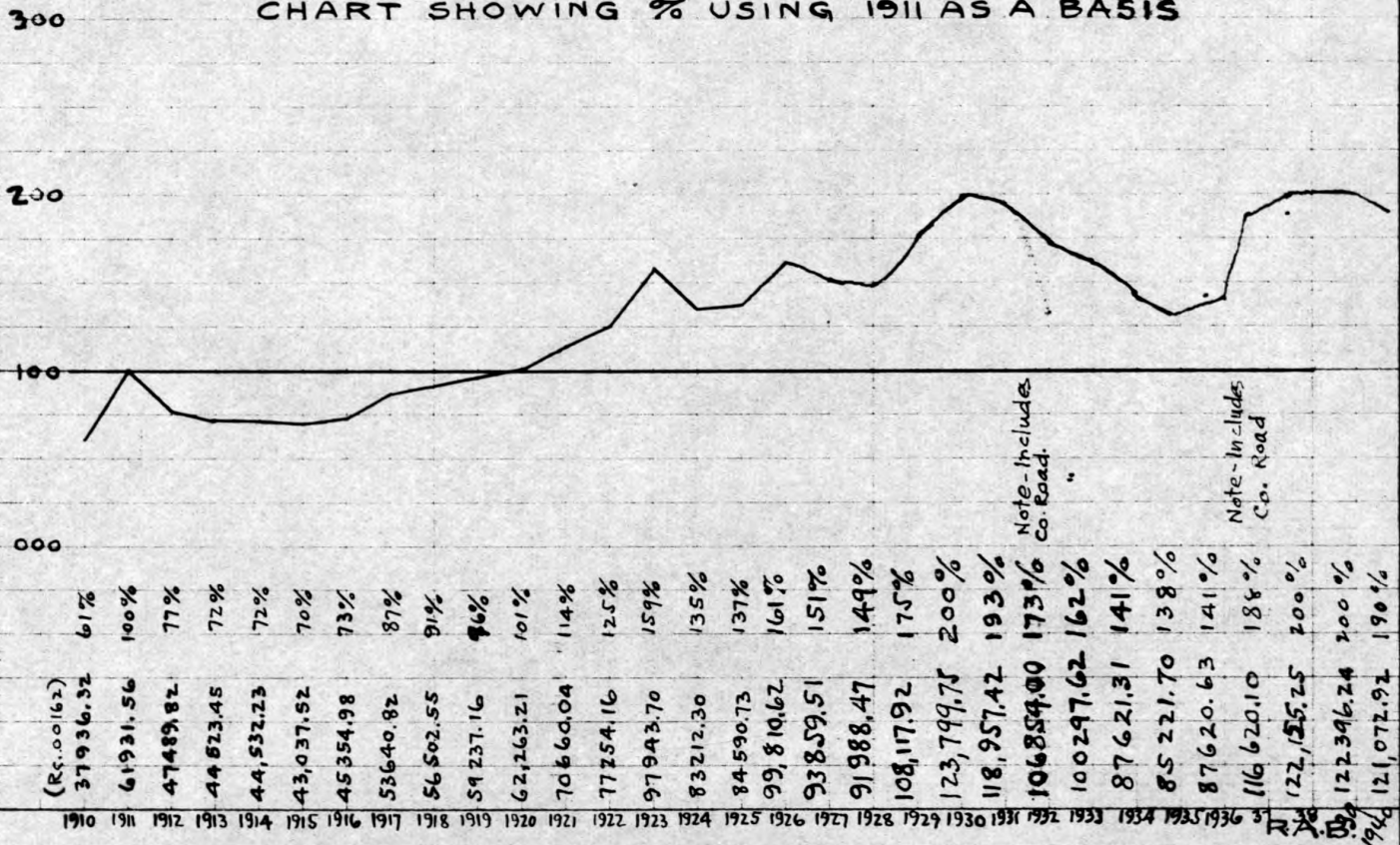


CHART SHOWING % USING 1911 AS A BASIS

CHART SHOWING % OF TOTAL TAX PAID.

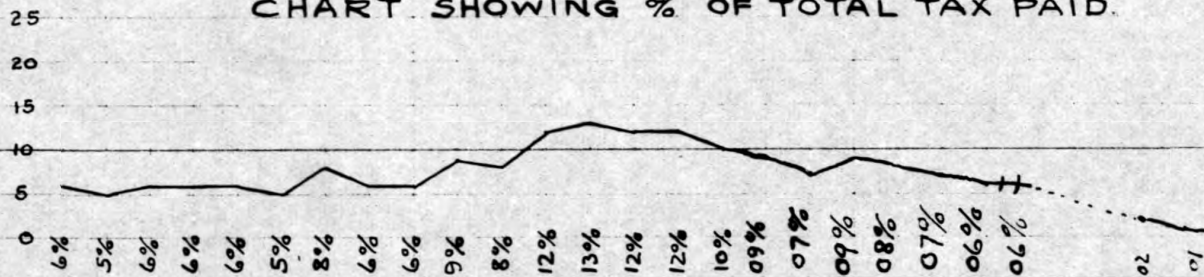
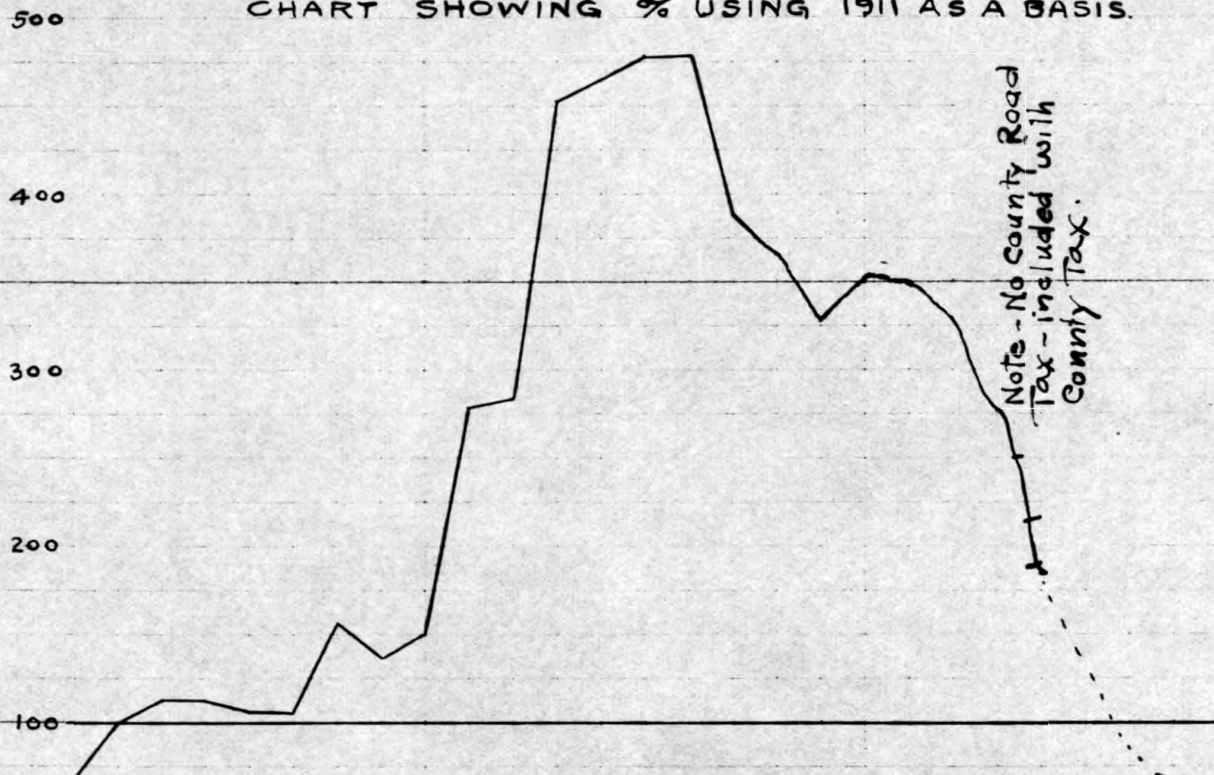

CHART SHOWING % OF TOTAL TAX PAID

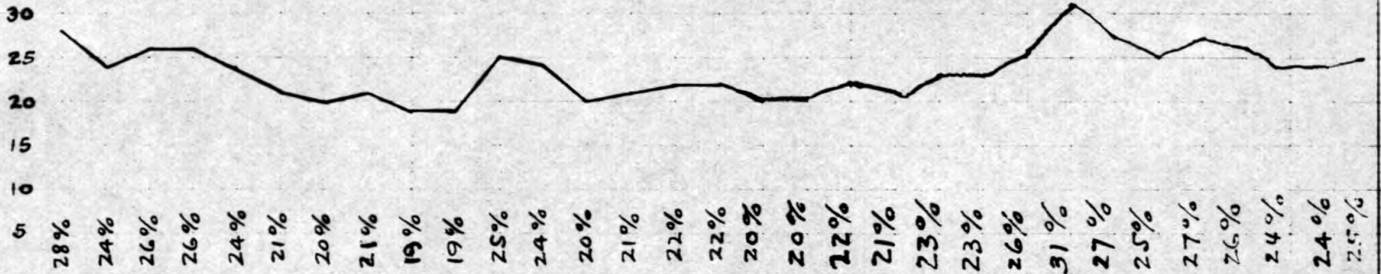
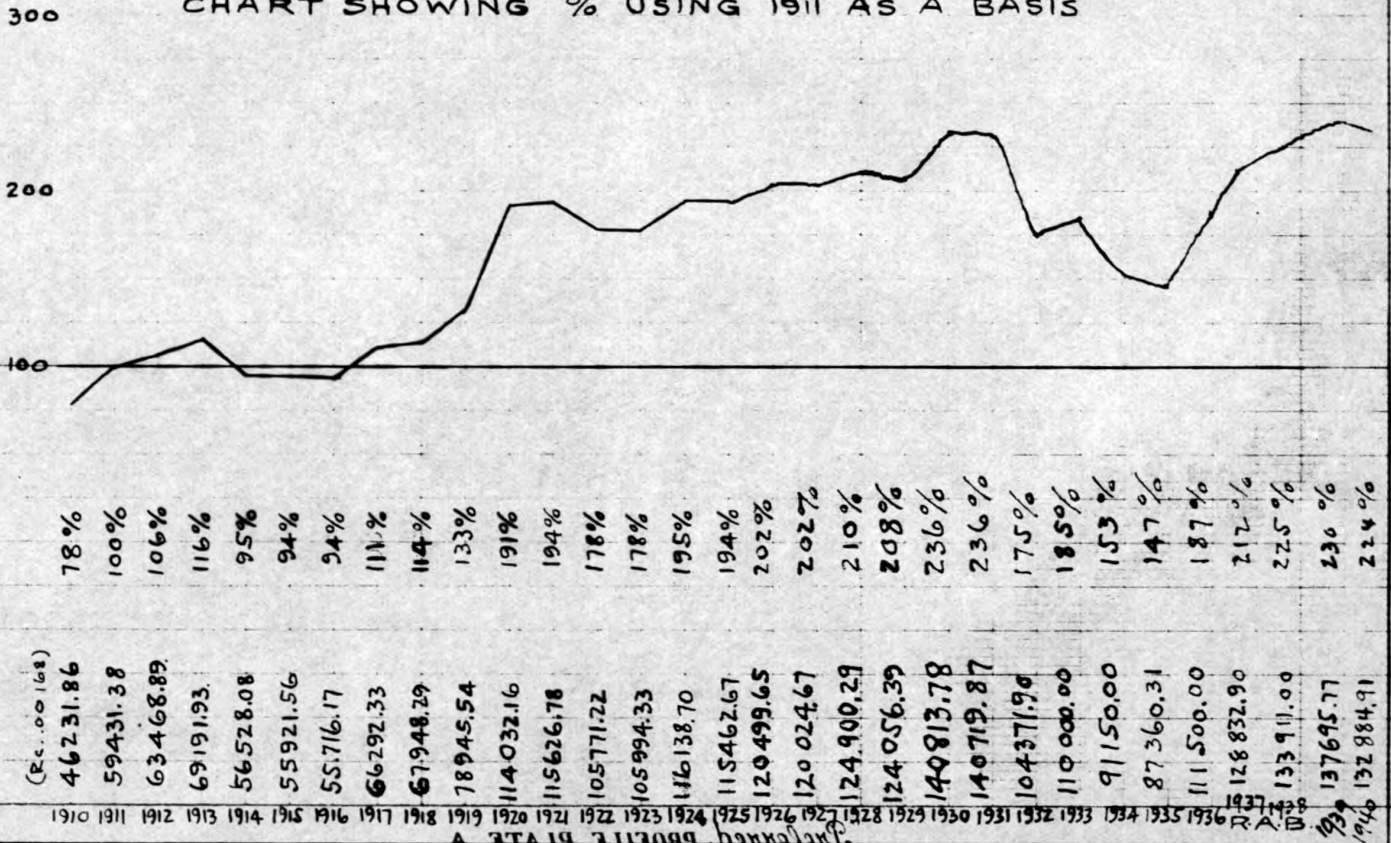

CHART SHOWING % OF TOTAL TAX PAID

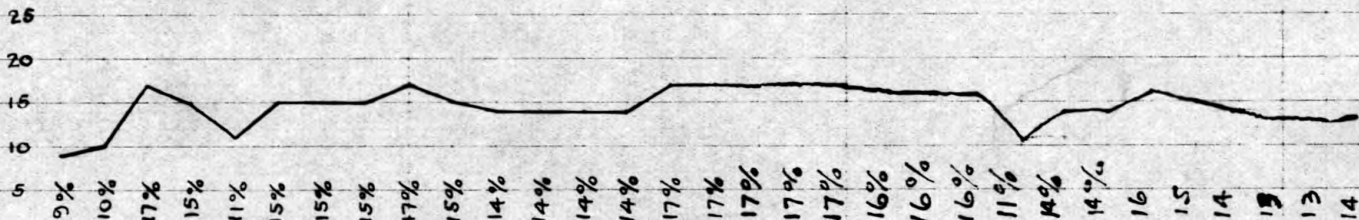
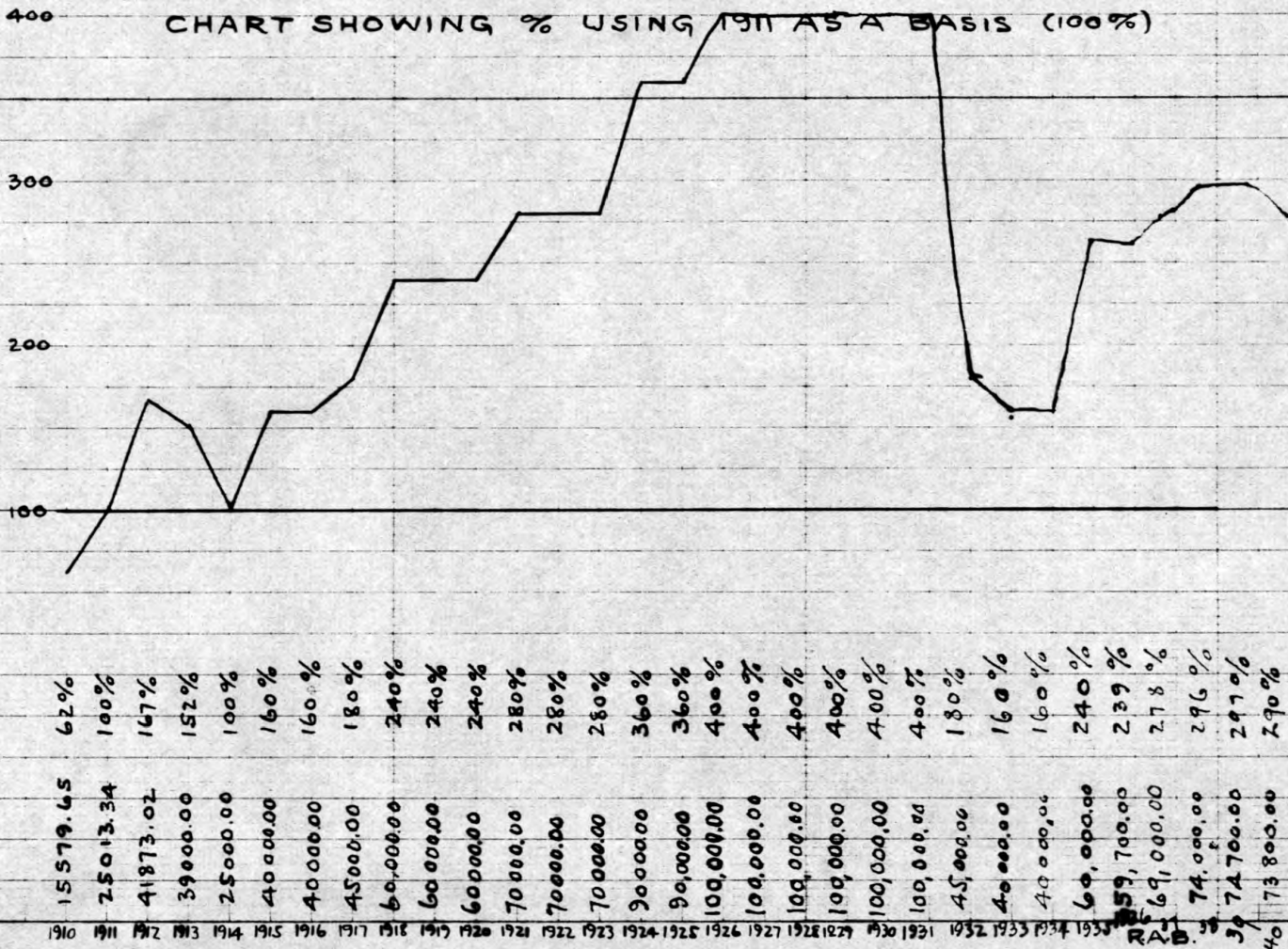


CHART SHOWING % USING 1911 AS A BASIS (100%)

CHART SHOWING % OF TOTAL TAX PAID

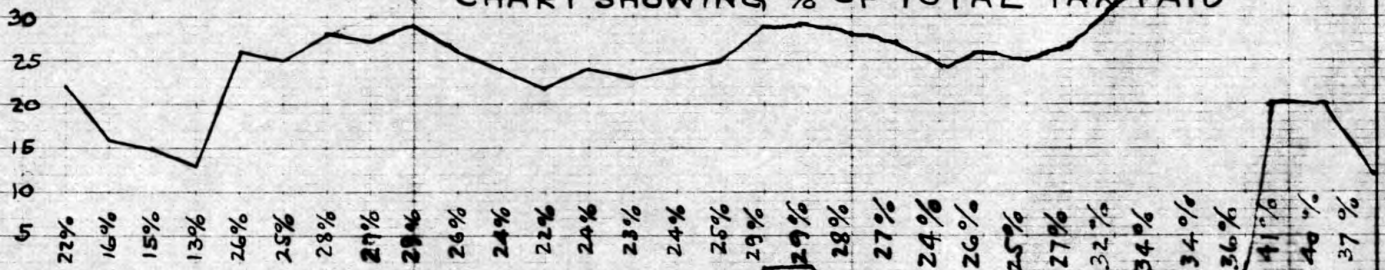
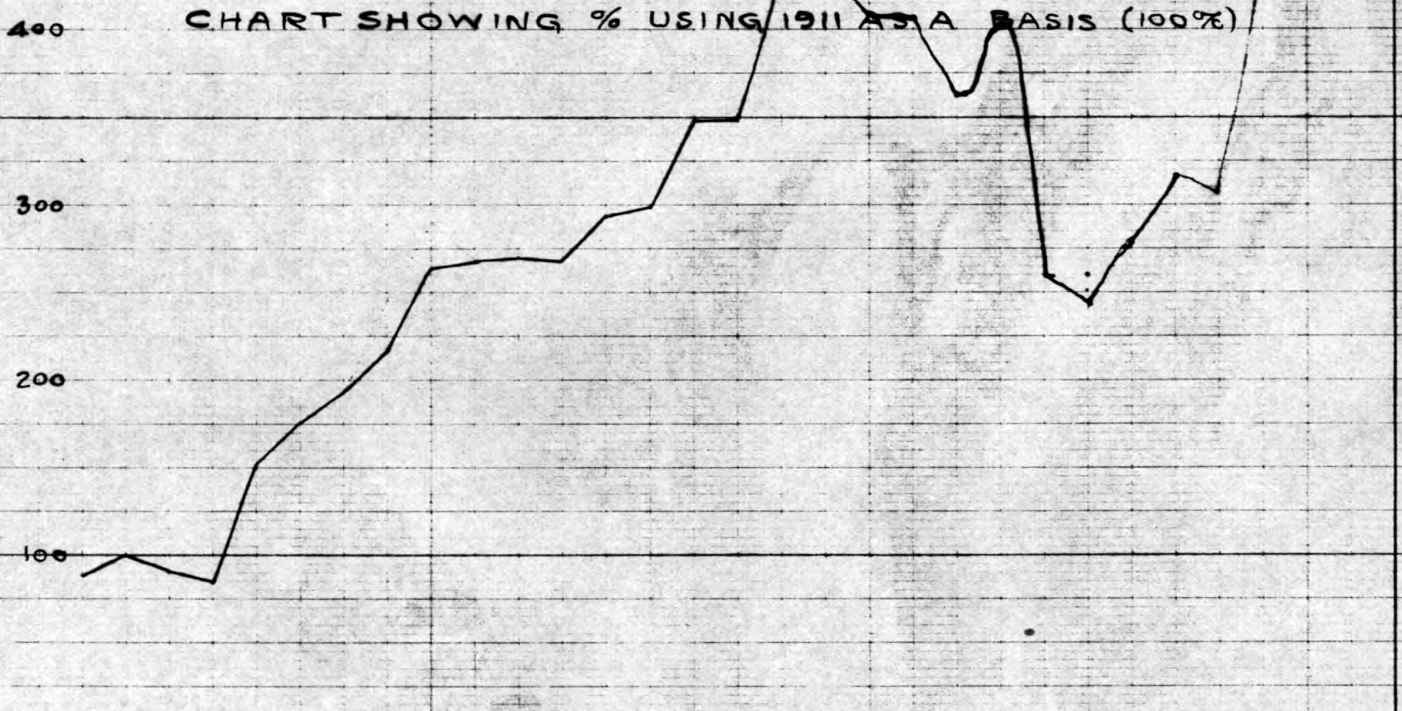
