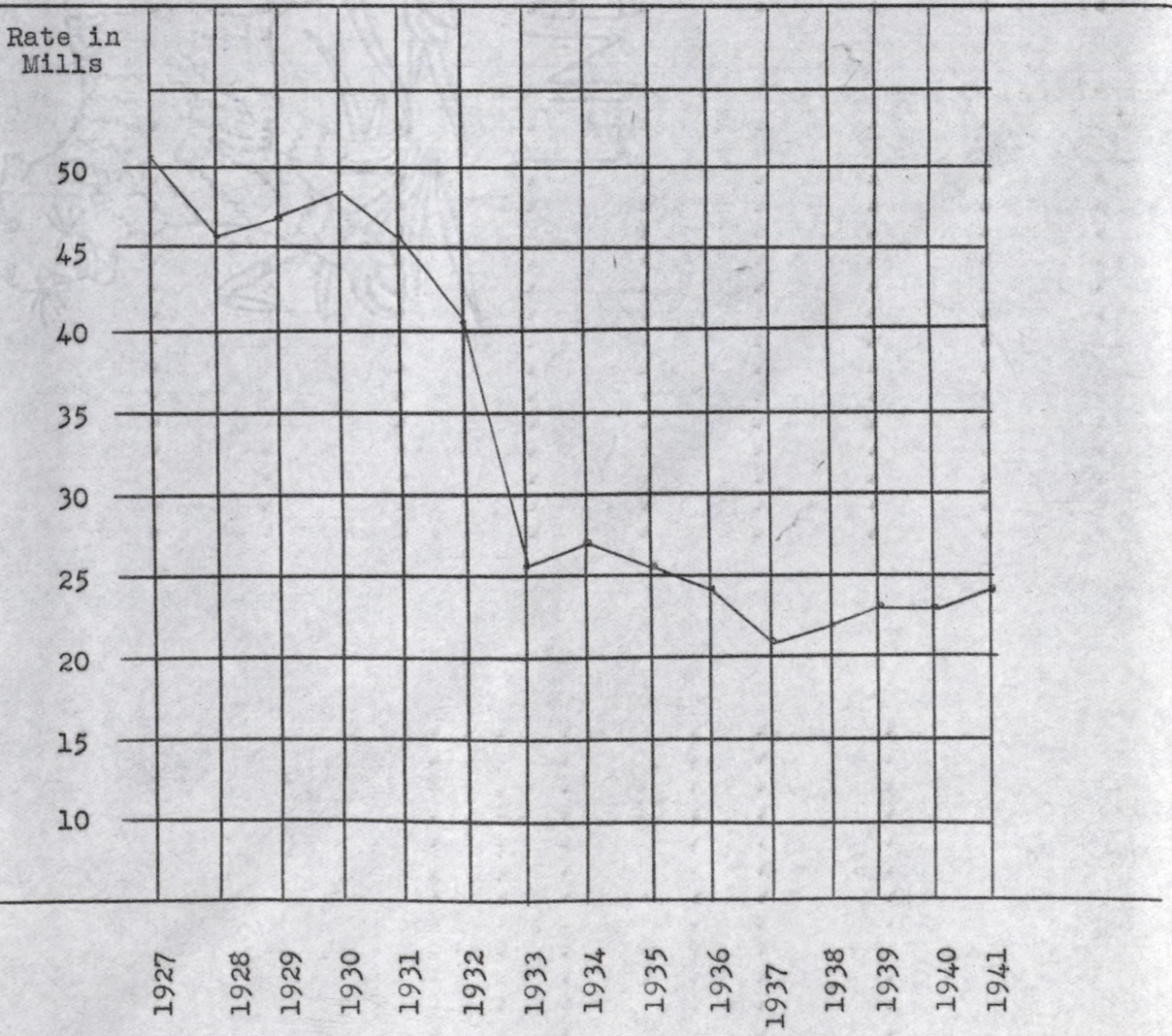

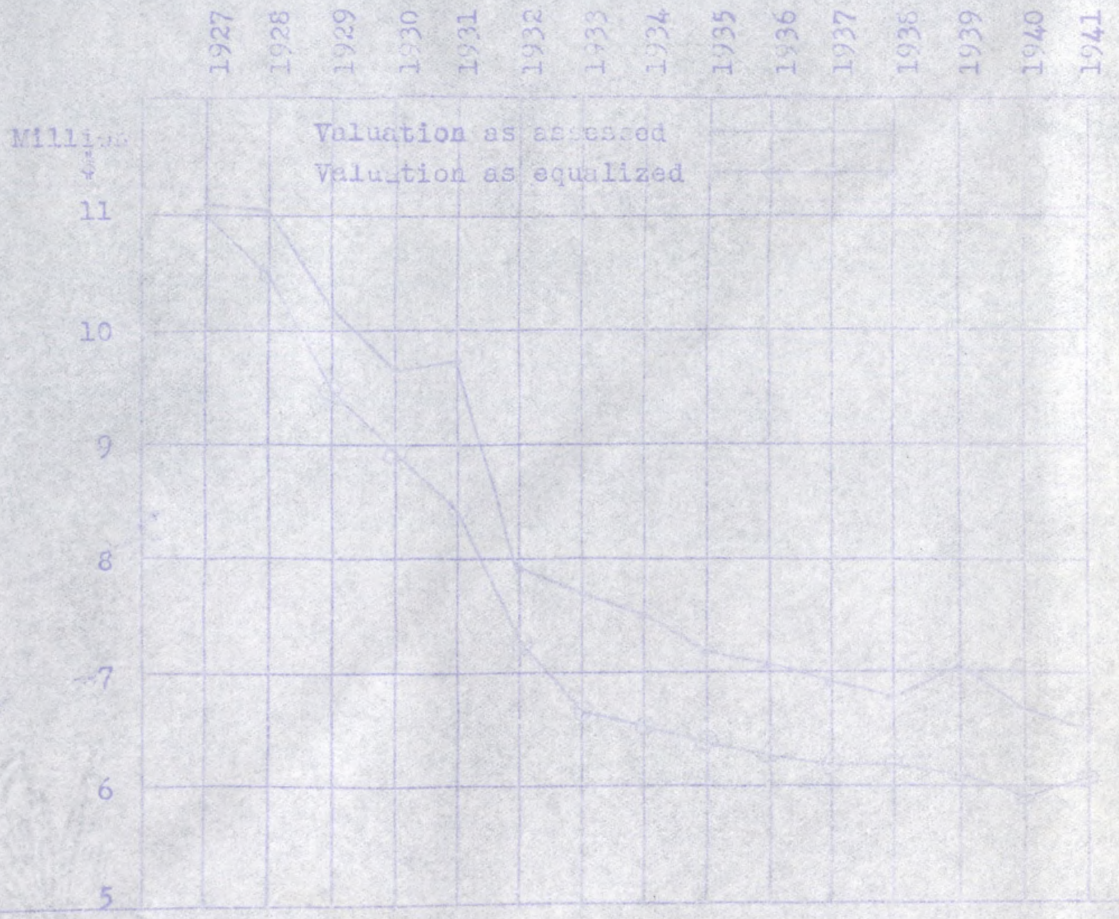
TOTAL TAX RATES 1927 TO 1941 INC.

TOTAL VALUATION AS ASSESSED AND AS EQUALIZED BY THE STATE BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

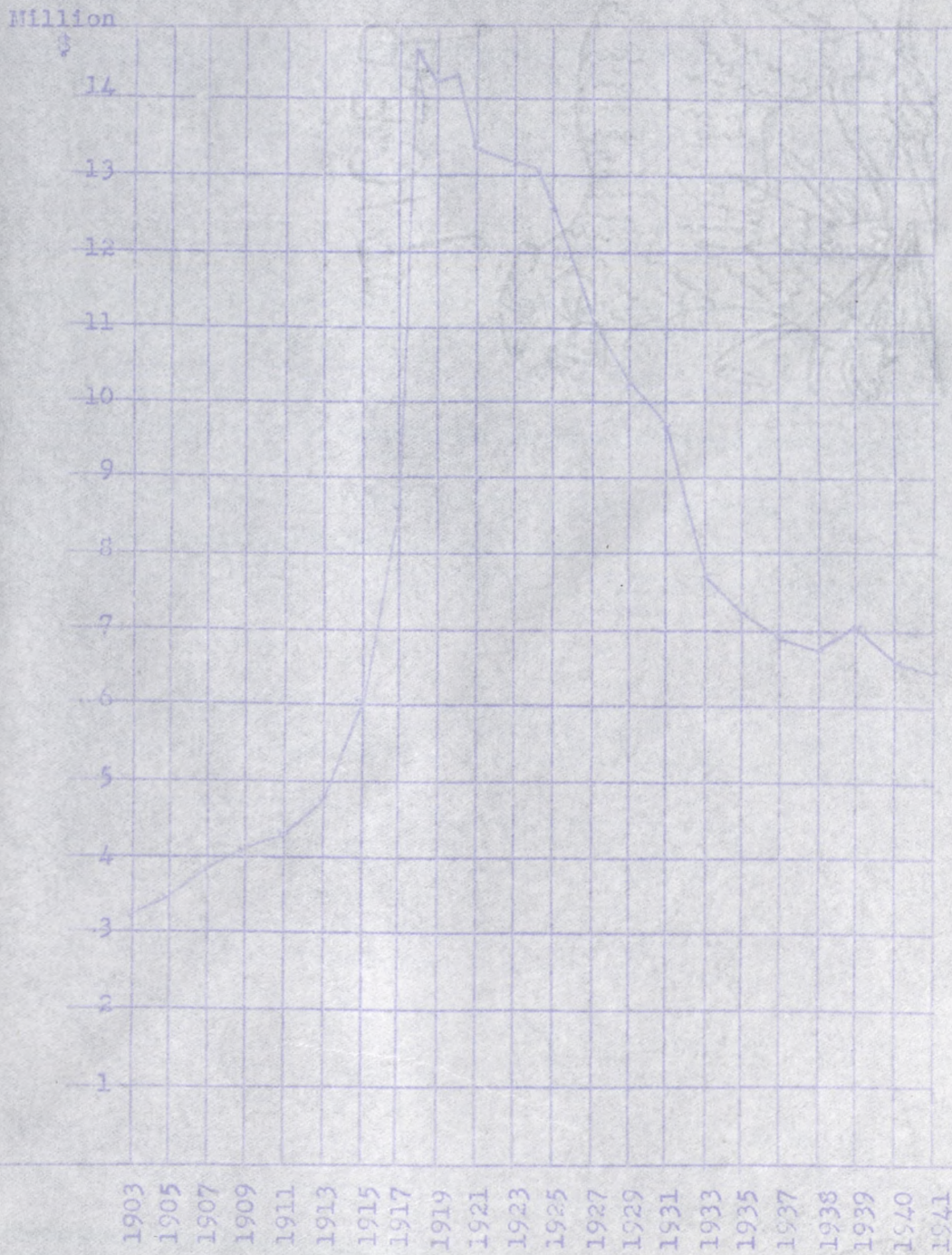

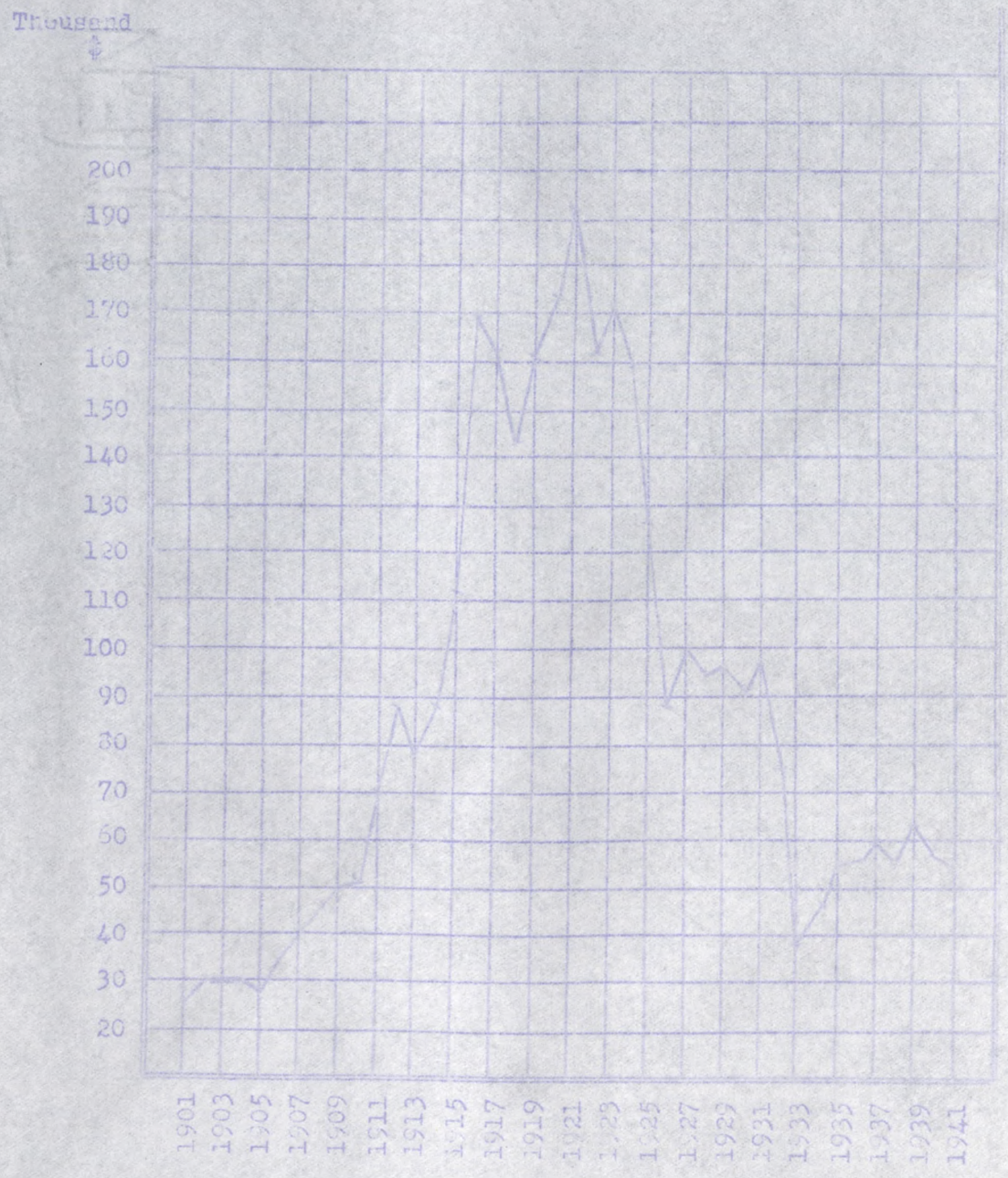

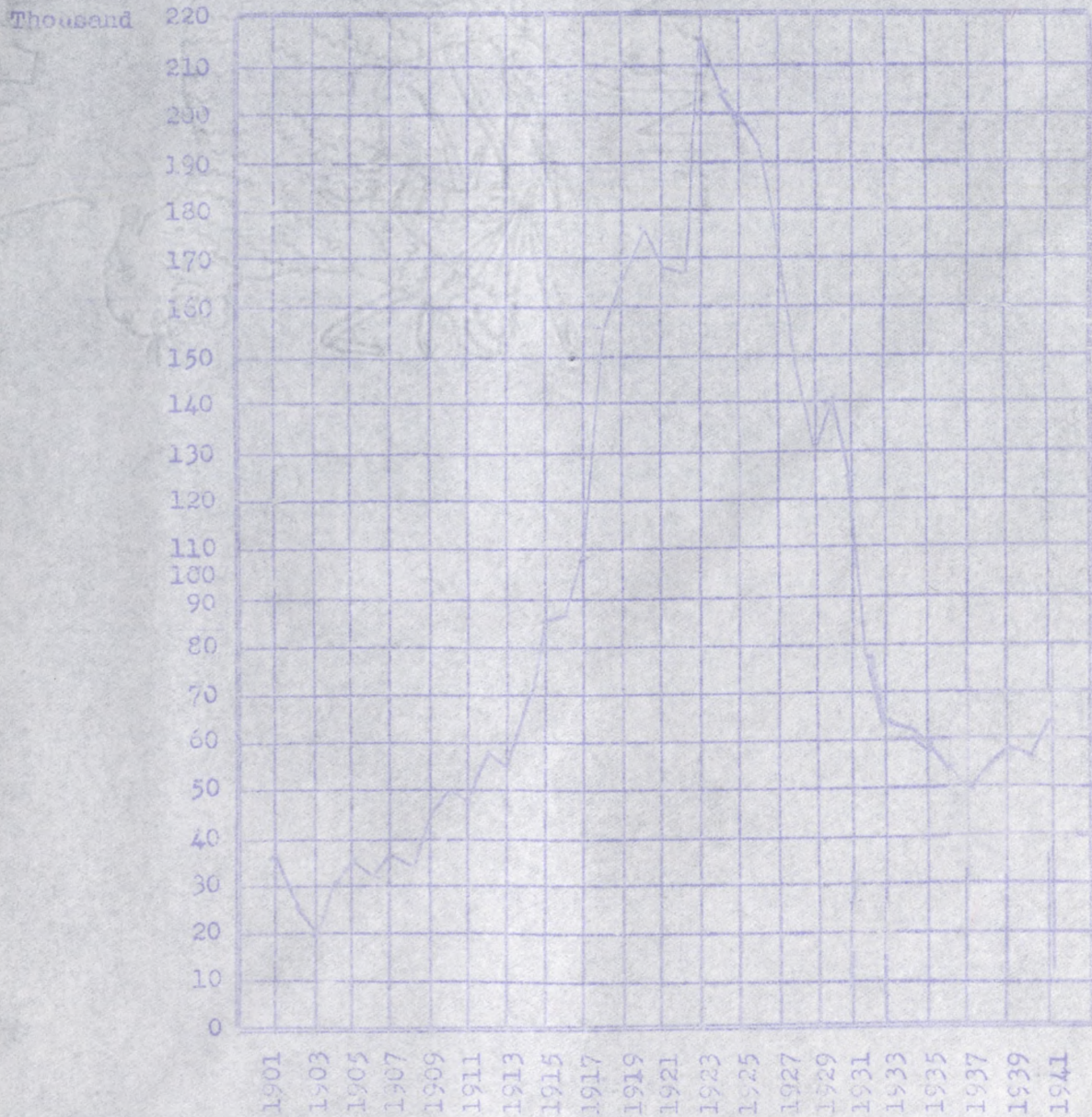
ALGER COUNTY

COUNTY TAX LEVELS

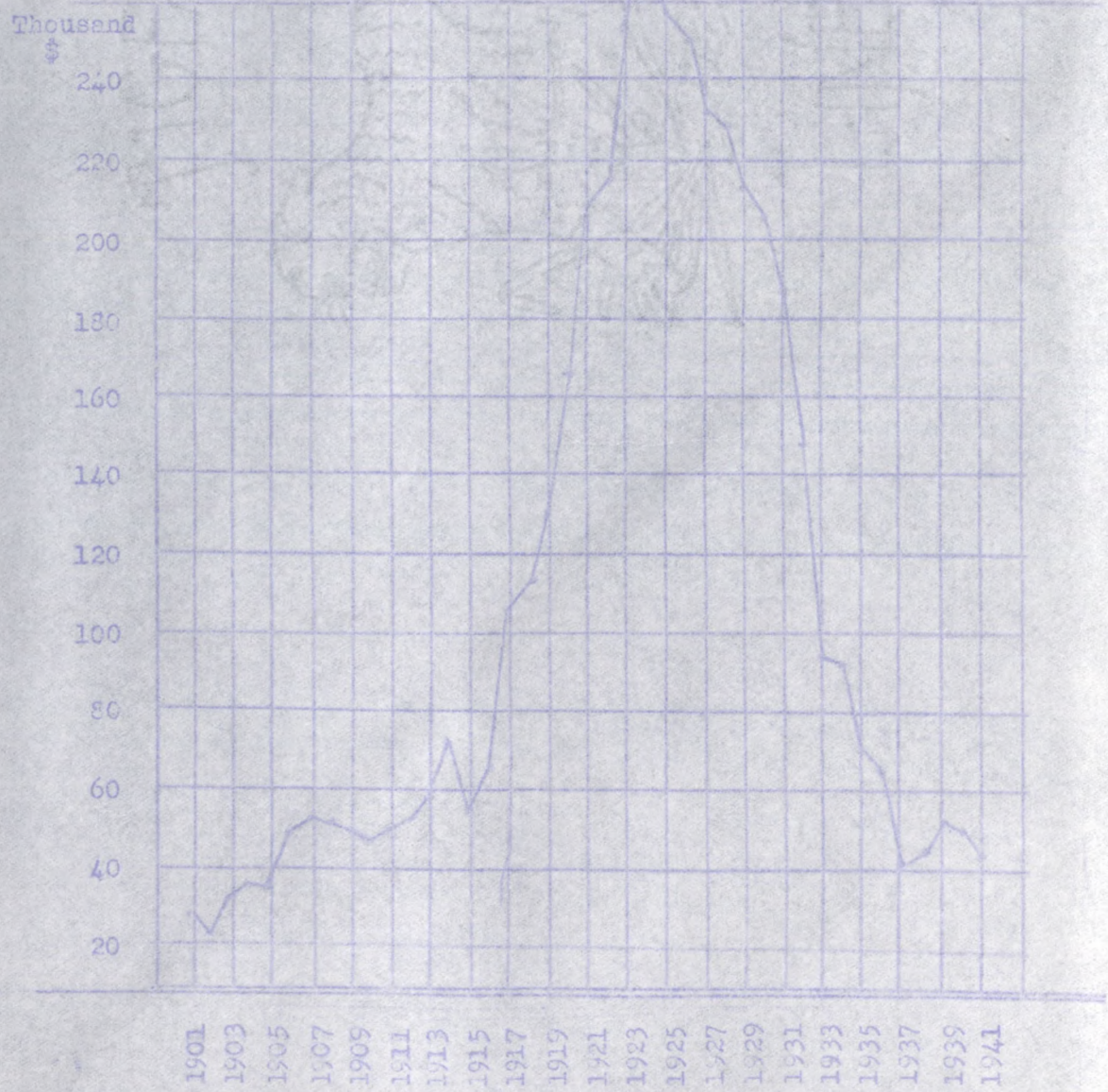


ALGER COUNTY  
TOWNSHIP & CITY TAX LEVIES

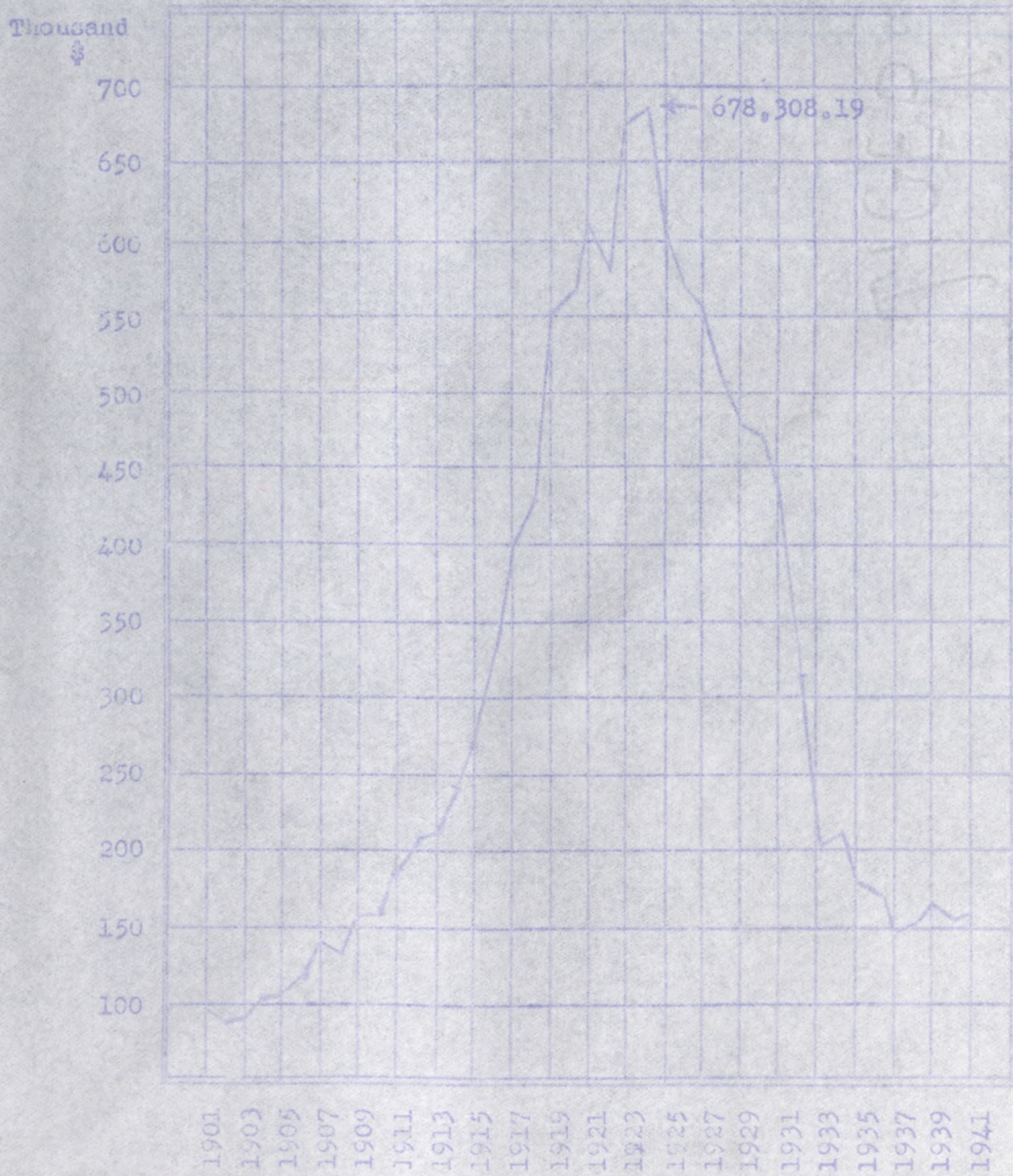




ALGER COUNTY

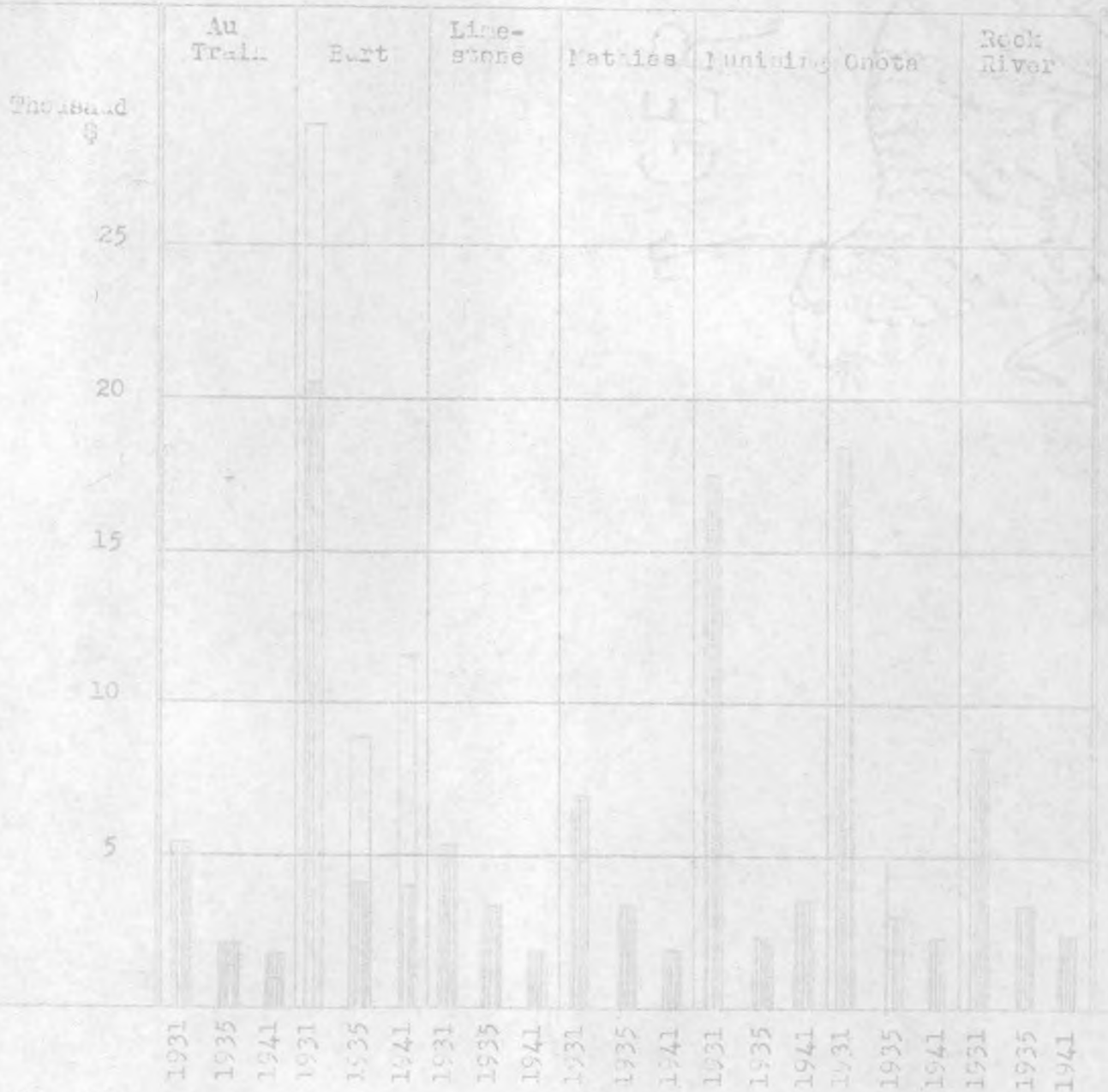

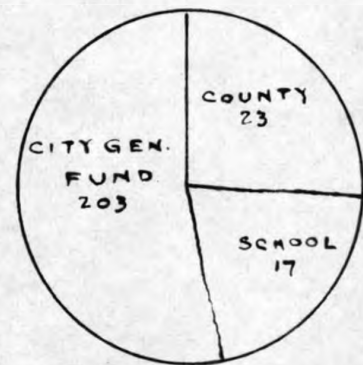

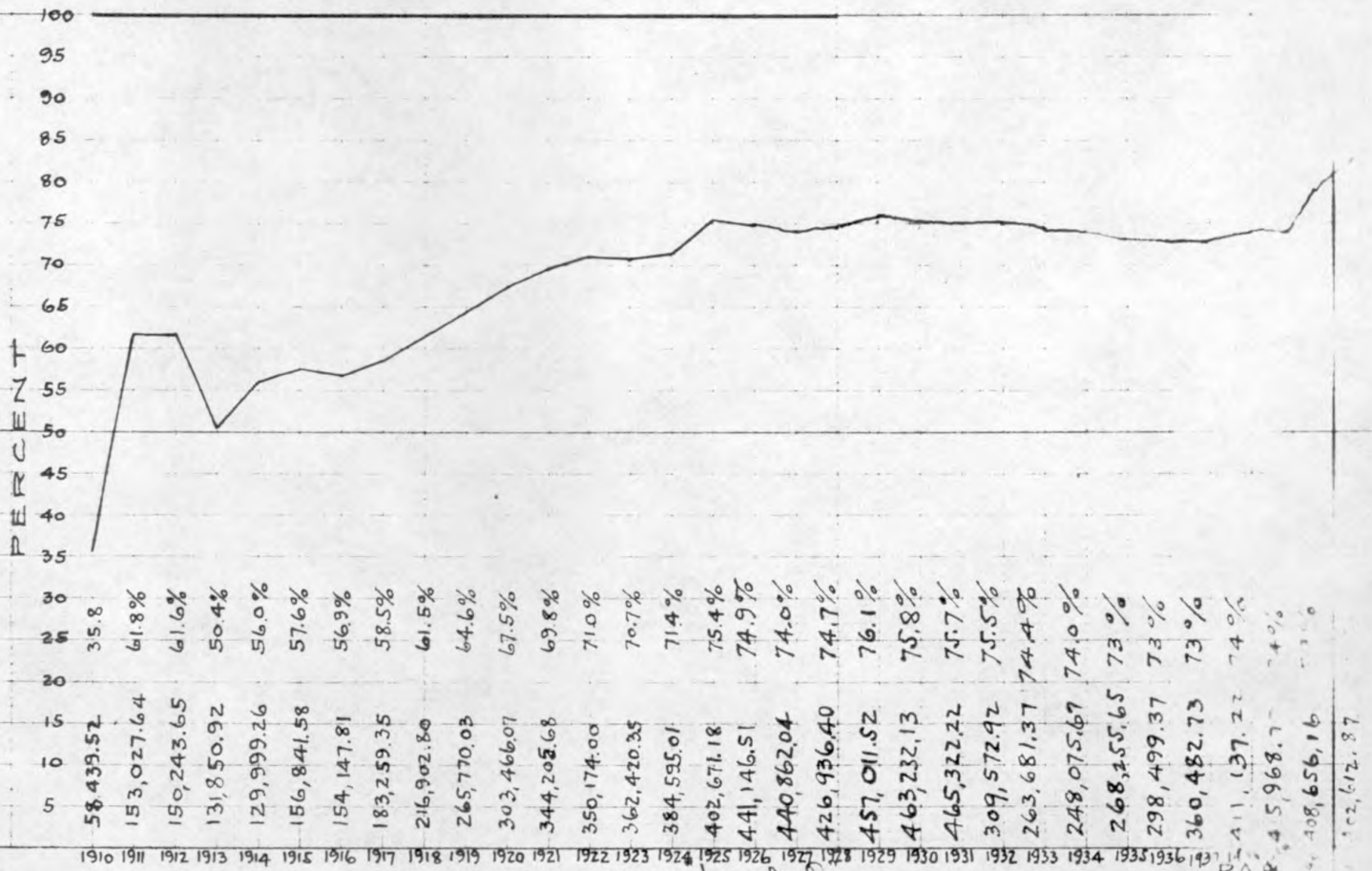

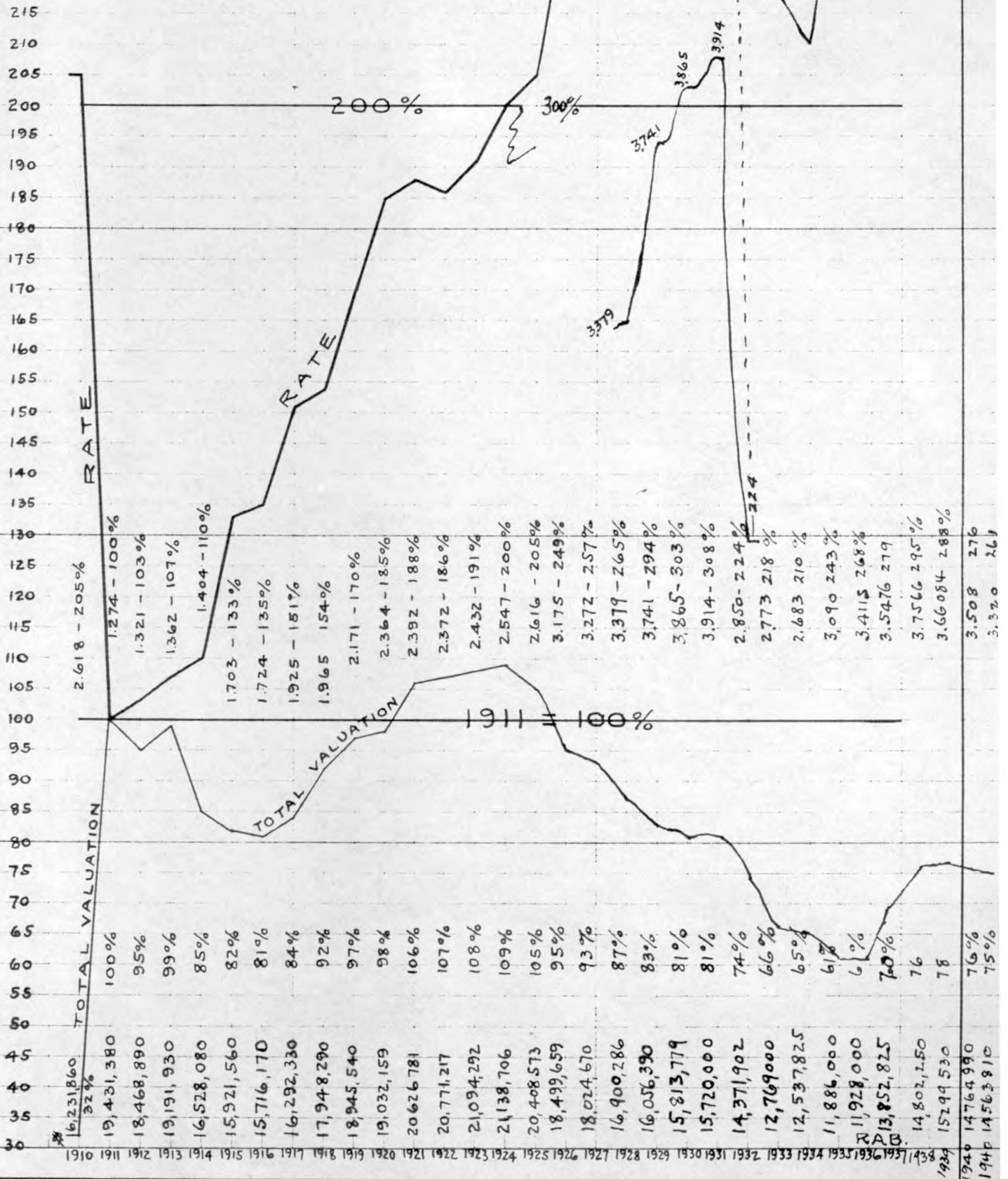
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CHART SHOWING THE PERCENT OF THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF TAXES RAISED PAID BY C.C.I.CO.

CHART SHOWING RATE PERCENT OF TOTAL TAX PAID

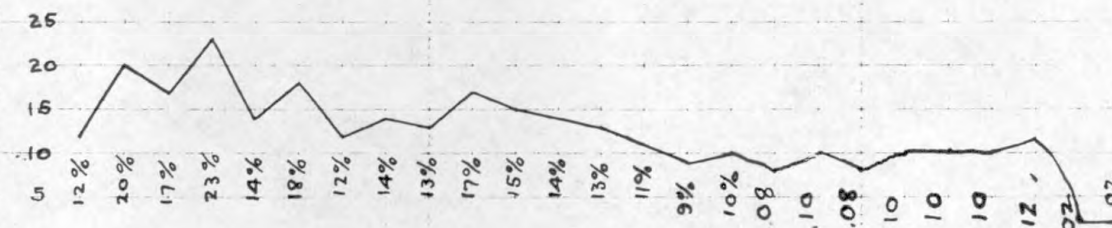
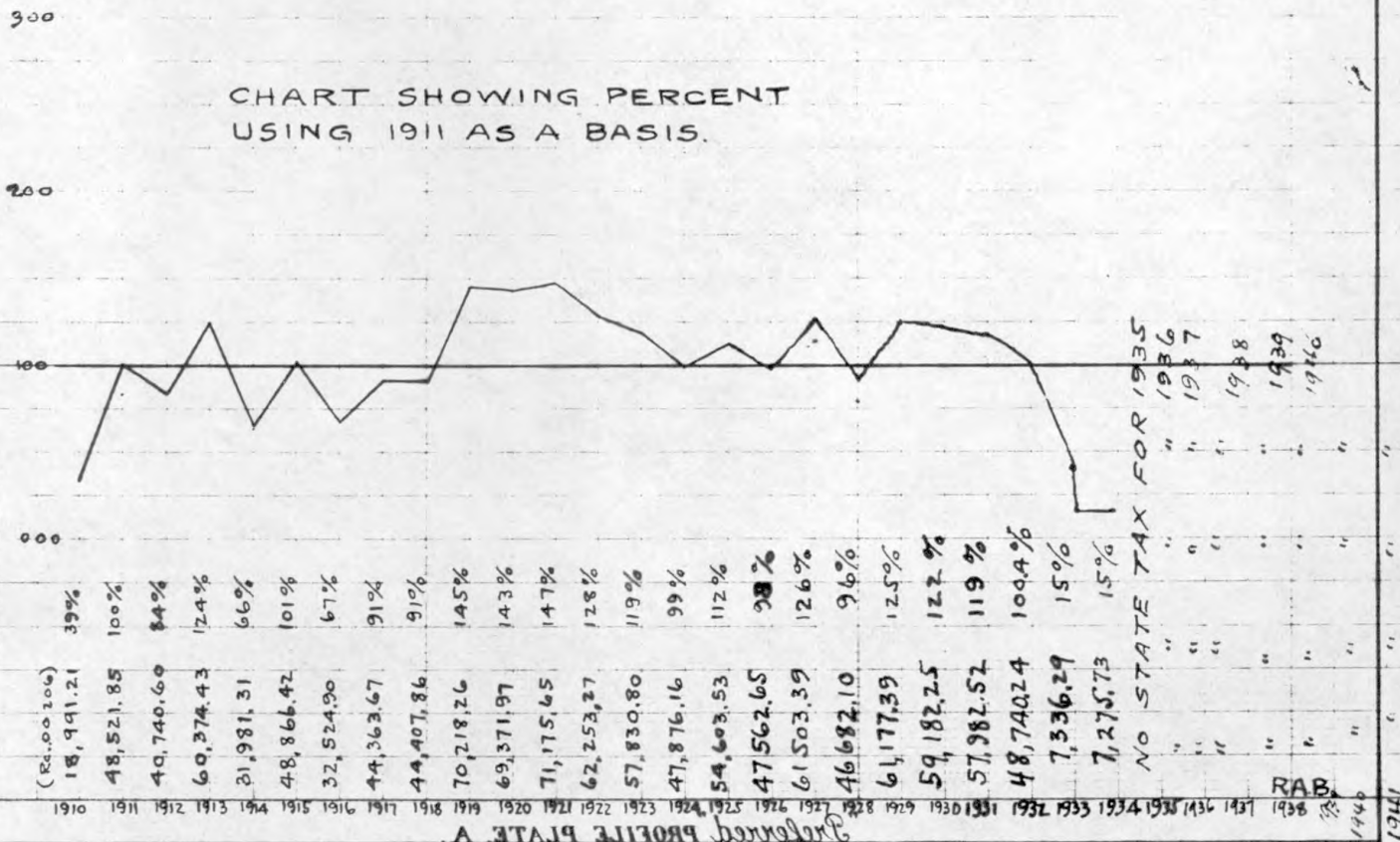


CHART SHOWING PERCENT USING 1911 AS A BASIS.

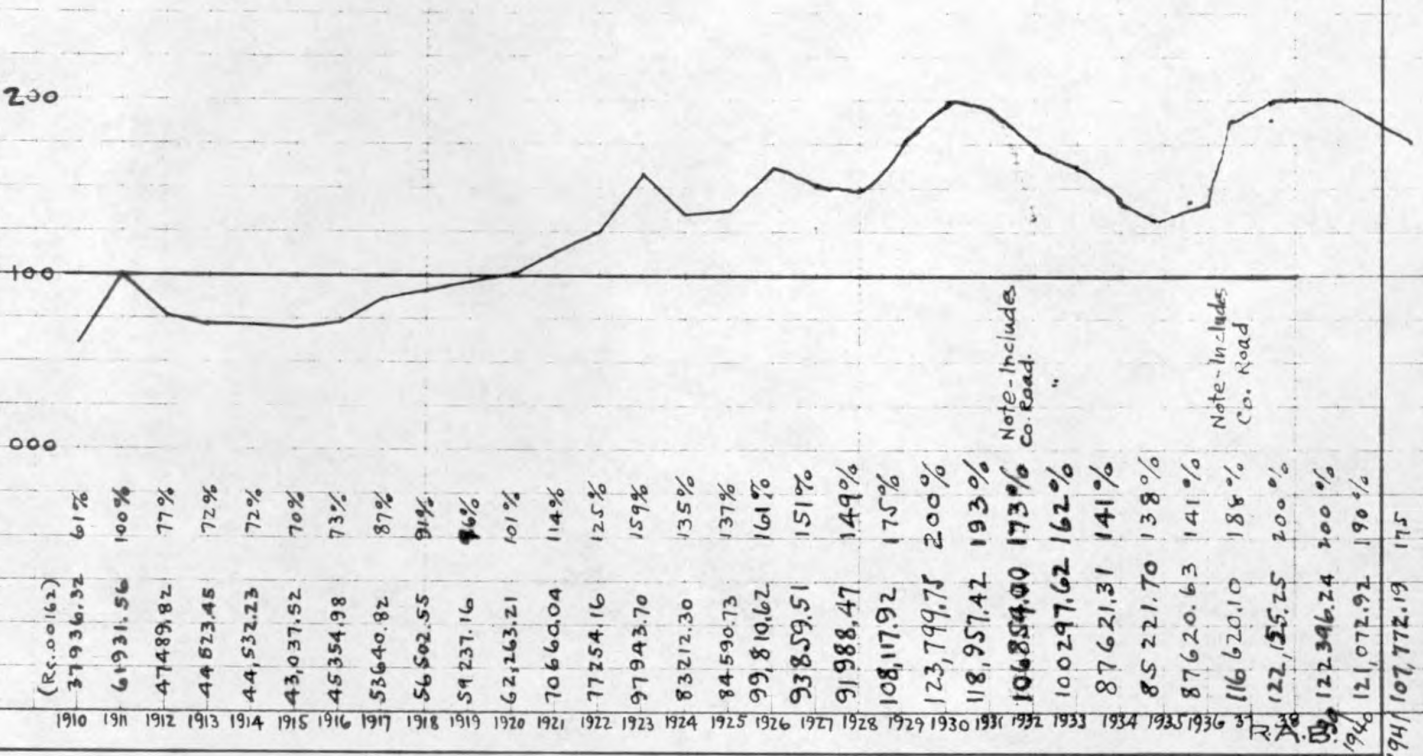

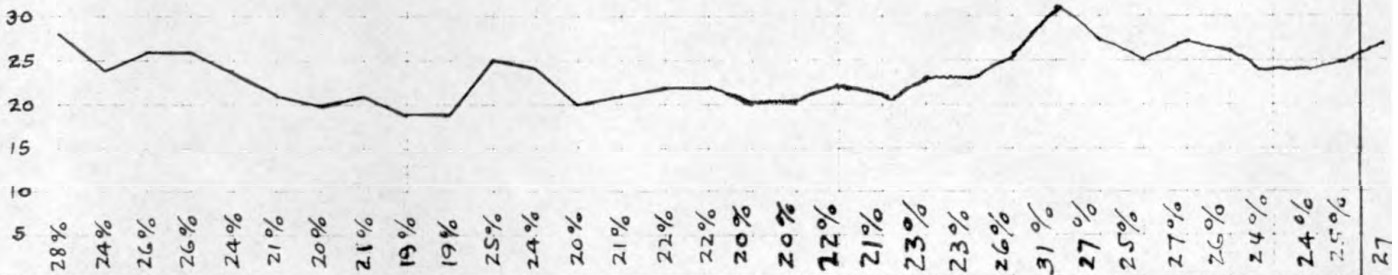

CHART SHOWING % OF TOTAL TAX PAID

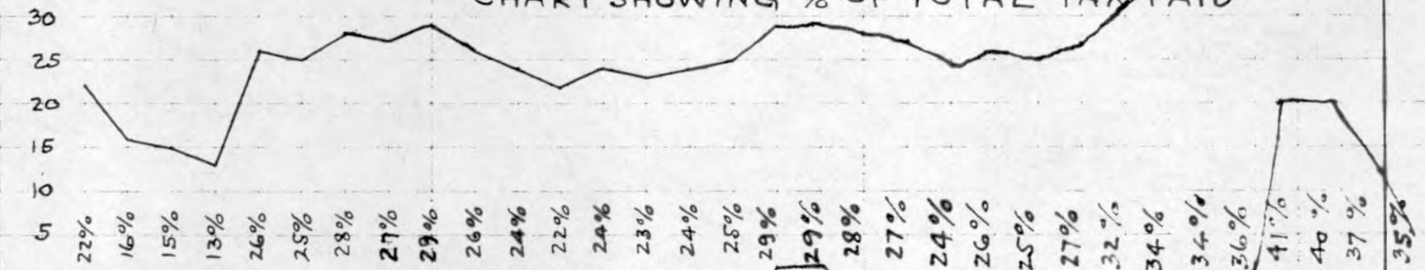
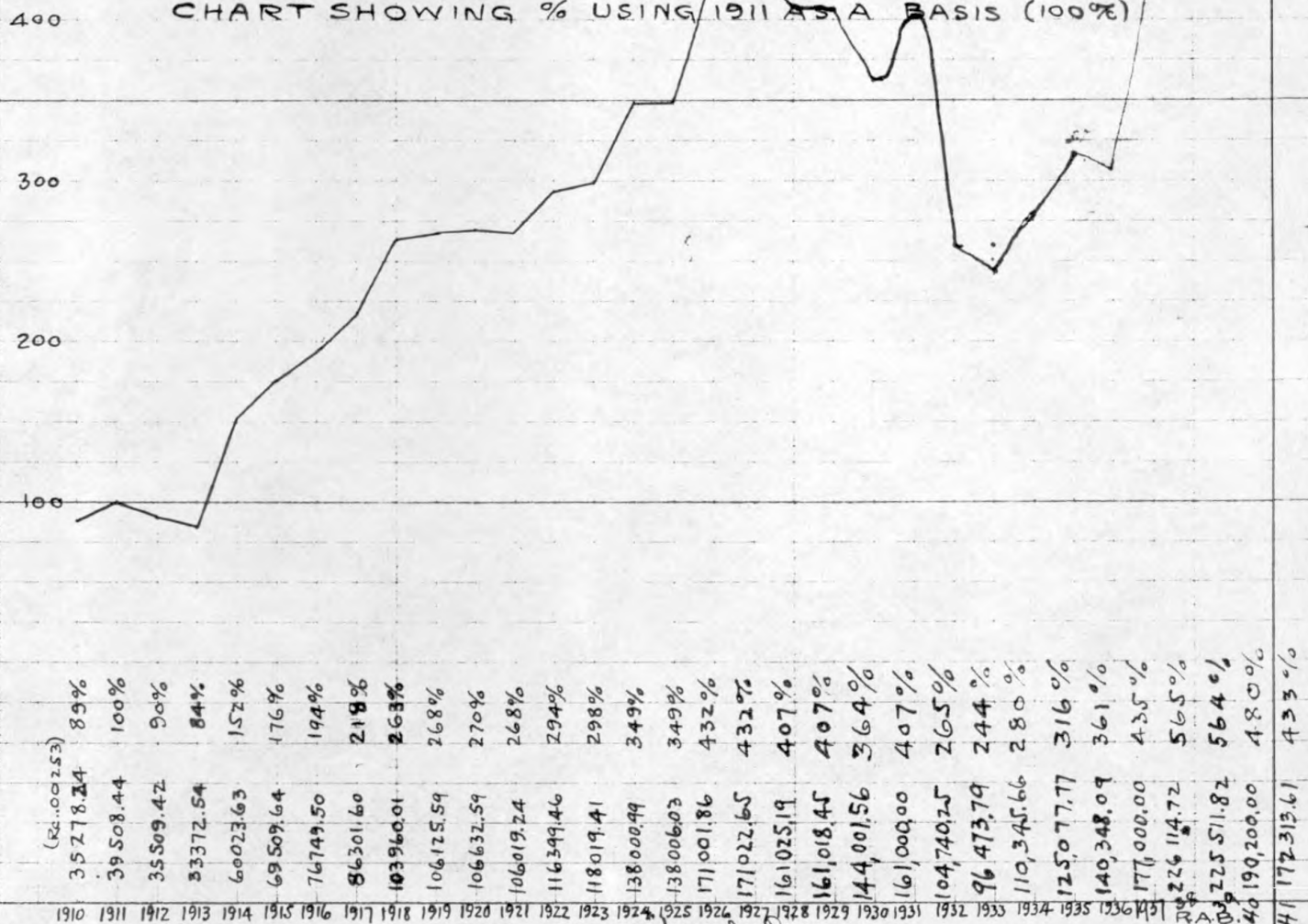
