



Every corporation subject to this act shall annually, in the month of January or February, make duplicate reports for the fiscal year last ending, of such corporation. on suitable blanks to be furnished by the Secretary of State, as hereinafter provided. Such report shall state the amount each of common and preferred capital stock authorized, and the amount thereof subscribed for, and the amount thereof actually paid in, in cash, and the amount thereof paid in property; the amount of capital invested in real and personal estate, and the present actual value of the same as near as may be estimated: the amount of debts of the corporation, and the amount of credits, and the present estimated value of the credits; the name and postoffice address of each stockholder and the number of shares of preferred and common stock held by him at the date of such report; the name and postoffice address of each officer and director of the corporation, and such other information as the Secretary of State may require. It shall be the duty of the Secretary of State in the month of December in each year, to mail to each corporation which is subject to the provisions of this act, suitable blanks on which shall be printed a copy of this section. Such reports shall be signed by a majority of the board of directors and verified by the oath of the Secretary of the corporation, and deposited in the office of the Secretary of State within the said month of January or February. The Secretary of State shall carefully examine such reports, and if upon such examination they shall be found to comply with all the requirements of this section, he shall file one of them in his office and shall forward the other by mail or express to the county clerk of the county in which the office, in this State, for the transaction of the business of said corporation is situated. And it shall be the duty of such county clerk, upon receipt of such report, to immediately cause the same to be filed in his office. If any of the directors of any such corporation shall wilfully neglect or refuse to make and deposit the report required by this section, within the time herein specified, they shall each be liable for all the debts of such corporation contracted since the filing of the last annual or special report, and subject to a penalty of twenty-five dollars, and in addition thereto the sum of five dollars for each and every secular day after the first day of March in each year during the pendency of such neglect and refusal, which penalty shall be for the use and benefit of the general fund of this State. The Secretary of State shall, during the last week of June of each year, report to the Attorney General in writing, the name and postoffice address of each and every corporation which has failed to comply wth the provisions of this section. And upon the receipt of such report, it shall be the duty of the Attorney General to institute proceedings in any court of competent jurisdiction, to collect said penalties, and all necessary expenses incurred by the Attorney General in such proceedings shall be audited by the Board of State Auditors, and paid from the general fund of the State. And in case a corporation


organized or doing business under the provisions of this act shall be dissolved by process of law, or whose term of existence shall terminate by limitation, or whose property and franchises shall be sold at mortgage sale, or at private sale, or if for any reason the attitude of the corporation toward the State shall be changed from that set forth in the articles of association, except as is provided in sections two and seventeen, it shall be the duty of the last board of directors of such corporation within thirty days thereafter, to give written notice of such change to the Secretary of State and the county clerk of the county where the office of such corporation is located, signed by a majority of such directors, which said notice shall be recorded as amendments are required to be recorded. The certificate of the Secretary of State or his deputy, of the mailing of such notices, shall be prima facie evidence in all courts and places of that fact, and that such notices were duly received by said corporation, officers and directors thereof, severally: Provided, Flour milling corporations shall make and deposit annual reports in the month of July or August for the year ending June thirtieth, preceding, and for refusal or neglect to make and deposit the reports required by this section before the first day of September in each year, the directors shall be liable for all the debts of such corporation contracted during the period of such neglect or refusal, and shall be immediately subject to all the penalties provided in this section. All actions and suits based on the neglect or refusal of the officers or directors of such corporations to make and file the reports required by this section shall be commenced within two years next after such neglect or refusal has occurred, and not afterward.



The Secretary of State shall, during the last week of June of each year, report to the Attorney General in writing, the name and postoffice address of each and every association which has failed to comply with the provisions of this section. And upon the receipt of such report, it shall be the duty of the Attorney General to institute proceedings in any court of competent jurisdiction, to collect said penalties, and all necessary expenses incurred by the Auditor General in such proceedings

shall be audited by the Board of State Auditors, and paid from the general fund of the State. And in case an association organized or doing business under the provisions of this act shall be dissolved by process of law, or whose term of existence shall terminate by limitation, or whose property and franchises shall be sold at mortgage sale, or at private sale, it shall be the duty of the last partners of such association, within thirty days thereafter, to give written notice of such change to the Secretary of State and the county clerk of the county where the principal office of such association is located, signed by a majority of such partners, which said notice shall be recorded as amendments are required to be recorded. And in case of neglect to give such notice, they shall be subject to the same penalties provided in case of neglect to make annual reports, which said penalties shall be collected and applied in the same manner as in case of neglect in making annual reports. The neglect or refusal to file the reports required by this section to be filed, shall be deemed to be wilful when the report required is not filed within the time herein limited. 


